HOUSTON — Easter is hopping (pun intended) in the Bayou City this year with two traditional fund-raising parties.

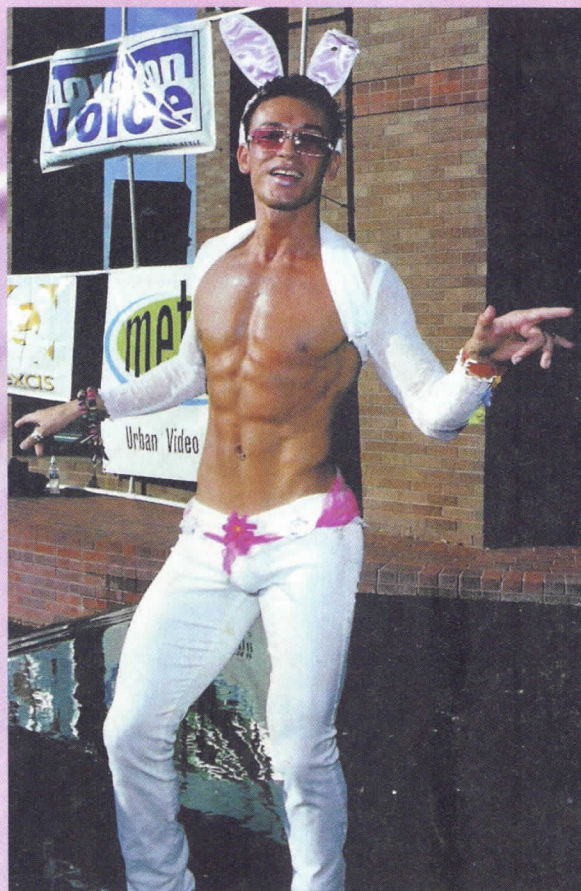
On Sunday, April 20, Bunnies on the Bayou Inc. hosts its 2003 Easter Event. The one-day fund-raiser is well known for raucous outdoor dancing, cranked-up disco and the festive Easter-themed garb of those who attend to drum up support for good causes.

A separate organization and event, but also held over Easter, is Jungle 11 Weekend, an annual circuit party powered by the Bayou City Boys Club. Jungle 11 also raises funds for Houston-area HIV and AIDS service and education providers.

Between the two events, Houstonians and visitors are sure to find Easter 2003 a memorable one.

Bunnies on the Bayou

This year's Bunnies on the Bayou event on Sunday, April 20, is the culmination of more than two decades of Easter festivities among friends.

According to Bunnies organizers, it was Easter 1979 when a group of friends planned a party, and when it was a big success, decided to make the event an annual fest. Bunnies on the Bayou began to grow. In the mid 1980s, AIDS was taking a toll on gay Houstonians, and a bag of food was charged as admission to assist those in need.

Party attendance grew until a new venue was needed in the early 1990s, so the new outside plaza at the Wortham Theater downtown was chosen, and the group's name also was selected. Since then, tens of thousands of Houstonians and visitors have celebrated Easter with their friends, made new friends and helped raise hundreds of thousands of dollars for area charities.

This year's Bunnies Easter event is at 2 p.m. at the Wortham Center in downtown Houston. Beneficiaries are American Red Cross, Q Patrol, People With AIDS Coalition, H.A.T.C.H. (Houston Area Teen

Coalition of Homosexuals), PAWS Houston, Montrose Clinic, The Center for AIDS Hope & Remembrance Project, AssistHers and Colt 45's.

Cost is \$25 at the door, or \$100 for a VIP pass, which includes VIP entrance, liquor and a VIP restroom area.

"Things are going quite well this year," says Trevan Ross, chair of the contributions committee for Bunnies on the Bayou. "I've been actually quite pleased with the amount of cash we've been able to raise, given the economy. We've received so many requests for funding."

About \$50,000 was raised at the party last year, with some 2,200 people in attendance. Ross says he expects about the same amount of money to be raised with the 2003 event.

This party is known as a must-see in Houston, and Ross tries to describe it for those who have not attended.

"Bunnies on the Bayou is probably the best time that you'll ever have," he says. "It's just a large outdoor cocktail party with socialization, fun, friends, outrageous bonnets and a celebration of the community that we have."

Bunnies on the Bayou, Inc. is a non-profit organization dedicated to raising and distributing funds for various charitable, educational, and cultural programs, organizers note. The non-profit groups and programs that benefit seek to improve the quality of life for individuals in the Houston gay community, and to promote education and awareness of individual human rights.

Jungle 11 Weekend

This year's Jungle Weekend, powered by the Bayou City Boys Club Inc., promises to be the biggest and best yet, organizers say.

"We are very excited. The buzz has gotten out there. We really do project our largest crowd ever," says Mike Collins, Jungle Weekend president. "The party has grown for the last five years. The buzz is good. The only uncertainty of course is the war. We're concerned that we may not get as many out-of-towners.

"We're hoping for the best," Collins adds. "Barring something unforeseen, this really really looks to be the best Jungle ever."

Jungle Weekend raised \$48,000 last year for Houston-area HIV/AIDS service and education providers. Corporate underwriting alone already shows that the 2003 event will surpass that amount, according to Collins.

"The underwriting and the corporate sponsorship from the Houston business community is what makes this possible, and we're so very grateful," Collins says.

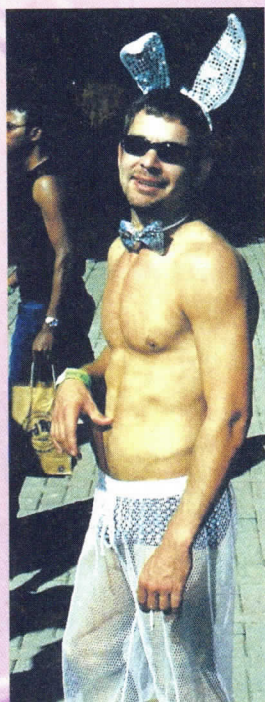
BCBC leaders expect nearly 2,000 people to attend the events this year from April 17-20.

"Steadily over the years, the attendance has grown," Collins says. "We had a little over 1,500 people last year.

Jungle Weekend began in 1993 as an idea among a group of friends, according to Collins.

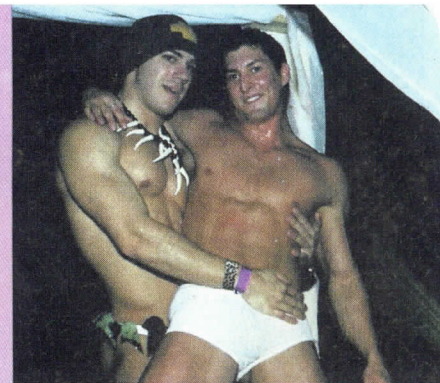
"They were all turning 30. They decided that they wanted to have a joint birthday party, but that they wanted their friends to make donation to a charity rather than bringing them gifts," says Collins. "That's how it got started."

The weekend kicks off on Thursday evening, April 17, with a free event at Meteor. On Friday night, DJ Roland Balmores returns to his Texas roots with the "Gather the Tribe" event at Rich's Houston, according to Jungle Weekend organizers. The Saturday night main event, "Tribal Heat," will be held in downtown Houston at Verizon Wireless Theater. The party features DJ Monte Q and Circuit Mom.



After Saturday's "Tribal Heat," the party shifts to afterhours at Boaka Bar and Mercury Room for "Tribal Communion" with DJ Dawna Montel. On Sunday night, DJ Barry Harris brings the weekend to a close with "Tribal Lust" at South Beach.

This year, tickets for Jungle 11 Weekend start at \$95 for a 3-Day pass, and go up to \$125 for a 3-Day Gold pass and \$200 for a 3-Day Platinum pass. For the main event only Saturday night, cost is \$25 for students with a valid ID, only at the door; \$45 general admission in advance, which will be sold up to 5 p.m. the day of the event at Lobo, M2M and JR's; or \$55 at the door.
