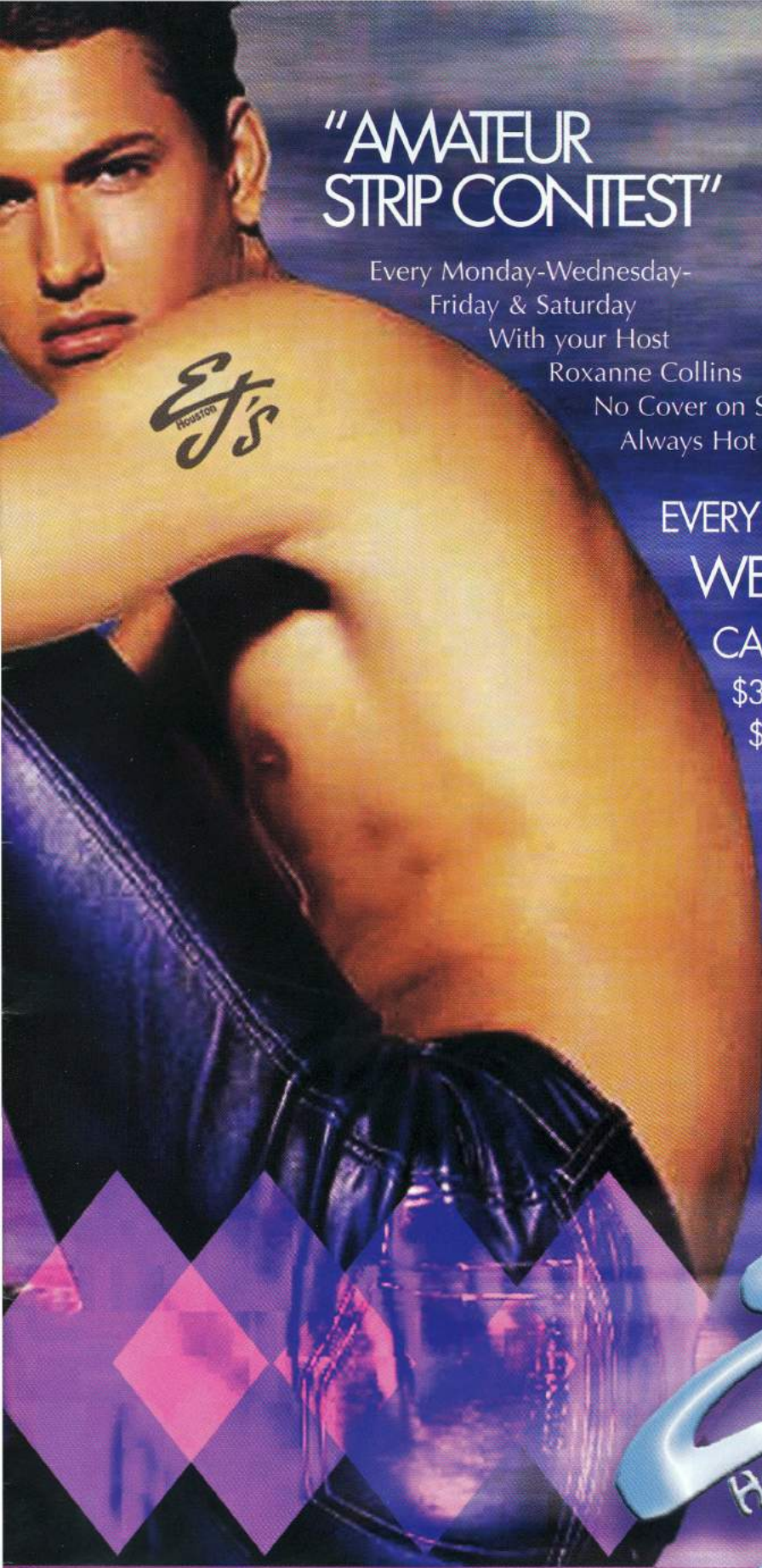
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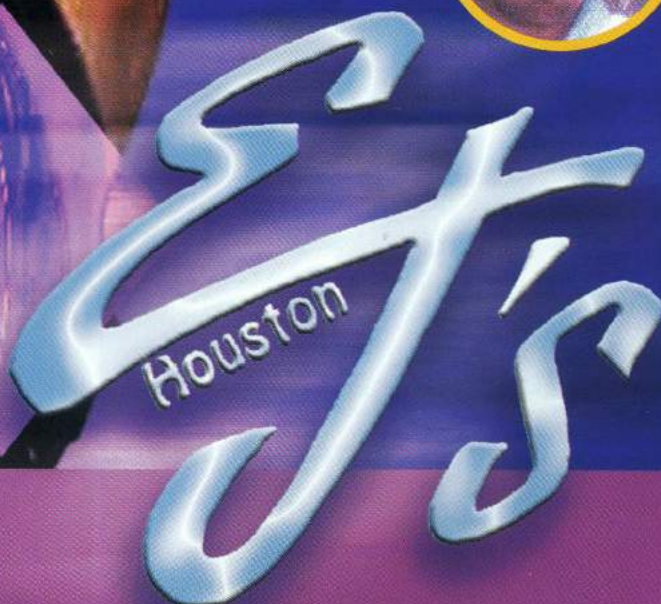

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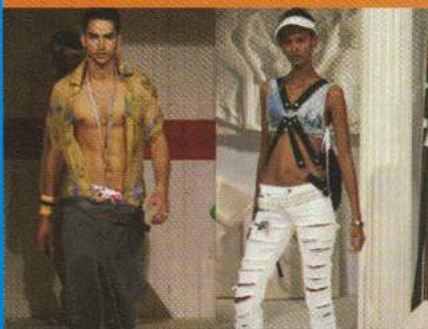

The play is an unauthorized take on Heche's book, which features 14 actresses "performing" passages from the autobiography. Included in the show are

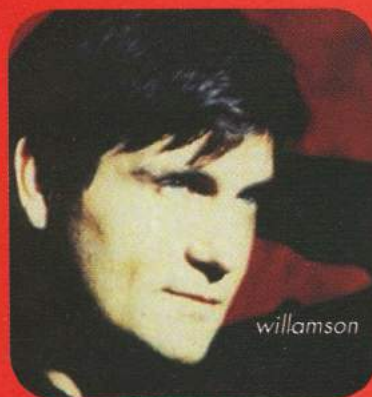

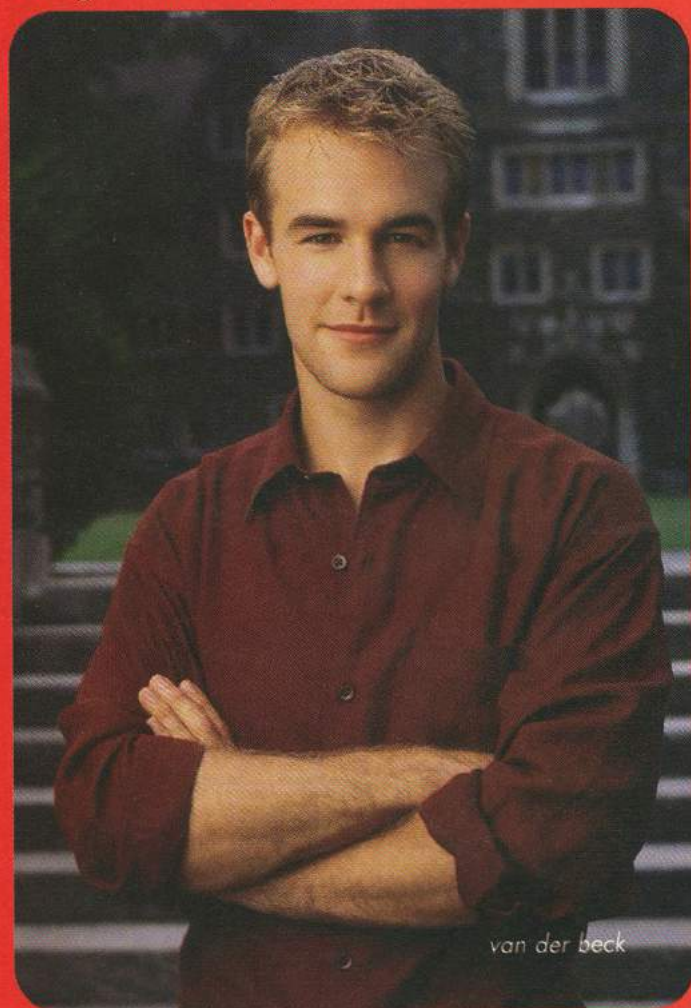

One of gay Houston's largest annual events, this year's 30th annual Let Us Entertain You weekend (LUEY) is sure to be a blowout.

The festivities, always held on the weekend after Fat Tuesday and designed to allow participants to continue partying post-Mardi Gras, is sponsored by the Houston Council of Clubs. The Council has seen varying membership over the years, but this Council currently is composed of 12 area levi-leather organizations that are helping to stage this weekend's LUEY.

Let Us Entertain You weekend kicked off last night with a pre-registration event at E/J's, with cocktails sponsored by Lancers MC, Space City Empire and the Wretches.

Formal registration gets underway Friday at 8 p.m. at Mary's, and LUEY continues through Sunday (see schedule).

The original LUEY weekend was created by a group called the Texas Riders. Over the years the event has grown, with various local clubs joining in to sponsor the run, which the Council says has included as many as 833 registered guests from 29 states and five foreign countries.



Many years after the first LUEY — no one seems exactly sure of the date — the Council added the Show of Shows, the capstone event followed by an After-LUEY Party which concludes the weekend. The Show of Shows, held on

Sunday afternoon, involves participation from members of all the Council's clubs and features a wide range of entertainment.

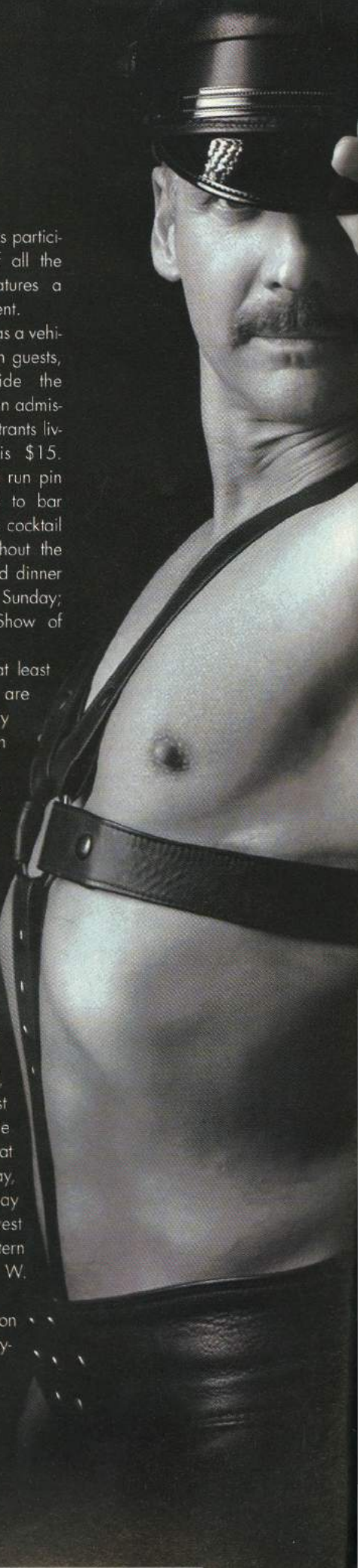
Since it was designed as a vehicle to entertain out-of-town guests, participants from outside the Houston area never pay an admission fee. The fee for registrants living in Harris County is \$15. Registrants get an official run pin and are granted access to bar hops; Friday night snacks; cocktail parties scheduled throughout the run; breakfast, snacks and dinner on Saturday; brunch on Sunday; and admission to the Show of Shows.

Participants must be at least 21 years old, and are required to wear or carry the LUEY run pin to each event.

Pre-registration was limited to the first 800 applicants. Registration is available during the event, both at the Friday evening registration party at Mary's and again on Saturday morning at Michael's Outpost. On-site registration is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

For afterhours action, check out the three host hotels. They include the Rodeway Inn Southwest at 3135 Southwest Freeway, Best Western Greenway Plaza, 2929 Southwest Freeway and Best Western Downtown, 915 W. Dallas St.
