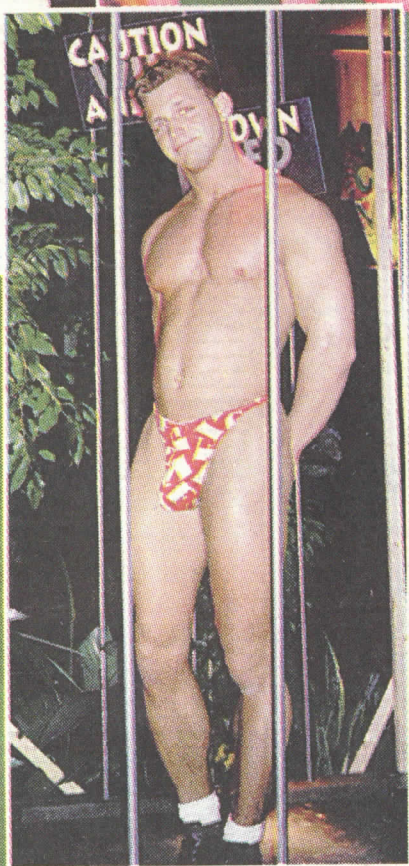

The Easter holiday, April 3-4, is one of the premier times to party in this town as several organizations and clubs get into the giving and gyrating spirit.

Expect Tarzan in Calvin Kleins and high-heeled sprinters with armfuls of assorted food stuffs, racing across Westheimer; anticipate golden-tanned, taunt boys, rococo bonnets, and plenty of elixir. These are the dance daze of unsurpassed Bacchanalianism involving wildlife of all varieties.

Some of the Easter weekend events date back 20 years.

This isn't your father's lost weekend. And don't even think about being a wallflower.

First up on the party tour is a step right into the wild fronds and fabulous boys of one of Houston's most popular soirees—"Jungle Lust VII," April 3, 10 p.m. at the Houston Polo Club, Loop 610 at Memorial Drive. Past swingers should note: this year's event, once again hosted and produced by the Bayou City Boys Club, is in a new location to accommodate the swelling attendance, said Allen Glander, BCBC president.

The "fund-raising dance party" usually attracts over 1,000 revelers. Tickets can be purchased for \$35 in advance at Basic Brothers, Lobo Bookstore and Cafe in Houston, Lobo Bookstore in Austin, Ken Knight in the Quadrangle in Dallas and throughout the day of the party. The event is, quote, "OPEN BAR."

"You'll spend that much on any given Saturday night," said Matt Krol, past president of BCBC.

The best part about the dance is participation in its theme.

"We encourage people to come in the theme of the event. You'll see loin clothes, one guy came dressed as if being eaten by a snake, there's Tarzans and Janes," said Glander. "This event usually generates \$30,000 to \$35,000."

The annual dancefest for fund-raising idea originated seven years ago when friends got together over the Easter weekend to celebrate a mate's birthday.

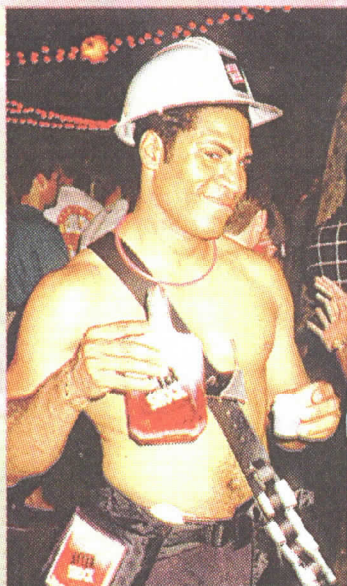
"We looked and saw how many people were there and we said, 'Oh my God,' and we've grown to what we are now. That very first event we had 200 people there," said Glander.

The atmosphere of Jungle Lust can lead to false impressions, especially with the recent controversy surrounding the circuit party scene.

"This is not a circuit party. It's a completely volunteer organization, we are strictly a fund-raising organizer. I have no

overhead, no paid staff, our events are completely underwritten by supporters."

Glander said, "I have the money in the bank right now to pay for the expenses of the party. What comes in the door goes right back out the door, to the benefactors."

Excess, he said, has meant success.

"We believe in having fun while raising money. We're not going to wear tuxes and sit there for two hours and listen to someone give a speech."

There won't be tuxes and speeches at **Bunnies On The Bayou 20**, either. Here, the Easter Bunny will be giving out more than chocolate egg treats.

The 20th anniversary benefit, which started out as a back yard get-together, has morphed into a gigantic extravaganza designed to raise funds for Houston's gay and lesbian community and AIDS/HIV charities.

The April 4 event, which begins at 2 p.m., is at the outdoor Fish Plaza at Wortham Center in downtown Houston. Regalia includes the ubiquitous bunny ears and tails, and other assorted Easter-themed attire. The fun is apparently contagious.

"It has grown into one of the Houston gay and lesbian community's favorite events, as evidenced by each year's significant increase in funds raised," said Ray Ramirez, one of the chief organizers.

"It's a large, spring-time affair. This year we're going to have body-painting, aerobic demonstrations. It's the first time to wear white, wear shorts ... and on to Rich's afterwards." Rich's is located at 2401 San Jacinto.

Last year's event raised more than \$40,000 and attracted more than 2,000 partiers, said Ramirez.

Events for this year's party also include an Easter bonnet contest, entertainment from magicians, artists and dancers.

Music is being provided by Dan Mador, weatherman at KHOU, Channel 11.

Hostess Penny Rabbitt will be there in her "rabbithness." The chief hare is asking for a \$20 admission and is guaranteeing 100 percent of the monies will go to local charities including:

If dancing bunnies and shaking jungle beasts aren't your cup of Darjeeling, head over to a couple of institutions of local yore for fun on the bunny days.

Down at Mary's, Montrose's ersatz clubhouse at 1022 Westheimer, there will be a bar crawl, Easter bonnet contest and the "you-have-to-see-it-to-believe" high-heel race.

Meg the Bartender tells *eclipse* the fun kicks off at noon April 4 with the crawl and patrons end up back at the bar, if able, around 6 p.m. for the high-heel race.

The race consists of men running from the bar in their favorite pumps to a local grocery store, where they must fulfill a sundry list of items and return to Mary's.

"The first back, honey, wins a prize," said Meg, barely containing his glee.

The best Easter bonnet will be judged—by audience applause—following the race.

Not to be outdone, Decades' best bonnet contest takes place at 3 p.m. on April 4. Decades is located at 1205 Richmond Road.

"There'll be cash prizes. See you there, sweetie," said a real sweetie himself, Jeff Cowin, manager/bartender at Decades.

So there you have it, a weekend like no other to shake your money-maker, help out some worthy causes and celebrate with all the wildlife in Bayou City.
