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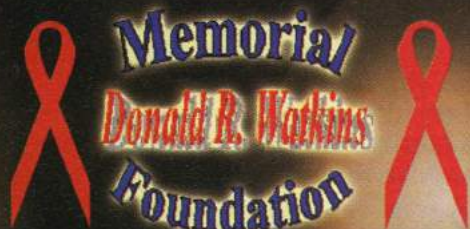
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he says, "Contrary to what you may have read, it is a famous Brit with a title."

Kelsey Grammer has attracted the attentions of many fans over the years — but he was most touched by the advances of one gay fan.

The Virgin Islands-born *Frasier* star, married to model Camille Donatucci, explains that when he was a rising actor, he was sent a lengthy romantic note from a man who was instantly attracted to him after seeing him perform on stage.

Grammer says, "I had a wonderful fan letter once in my life from a man whose obvious proclivity was for other men."

"I was a young man at the time, I was 25 years old. I had just appeared on Broadway in *MacBeth* at the Lincoln Center.

"He wrote a magnificent letter, it was like three pages long, quoting from the play about how he would like to o'er-leap the third row so that he could be in my arms."

But, alas, his fan's advances were left unanswered.

Grammer explains, "I was very touched and flattered, but I didn't acknowledge his letter — I thought that was best. It's not my thing — I like girls."

Billy Joel and Elton John's Piano Men tour is back on now that the *New Yorker's* made a full recovery from a car crash that put him in hospital last month.

Producers and fans feared the accident would prompt the cancellation of some dates, but Joel's management has confirmed the tour will begin, as planned, in Alabama on February 21.

The "Uptown Girl" star crashed into a fire hydrant near his Long Island home on January 25 and sustained facial bruises.

There were also reports the singer checked into a drug and alcohol abuse treatment centre immediately after the accident — and was said to be suffering from depression.

But Joel's agent, Dennis Arfa, says, "The crash was a non-event. Billy's fine and everything is as normal."

The joint tour is the most successful co-headlining venture ever.

Russian pop duo Tatu have hit back at critics of their lesbian antics — insisting that "everything is normal if it's love."

The "All the Things She



Said" hitmakers are currently riding a wave of popularity in Europe — but have sparked furious controversy with their video, which shows the two girls dressed in school uniforms kissing and fondling each other.

But the group insist what people think of them isn't a priority.

Lena Kativa says, "We don't care! We want to say to anybody that they shouldn't be afraid of their feelings. This is the message. If it's real feeling, why not? If you love then it doesn't matter if girl loves girl, or boy loves boy or girl loves boy. It doesn't matter."

"It's just love and we shouldn't be afraid of this crowd's opinion. Stupid things."

Despite media reports that the girl's romantic relationship is just a media stunt, Tatu insist that their love is for real, and that they've been dating for four or five years.

Lena adds, "It was love and it is love for a long time."
