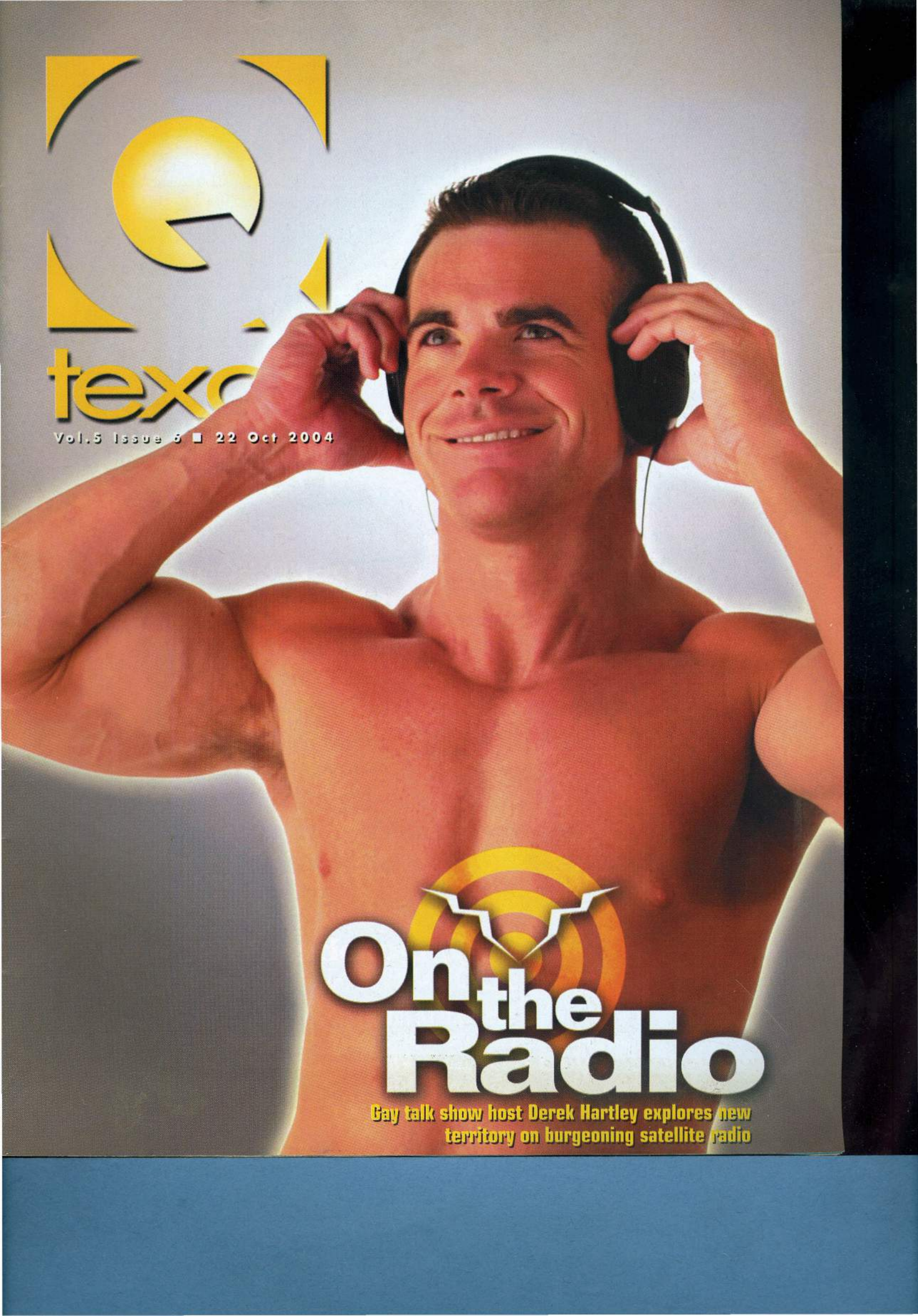




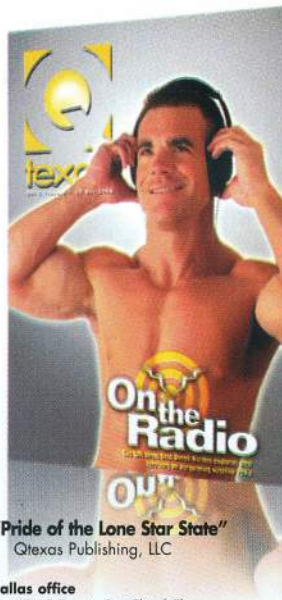

On the Radio

Gay talk show host Derek Hartley explores new territory on burgeoning satellite radio

Radio's gay shock jock

derek Hartley began writing for the gay press in 1995, but it wasn't until 1997 that he made a big splash. That was when his column, "Fantasy Man Island," started appearing on the Web site Planetout.com. His writing has since been seen in national publications such as *Unzipped*, *Genre*, *Hero*, *On Our Backs* and *Out and About*.

Hartley's profile continued to grow as he moved from print to broadcasting. He co-hosts *The Derek and Romaine Show*, which airs daily on Sirius Satellite Radio as part of its Out Q programming lineup. Hartley and Romaine Patterson's gabfest addresses everything from courtship and relationship advice to no-holds-barred discussions about S&M, fetishes, the leather scene — and countless other hot button issues. The language can be tough and the topics bizarre and daring, which has even earned Hartley the label "gay shock jock." While it has elicited both praise and condemnation, one thing is certain: *The Derek and Romaine Show* is rarely dull. Talking with Hartley, it's easy to see why.

Qtexas: How did you come up with the title "Fantasy Man Island" for your column?

Derek Hartley: I wanted to call the column "Boy World." AOL, which is a Planetout partner, had concerns about the use of the word "boy." "Man World" sounded like a porn company. So one day I just kind of came up with it "Fantasy Man Island." I liked creating an idea in people's heads of a mythical place that was filled with cute guys where I was the intrepid reporter inside that world, giving people the lowdown on it. The original idea expanded over time because I

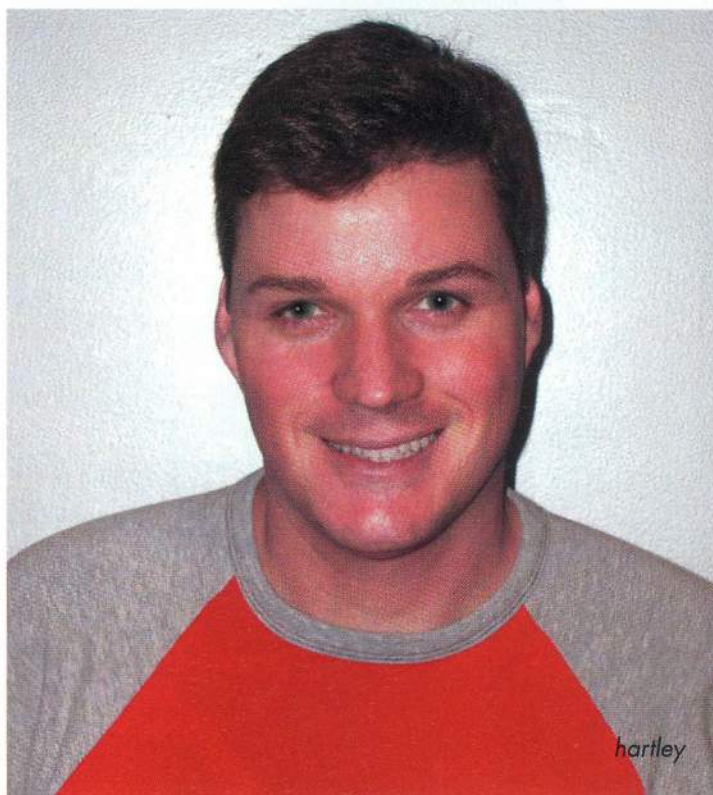
was more interested in talking about myself than other people. But it worked out okay because talking about myself turned into a radio show.

Q: What advice do you give people who are looking to date or searching for a relationship?

A: The best place to meet someone is doing the activities that you love, whatever those might be. You're so much more likely to meet

Q: What's your take on gay cruises?

A: This actually came up on our show. Someone was going on a cruise and I said to him, "Don't sleep with anybody on the first two days." The first day you get there it's like, "Wow, all of these guys are so cute, he's hot, blah, blah, blah." But the next morning you wake up, and they're all there at breakfast! Then they're all there at lunch. By dinner you realize that



someone who shares your interests by going out and doing the things that you most enjoy. And for most people, their interest is really not sitting online for six hours a night. If people get out of their homes and do more things like joining a sports team or going to a church, they are more likely to meet someone who is like them.

you can't leave and go someplace else to meet new people. So for the sake of your sanity and your reputation — and to ensure that you'll enjoy the rest of your trip — you should let things shake out for the first couple of days and figure out who the flighty people are and who are the people with the bad reputations. Word gets around pretty fast on a gay cruise. Then

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you can make a wiser choice about whom to sleep with. You don't want to sleep with someone who winds up being a huge embarrassment. Then you have the shame of having slept with him.

Q: Circuit parties: A valid place to meet men or just an excuse to get tweaked and have sex?

A: Gay people sure do love their fantasies! Circuit parties are our version of Disneyland. It's such an escape from reality, and what kills me about circuit parties is that

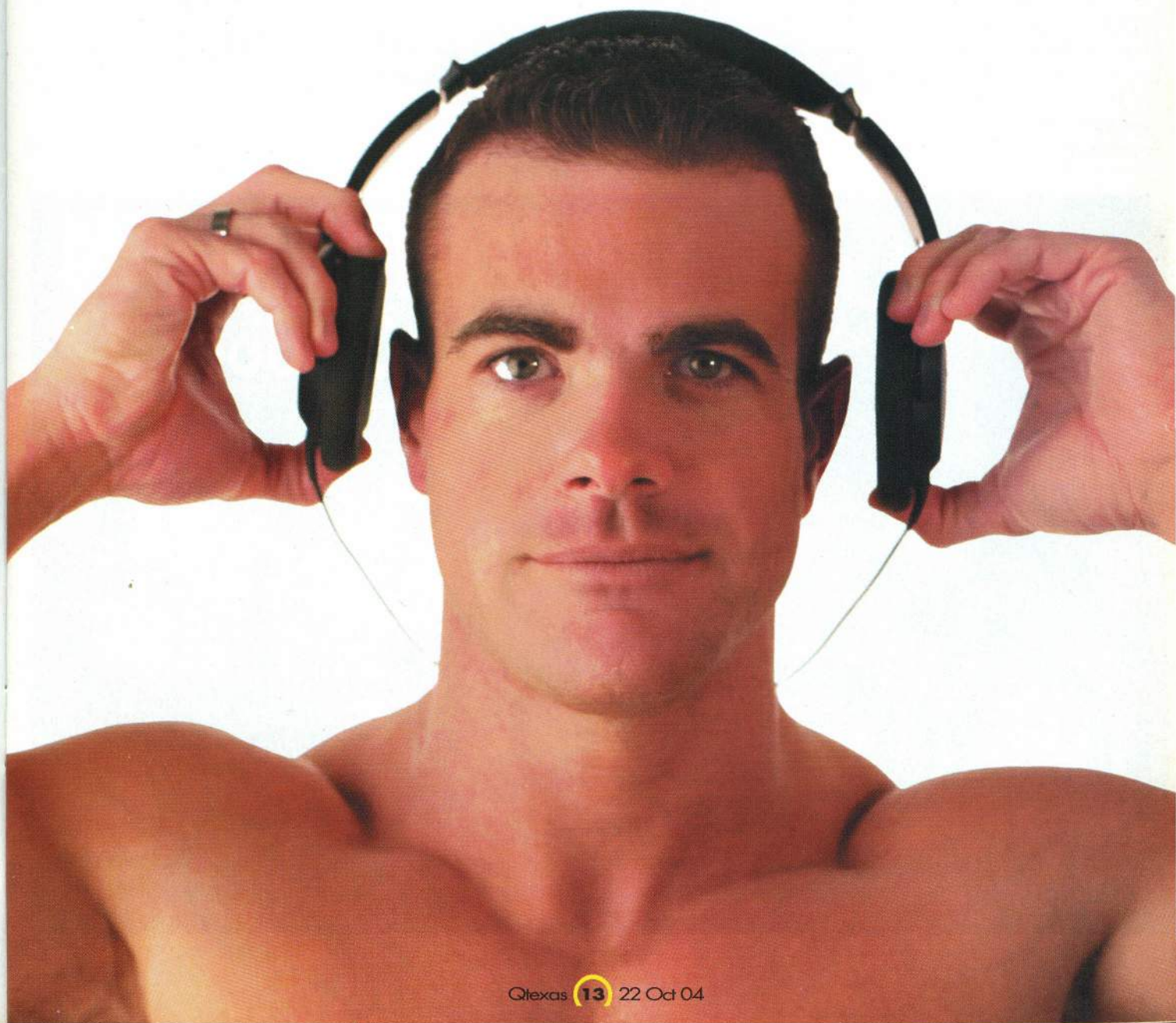
so many of the people who go to them are white-collar professionals — doctors, lawyers, the kind of people that you would least think would be dancing on a table with their shirt off and having sex with four guys at the same time. But part of the attraction is that I think they are looking for an escape from their lives, a release, and from that standpoint I can understand. I'm concerned about the drug use and the unsafe sex, but people need to let off steam. It's not for everyone. For dating, I think it's probably the

worst of all places to meet someone. At a circuit party, people are in fantasy mode, and relationships are not about fantasy — relationships are about reality. Most relationships that break up early on do so because of this conflict between fantasy and reality.

Q: In your experience, is it easier for lesbians to maintain long-term relationships than it is for gay men?

A: It certainly seems that way. I think that part of the reason for it

is the nature of women versus the nature of men. Many more women than men — but not all — are more interested in nesting. Even in such venues as lesbian love circles, they end up dating one another and passing girlfriends on to past girlfriends who are now their best friends. I think that women are more comfortable in their sexuality, more at ease with themselves and thus are better equipped to have those kinds of stable relationships where an ex can turn into a best friend who can turn into



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somebody who introduces you to somebody else that you date. Gay men are far more territorial, far more jealous and we're far less likely to be okay with our best friend being our ex-boyfriend. Maybe it's just about being a gay man; maybe it's about the culture that we create for ourselves.

Q: How do you feel about your hate mail?

A: I love it! At first I didn't like it, but then I started to embrace it. Since I get an enormous amount of it, if I didn't love it I'd have to get out of this business.

Q: Who is the audience for *The Derek and Romaine Show*?

A: Most of the mail that I get

right now from my column is from 19, 20, 21 year olds, because all they think about is dating. They only care about dating and they're obsessed with it, so they can't wait to read my column and find out what I have to say. Seriously, it's their whole world. I hope that when I'm 60, my whole world won't be about dating.

Q: You have a book coming out very soon called *None the Wiser*.

A: I do. It's going to be a collection of essays that focus basically on life and sex. There's going to be some past columns of mine that are going to be incorporated into it and also some new material. But it's largely a collection of my columns.

Q: What was the most outrageous segment you have ever aired on your show?

A: We had the porn star Michael Brandon on our show. And he has a very large 10-inch penis. And he took it out and got it hard and was thumping it on the counter during the show. And then Romaine was grabbing it. She's a lesbian but she's obsessed with men's chests and penises. So we got some photos of Romaine grabbing Michael Brandon's penis. He has a name for it; it's called "the monster." And he kept insisting that we call it "the cock." And so we probably had the word "cock" on our radio show 40 or 50 times in an hour. That was probably a little excessive. Actually people

called in and they loved it. But we caused quite a bit of a stir. On another show we had Inga Muscio talking about her book, *Cunt*. We used this word about 30 times in that hour, and the word is kind of a lightning rod for people. And we were encouraging people to go to Barnes & Noble and go up to the head salesperson and say, "Excuse me, do you have *Cunt*?"

The Derek and Romaine Show can be heard weeknights from 6 to 9 p.m. on Sirius Satellite Radio's Out Q.

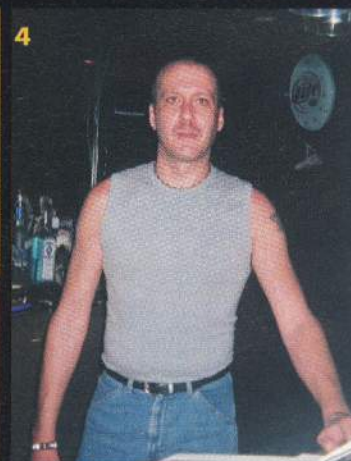
Man's Rich Pageant — Mr. Inergy 2004, a direct preliminary to Mr. Texas USofA, arrives on Sunday, October 24.

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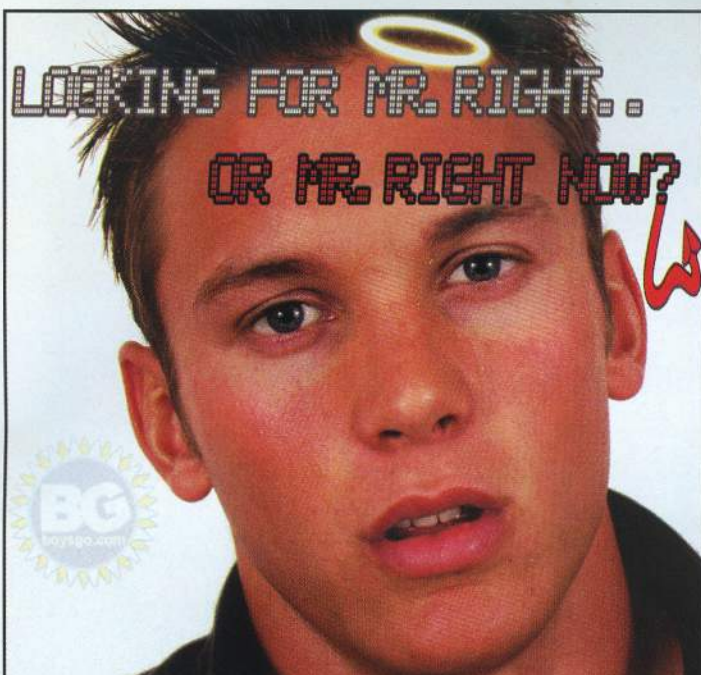

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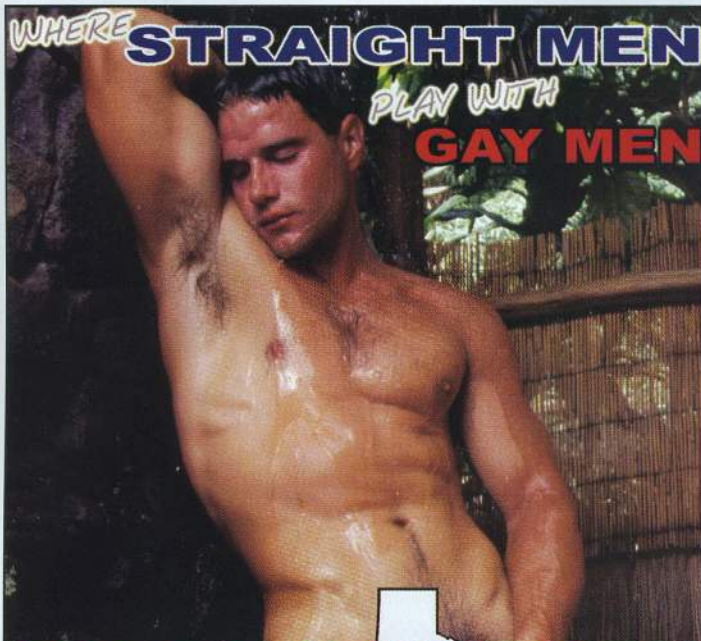
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
