Austin will remember those that we've lost to AIDS over the past year on **Sunday, May 18** as part of this year's **AIDS Candlelight Memorial Services** at **Republic Square Park** starting at 7:30 PM, feature speakers, remembrances, music, prayers and more. The event which also features panels from the AIDS Memorial Quilt on display is free and open to the public.

**Rebecca Havemeyer** hosts her **Sound of Music Sing-A-Long** at the **Paramount Theatre** ☉ on **Saturday, May 31**, starting at 7 PM, with proceeds from ticket sales benefiting **AIDS Services of Austin**.
