I'm busy exploring my own new life. I am like an adolescent discovering him or herself. I am just a kid, (not an easy thing to say at my age). I never meant to make anyone unhappy, I only meant to make me happy.

If you hate me because I differ from your beliefs, I suggest that you read "Mein Kampf" and study the workings of Adolph Hitler's master plan, so that you may use your hatred to it's fullest extent against me. 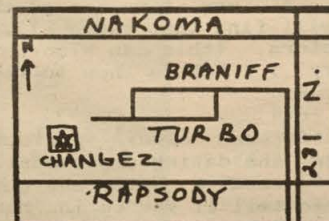

And, if you have a lover, you get to play Murray. Unless, of course you're too busy acting like another set of Gay role models. Who? Why, Lucy and Desi, of course.

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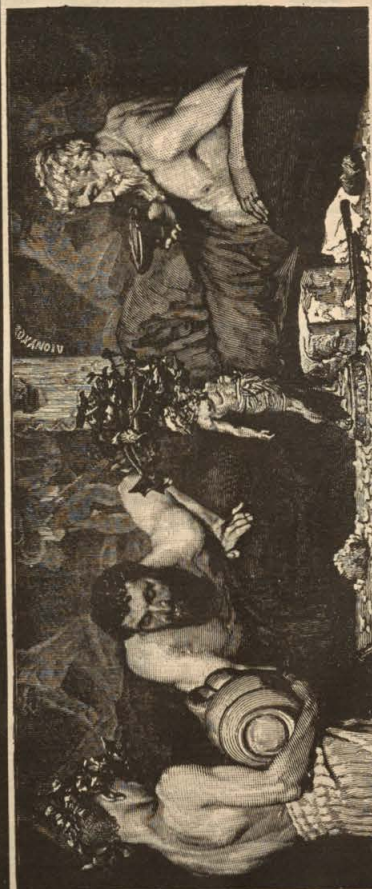
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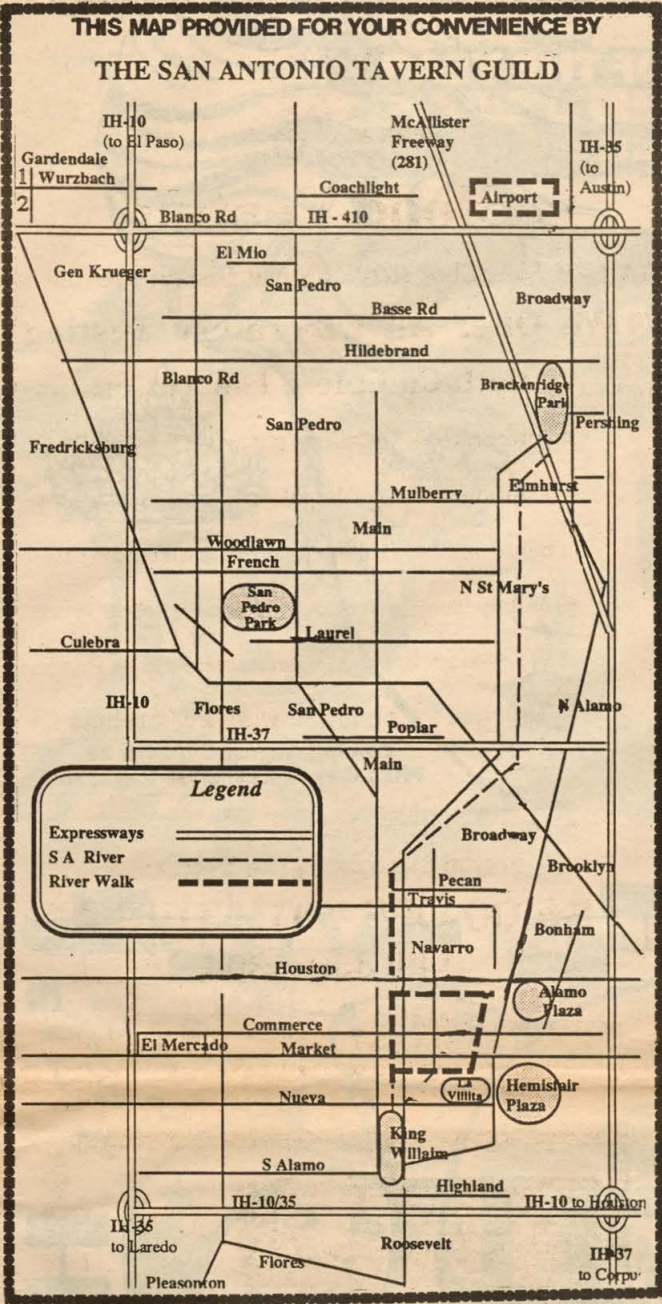

When Reverend Troy Perry founded Metropolitan Community Church in 1968, he called gay men and lesbians into a new relationship with their Creator. In 1969, newly-founded Metropolitan Community Churches came together to form a new denomination - the Universal Fellowship of Metropolitan Community Churches or as we call it, "The Fellowship." The exciting message of the all-embracing love of God has brought thousands of gay and non-gay persons into our family. Metropolitan Community Churches are found in most American cities, suburbs and many rural areas; in Canada, Australia, New Zealand, the United Kingdom, Denmark, Nigeria, South Africa, Mexico and other countries.

Within our unique Fellowship a special blend of doctrine and government has grown up. The congregational tradition has always been strong in the Fellowship. Sometimes that congregational government has been modified in the interests of common purposes and better governing of the whole Fellowship. Why has that happened? Of what value is the Fellowship to local Metropolitan Community Churches and members?

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AIDS Information

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WHY BE TESTED FOR THE AIDS ANTIBODY?

For anyone with some risk, it is important to know one's AIDS-antibody status. Because, if you should happen to be AIDS antibody positive, these 22 precautions and/or suggestions might help save your life or the life of someone you love:

For those who already have AIDS, ADC (AIDS Dementia Complex) or ARC (AIDS Related Complex), following these procedures and/or suggestions may lengthen your lifespan considerably.

1. For those testing AIDS-antibody positive (HIV Positive), it is suggested that you contact the San Antonio Tavern Guild AIDS Foundation to discover and evaluate the programs that are available. We can be of assistance in many ways; all services are free and all information remains confidential.
2. If you do not have the resources to see a physician, please contact the San Antonio Tavern Guild AIDS Foundation for assistance.
3. Avoid live vaccines, such as those for measles, mumps, and rubella.
4. Get a doctor's recommendation about pneumonia and flu vaccinations, which are often recommended. They use killed-virus vaccines.
5. Polio can be contracted by an AIDS-antibody-positive person from oral polio vaccine virus excreted in the stool of a vaccinated child or adult. No oral polio (live virus) vaccine should be given in a household with an AIDS-antibody-positive person.
6. Your doctor will not use immunosuppressive drugs, such as corticosteroids, certain antibiotics, and some anti-cancer drugs that are dangerous for AIDS-positive persons.
7. Do not use aspirin or other painkillers without consulting your doctor. Aspirin is slightly immunosuppressive.
8. Do not use illicit drugs, including marijuana and heroin, as they are immunosuppressive.
9. Encourage your spouse, ex-spouse, lover, ex-lover, and/or sex partners to have the AIDS antibody test.
10. Protect your sex partner by informing him or her of your condition; condoms improve safety but do not remove all risks.
11. It is suggested that anyone testing AIDS antibody positive investigate AL-721. An AL-721 meeting is held every Thursday between 7:00-7:30 PM at the Foundation's headquarters at 3530 Broadway.
12. Cats transmit toxoplasmosis. Birds transmit histoplasmosis and psittacosis. AIDS antibody positive people should not clean cat litter or bird cages.
13. Notify your physician, dentist and any other medical personnel that you have had a positive antibody test so they can do their best to care for you and to prevent the spread of the virus.
14. As your family doctor to help you select a physician who specializes in infectious diseases to do additional blood tests. Such tests will reveal the condition of your protective T Cells. Infectious disease specialists are also trained AIDS counselors. Further, professional ethics dictate that physicians maintain confidentiality.
15. If you are AIDS antibody positive, pregnancy may weaken your immune system and bring on AIDS, AIDS Related Complex, or AIDS Dementia Complex. The baby has a 30 to 50 percent chance of having AIDS. In an infected mother, breast milk contains the AIDS virus. Avoid breast feeding.
16. Do not donate blood, plasma, sperm, body organs or other tissues.
17. Avoid unpasteurized milk because there is a risk of salmonella infection, which is more serious in an immunosuppressed person. Salmonella is spread through contaminated blood from chicken and other meat. Use acrylic cutting boards that clean in dishwashers. Cook turkeys to 180° F. at center. Cook hamburgers to 170° F. Do not eat rare meat.
18. It is especially important that AIDS antibody positive persons exercise regularly, maintain a proper diet, get adequate rest, and avoid stress to help maintain the immune system.
19. AIDS antibody positive individuals need to know that they are at a greater risk for serious consequences what tourists jokingly refer to as "Montezuma's Revenge" or the "Aztec Two-Step." If you must travel to Third World countries, take bottled water and avoid raw foods.
20. To protect your immune system, do not use alcoholic beverages or tobacco products. They are immunosuppressive.
21. Assiduously avoid all additional sexually transmitted infections, such as cytomegalovirus, Epstein-Barr virus, syphilis, and reinfections with the AIDS virus.
22. Do not have your ears pierced or be tattooed.

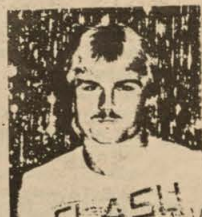

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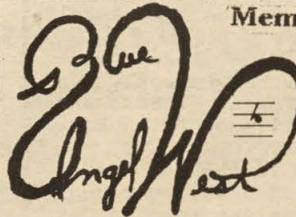
