

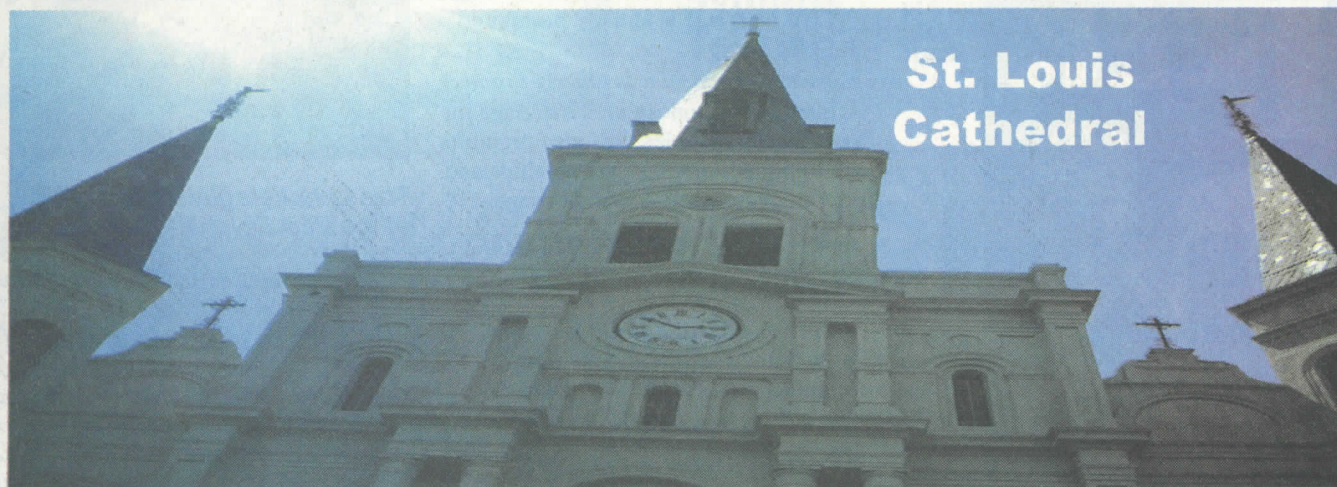

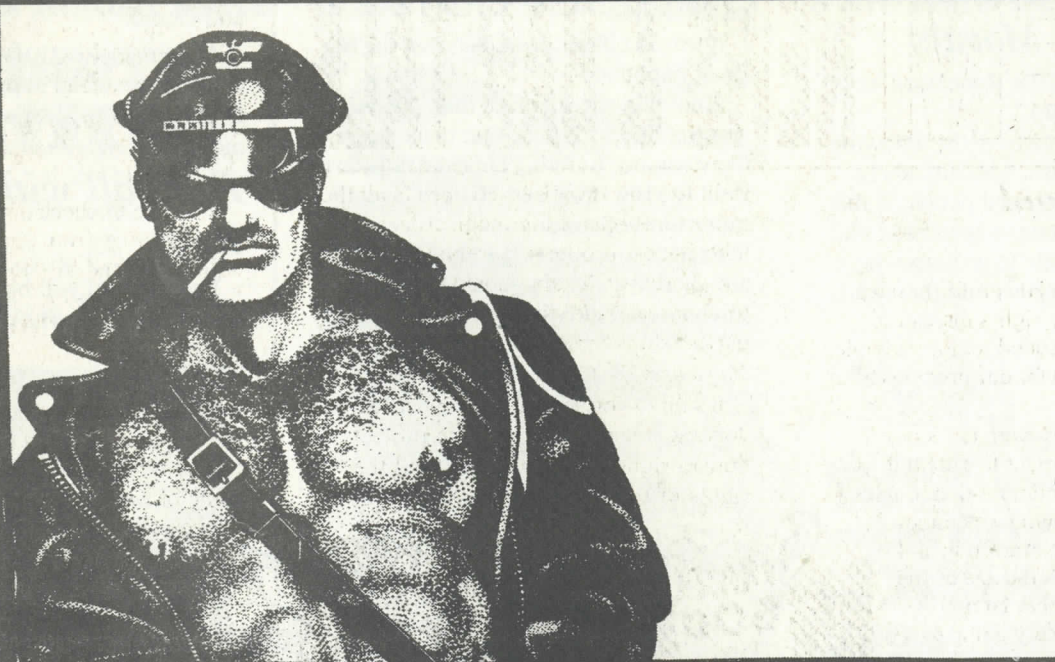

What was there before that? There was no "there" before that because there was no "before." Time did not start until the Big Bang and "before" is an expression of time.

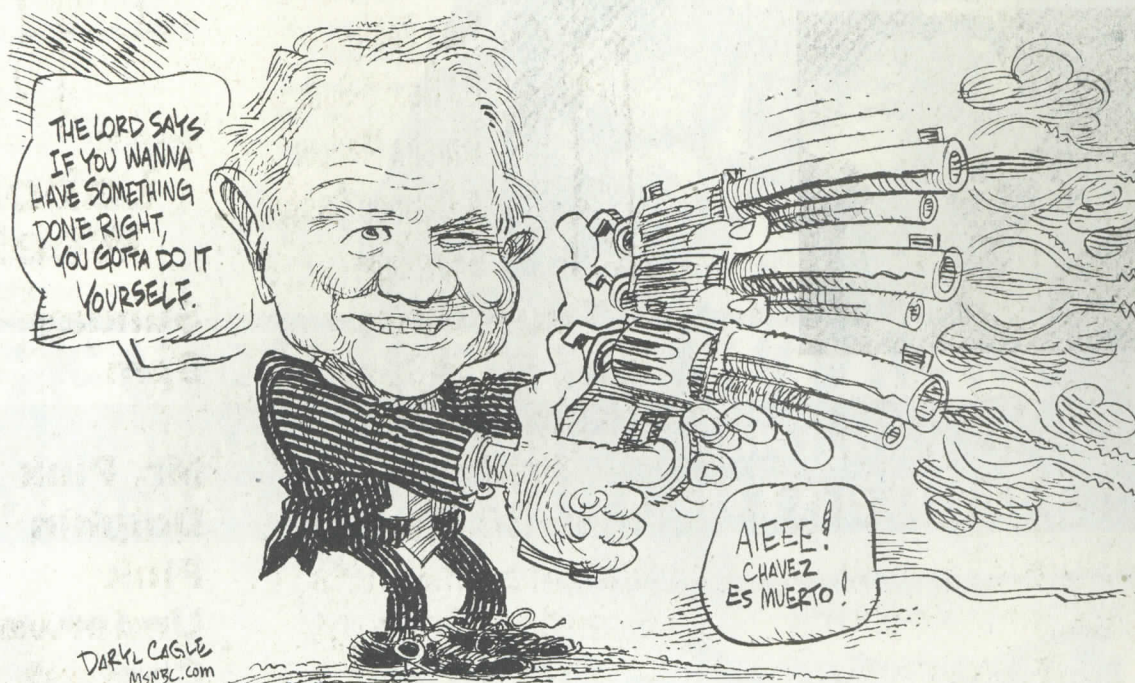
Earth came into being about 4.5 billion years ago. The first dinosaurs came around 190 million years ago. And

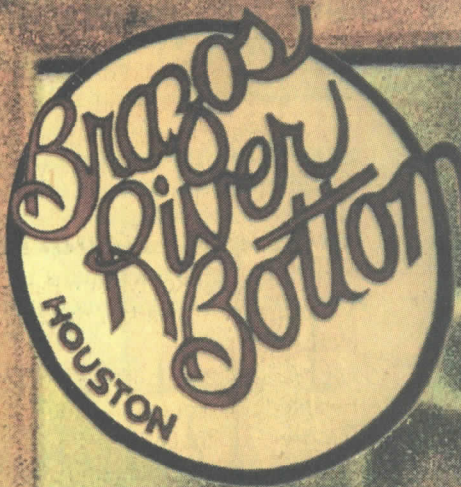

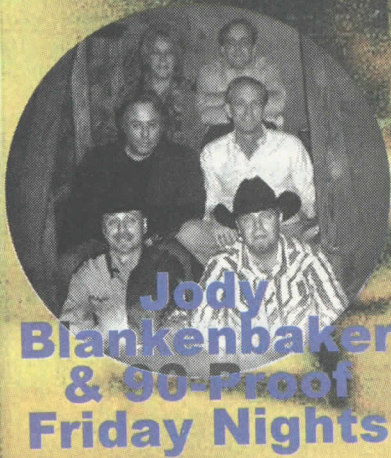

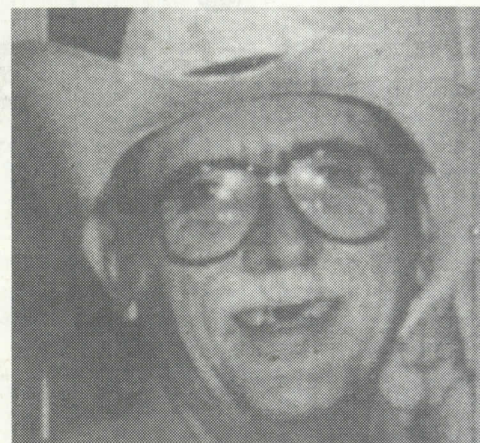
And that's the case here. They accused Starbucks of being (oh the shame of it) "liberal" and promoting the homosexual "agenda."
