SAVE 25% BY ORDERING FOR DELIVERY DURING FIRST WEEK OF ISSUANCE!

Whereas once a film has been issued you can order it at any time at the regular
price, if the orders placed for delivery during the one week the film is on special,
you save 1/4th of the cost. You can order one film or any number of films in
advance of their release dates with the understanding that they will be shipped to
you during the week of the special for that particular film.

STUDY THE CATALOGS TO LEARN THE CONTENTS OF THE FILM. You will
note that catalog pages have been listed for each of the films. These catalogs cost
25 cents each page (or any 15 for 15 cents each) The catalogs show many addition-
al scenes from the films and help you decide which movies will fit your needs. The
catalogs themselves are all available now so you have ample time to study them in
advance.

POSTAGE PREPAID BY AMG. We are glad to prepay the shipping cost of all
material sent to you. Of course we reserve the right to use the most economical
type mail or shipping. If you desire assured first class sealed mailing or air-
mail, then please include estimated postage (We will be glad to return a credit
slip for excess postage.)

8MM basic weight is about 1 1/2 ounces, (4 minutes.) Allow about one ounce
for each 4 minutes running time (Thus for 8 mins you should allow 4 ounces)

16mm basic weight is about 4 ounces for 100 ft (4 minute) size. Allow about
one ounce for each additional minute of running time.

First class postage in US 5 cents for each ounce. Foreign 1st class is 11 c for 1st
ounce and 7 c for ea additional ounce.

Airmail in U.S. 8c an ounce up to 8 ozs (greater wts subject to zone rates, check
with post office). Trans-Atlantic airmail: 15c ea 1/2 oz. Trans-Pacific 25c ea
one-half ounce

FOREIGN CURRENCIES may be used at par value.

ADDITIONAL FILMS WILL BE RELEASED DURING THE YEAR and will be announced
in Physique Pictorial and in special bulletins which will be sent automatically to
anyone making a purchase of one or more films from this calendar during the year.

DEFECTIVE FILMS (other than those with an inherent defect in the negative which
has been indicated in bulletin) should be returned for replacement. However, please
do not return films damaged by faulty handling or projection equipment. With some
projectors it is necessary to run "green" (new) film through a couple of times before
it will run smoothly without skipping. All films we send out are new and have ne-
ver been run before.

PLEASE SEND YOUR EVALUATION OF EACH FILM as well as those of audiences
to whom you have shown the film. These are studied carefully and help us in crea-
ting new films and determining which should be released.
