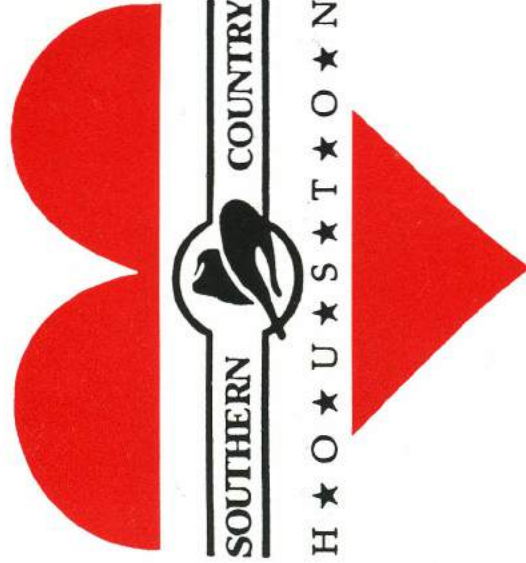

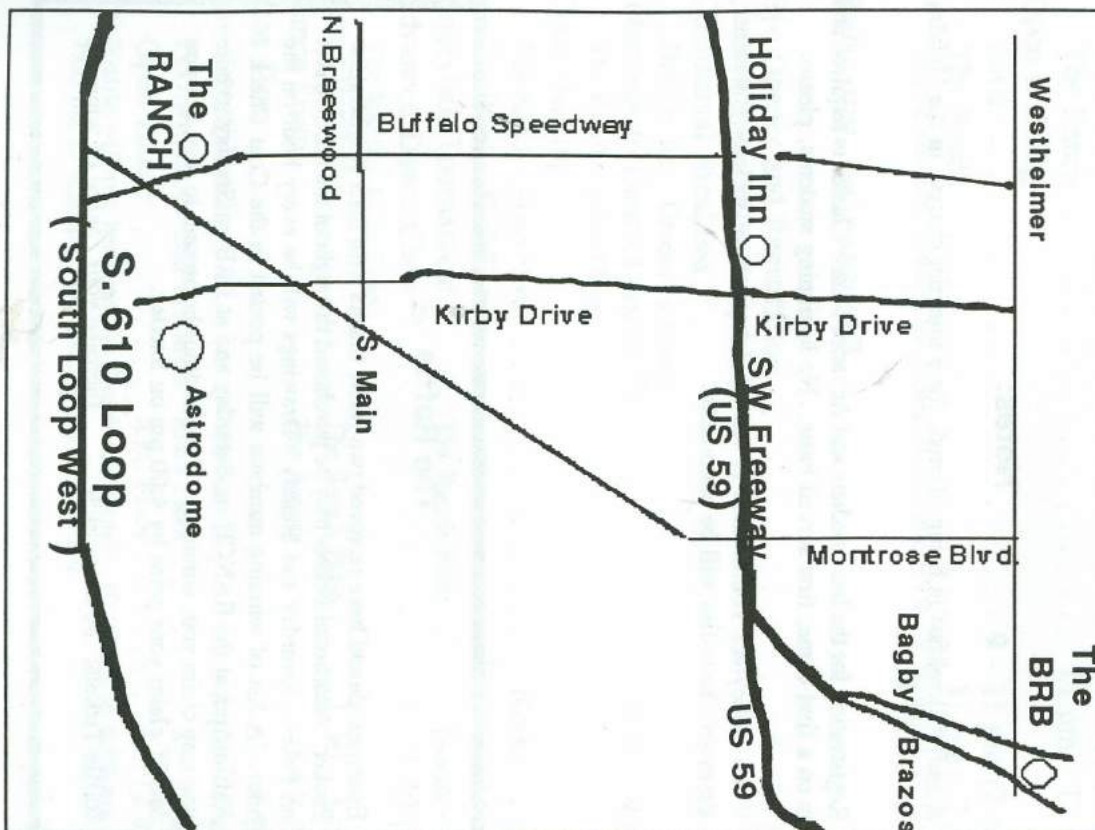

GUIDE MAP TO THE HOEDOWN

- 1) To get to the Brazos River Bottom from the hotel take US 59 North, remain in the left 2 lanes and exit Left at Downtown / Louisiana. Continue until freeway ends. This is Brazos St. The BRB is on the Left at 2400 Brazos across from Spec's Liquor. To get back to the hotel, take Bagby back to the SW Freeway (US 59) and exit Kirby.
- 2) To get to the Ranch to take the US 59 access road in front of the hotel to Buffalo Speedway and turn Left. Proceed South cautiously through the speed traps to 9200 Buffalo Speedway.

A Little Bit About Southern Country Houston

Southern Country Houston began with a small group of individuals, interested in country dancing. Some of these folks had also been members of other Southern Country chapters. Houston was officially recognized as a chapter April 11, 1992 at the national meeting in Nashville. The first dance workshops began that month at the BRB, and in May at the Ranch.

The club is a non-profit organization that functions as a 501(c)(3) charity providing monies to other community service organizations such as the Colt 45's, and AIDS Foundation Houston.

SoCo Houston has also developed a performance team that has danced for benefit functions including the Imperial Court Oktoberfest, the Metropolitan Community Church of the Resurrection Night of Song benefitting the Pastor's Benevolence Fund, as well as the Lady Victoria Lust's Christmas in July, and PWA Christmas benefits. We have also marched as a group in the Pride Parade, and walked for the AIDS Walk-a-thon raising almost \$2,000 in pledges for AIDS Foundation Houston.

The club has also had many social functions during our first year including our "Coyote Barbecue", a road trip to Austin, group functions at Astroworld and the concerts of Reba McEntire and Wynonna Judd, as well as camping at the Crystal Springs Resort in Arkansas with SoCo Memphis. There have been several road trips to regional hoedowns of other Southern Country chapters too!

Southern Country Houston is dedicated to continued service and the promotion of unity within our community. We take great pride in our role as an organization representing both the men and women of our community, and in providing an atmosphere of mutual respect and cooperation. We look forward to another great year of fun and fellowship by providing excellent instruction in the great social activity of country western dancing. We teach free dance workshops Tuesdays at the Ranch, and every Wednesday and the second and fourth Thursdays of the month at the Brazos River Bottom.

1) To get to the Brazos River Bottom from the hotel take I-10 East to the WestLoop 610 South. Exit US 59 North (Downtown), remain in the left 2 lanes and exit Left at Downtown / Louisiana. Continue until freeway ends. This is Brazos St. The BRB is on the Left at 2400 Brazos across from Spec's Liquor. To get back to the hotel, take Bagby back to the SW Freeway (US 59) and 610 North to I-10 West and exit Silber.

2) To get to the Ranch to take I-10 East to West Loop 610 South. Continue South on the Loop and exit Buffalo Speedway/South Main. Go Left on Main to Buffalo Speedway. Take a left and proceed to 9200 Buffalo Speedway.

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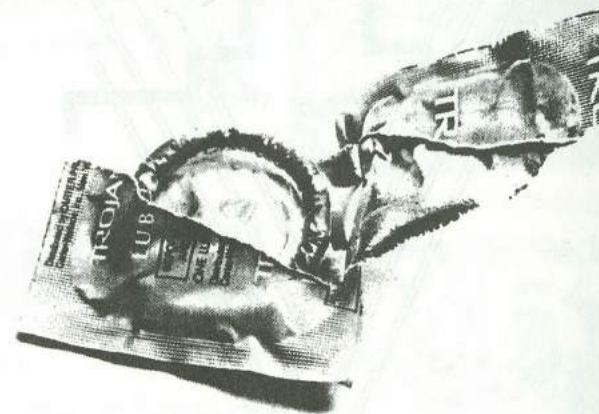
