DJ Escape

'Party Time 2002'

Groovilicious Records

Sometimes you just need a break from the club scene. You find yourself at home watching reality television and playing board games with other ex-club enthusiasts. So what are you to do when you want some sort of dance music to play in your car, but don't want to sound too dated? Groovilicious Records has come out with "Party Time." This 2002 edition, mixed by the label's in-house DJ Escape, is a double CD featuring some big club hits. The first CD is more of a house and circuit mix featuring songs like "Groove Jet (If This Ain't Love)" by DJ Spiller and "Never Enough" by Boris Dlugosh, featuring vocals by Moloko's

Rosin Murphy. The first CD also contains the No. 1 hit "Keep Control" by Sono and a new Crystal Waters song titled "Come On Down" which samples, of all things, the theme song to "The Price Is Right."

The second CD in this series is more trance and high energy driven, with songs like "Stranger in My House" by Tamia and "You Set Me Free" by Abigail. DJ Escape does his best at combining a mix of songs that would satisfy those who need a little party time in their life, but this CD doesn't even come close to what I would consider good club music. It just scratches the surface. If you are a club head and do go out every weekend, then most likely these songs are the ones that you are so sick of that you wouldn't want to hear them again.

Garbage

'Beautiful'

When it comes to alternative rock, Garbage is one group that has remained on top. With the release of "Beautiful," this group from Wisconsin once again gives us some rock music to dance to. This 13-song CD is filled with powerful songs that will soon hit Top 40 in the gut. Just listen to songs like "Shut Your Mouth" and "Till The Day I Die," both rock songs that radio should embrace. Like all bands, Garbage has grown musically, trying new sounds and effects to help evolve their sound. Some times these new sounds are a little too much, like on the song "Can't Cry These Tears." It starts out sounding like a bad Bangles song (did they have a good song?) but soon turns out to be a well-written piece. The songs that stand out are "So Like A Rose" and "Androgyny," both covering new ground for the band without losing the sound that has made them big. Fans of Garbage will enjoy this because it keeps to what they do best — powerful pop rock with an alternative twist.



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k.d. lang

'Live by Request'

Over the years, there have been many boot-leg live recordings of k.d. lang shows like

"For Lovers Only" that have captured the spirit of her live voice. Now there is an official live recording called "Live By Request." Taped last December in New York, this 14-song CD captures the warmth of k.d.'s voice so well you could almost imagine being there in front of the stage. "Live By Request" covers a wide range of lang's music starting with her song "Summer Fling" and continuing with her older hits like "Big-Boned Gal," "Miss Chatelaine" and "Constant Craving." Lang has a voice that is so pure and strong it just makes your knees weak. Listen to songs like "Pullin' Back The Reins," "Trail Of Broken Hearts" and one of her personal favorites, "Crying." Or just listen to the words in the songs "Three Cigarettes in an Ashtray," "Wash Me Clean" and "Barefoot." This is an excellent recording, but can't even come close to seeing her perform live.



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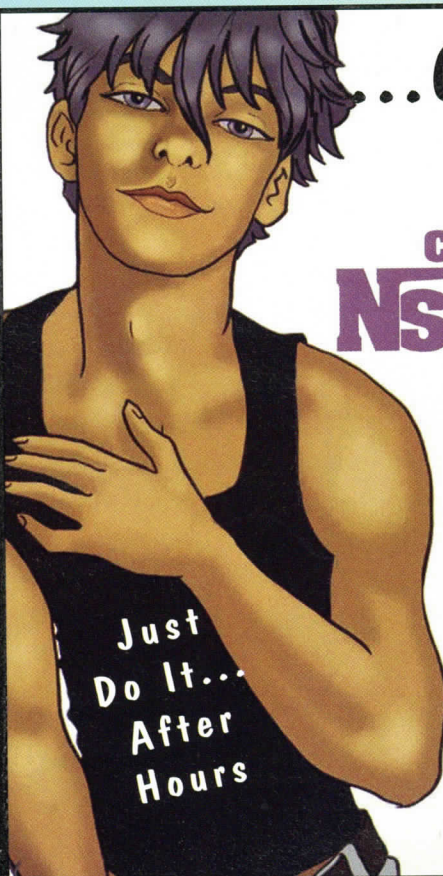
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
