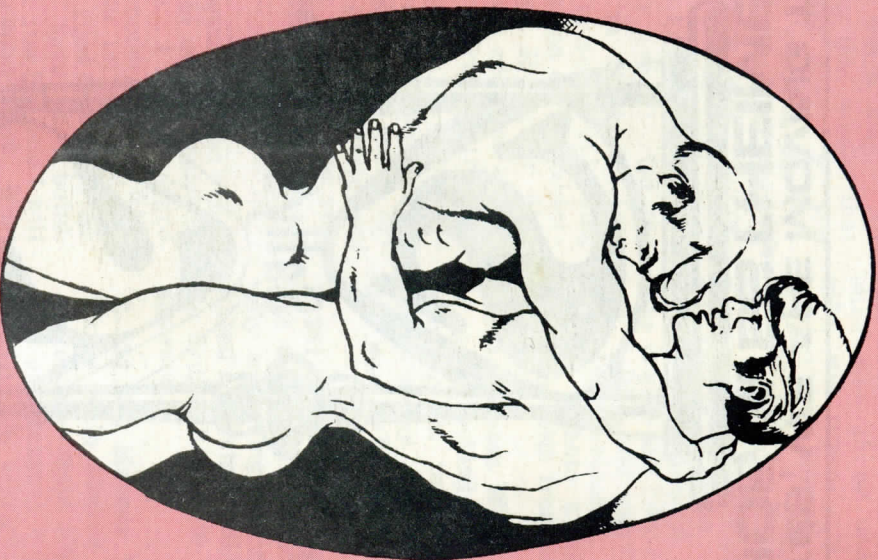

It was my pleasure to be a guest on the WildenStine show last Wednesday. The radio program is broadcast from KPFT, Pacifica Radio on Wednesday nights from 9 to 12 and is the only gay radio program in Houston.

Free speech radio does not seem like something hard to come by but in the commercial radio business the money comes from commercials and the people who pay for commercials are usually very concerned about what kind of material is broadcast on either side of their time slots. Houston has four non-commercial radio stations. Three are low powered university connected stations and the fourth is Pacifica Radio, KPFT 90.1 FM.

The idea is that listeners support the station by subscribing much like to a magazine. In return for supporting the listeners get radio like they want it. On Pacifica you hear programming that you hear nowhere else: jazz, drug information and of course Wilden Stine the gay community program.

WildenStine is aired each Wednesday evening and if produced by gay people for the general listening audience. Ray Hill plays host most evenings while Jay Thomas controls the switches and production. Regulars on WildenStine are Katy Feller, Rita Wanstrom and representatives from various organizations and covers topics of interest to gay people and their friends.

So please, if you can send for your subscription now, not every place in the U.S.A. can you have this type of service for the gay community.

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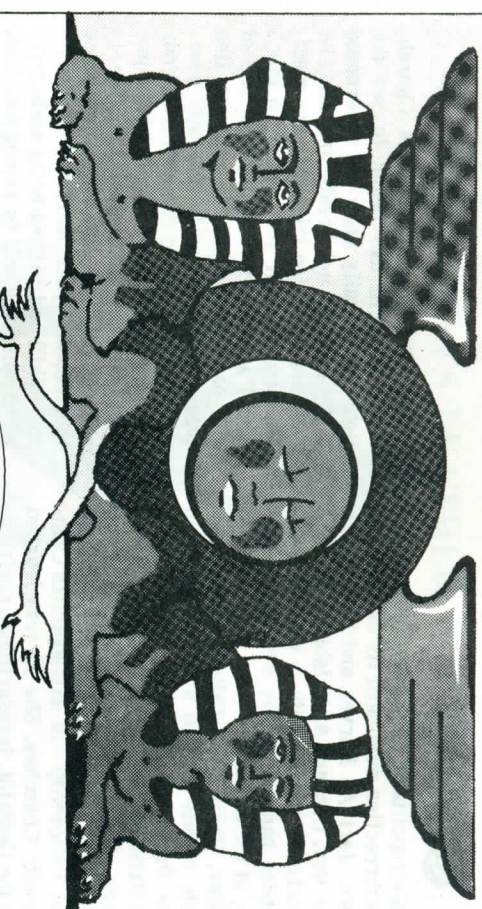

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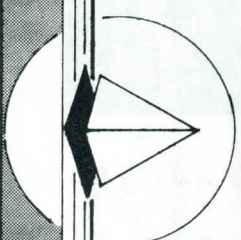

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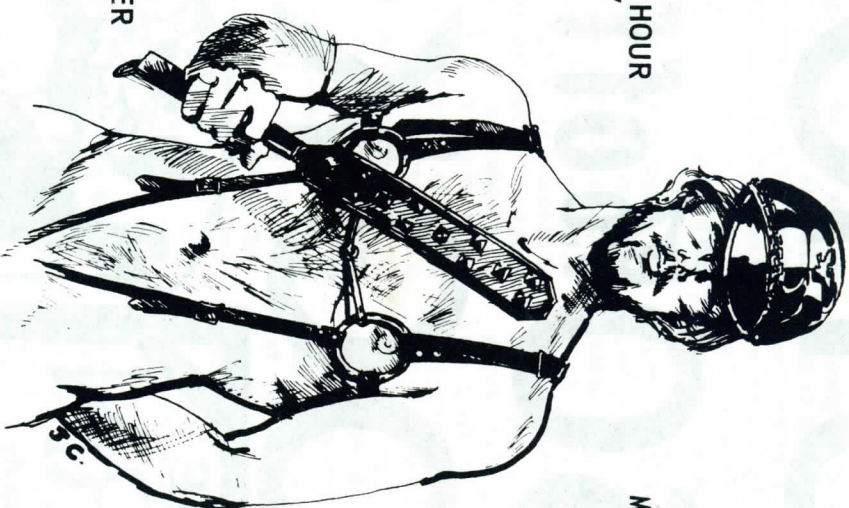

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IS COMING

Gourmet Cooking



Winter is upon us. Its time when we usually stay at home and entertain. The meals we serve during this period are heavier and one of my favorites is pork.

How many times have you heard that pork must be cooked for a long time. This would destroy the parasites that can be passed to man which can cause the disease known as trichinosis. True, this can still be found and passed to man in pork which is not cooked to an internal temperature of 137 de. I have tried pork at 145 de. and found it to be less tasteful than pork that is cooked to an internal temperature of 180 de. This doneness will appear gray with a slight glow of pink to the eye.

Pork is usually considered self basting due to the fat content. A roast should be cooked slowly no matter what method you use. This slow cooking will give most foods a chance to develop their true flavor. The following is my favorite pork dinner.

Tomato Soup and Parsley
Roasted Pork and Turnips
Onions and Apple Casserole
Gingerbread with Sweetened Whipped Cream.

This meal is very easy to prepare. Try this recipe for the roasted pork.

3lbs bonless pork roast (loin)
4T cooking oil
2 cloves of unpeeled garlic
4 parsley sprigs
1/2 bay leaf
1/4 t thyme
Salt, pepper, sage to taste
6 Turnips
1/2 cup white wine
parsley to decorate

Let the meat set at room temperature for one hour. Preheat the oven to 325 de. Put the cooking oil in a stove top oven casserole and set over moderate high heat. Brown the roast quickly and

thoroughly in the hot oil. Pour off half of the grease after the roast has been removed from the pan. Stir in the garlic (optional) and herbs. Cover and simmer for a few minutes. Place the meat on the herbs. (Usually sprinkle salt, pepper, and sage over the top at this point but it is not necessary). Cover the casserole, heat slowly for five minutes on top of the stove. Place in the oven and cook for one hour.

Place peeled, quartered turnips, which have been cooked for three minutes in boiling salted water, around the roast and re-cover. Cook for one hour longer and baste the turnips with pan drippings every fifteen minutes.

Remove roast and turnips to a hot platter. DEGREASE the liquid remaining in the casserole and pour in the wine. Place over high heat and boil for two minutes. Serve the meat and turnips.

While the meat is cooking, slice four apples and four onions, eight slices of bacon and toss 1/2 cup of soft bread crumbs in two tablespoons of bacon grease. Place the apples, onions and bacon in layers alternating layers in a greased casserole. Combine 1/2 teaspoon of salt with 3/4 cups of beef bouillon and pour into casserole. Cover Place in oven as soon as pork roast is removed and raise oven temperature to 375 de. Cook for 30 minutes. Sprinkle bread crumbs over the top of the casserole and return to oven for 15 minutes Uncovered.

Serve this with a white Cotes de Rhone or Lancers Rose. Eat slowly and enjoy--guaranteed to warm the body.

Gay studies is not a new idea. Many professionals academicians have played with the notion for years. Lou Compton of the University of Nebraska was the first to formalize regularly scheduled courses in the field. Since then the idea has become quite popular with many major universities.

The offering at the U of H began as a function of the Campus Activities Department in June, 1976. The first course was a general gay studies course called "The Homosexual Experience." To the selection this semester are two new courses: "Gay History" and "Homosexual Reality for Police and other Bureaucrats."

"Homosexual Experience" is a course designed to teach gay people the many positive aspects about themselves and the subculture they collectively make, and teach non-gay people the worth of their gay friends.

"Gay History" covers the attitudes toward gay persons in Western Civilization from Classic Greece to present with contact on significant gay people in history.

"Homosexual Reality for Police and Other Bureaucrats" if offered to provide a quick easy way for people in public service to learn how to work with gay people with the same ease they work with others.

The courses are non credited and are all taught at night on U of H Central Campus. The cost is much lower than regular college courses (Registration will begin Feb. 1, 1977 and close Feb. 7. For information call 749-1253. Pick up a Sundry School Catalogue at your local public library or MCC.

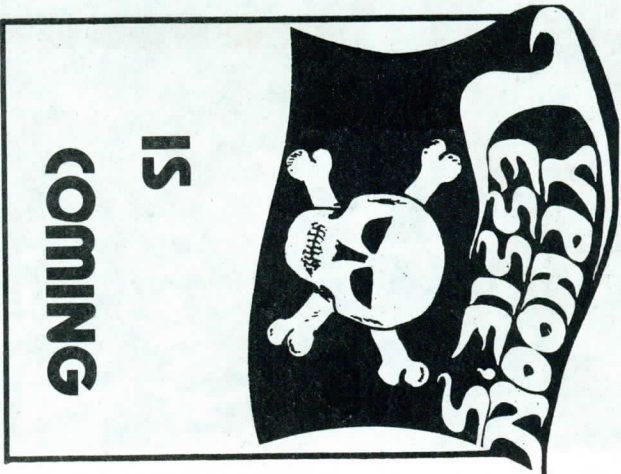
Miss Shanda Mae

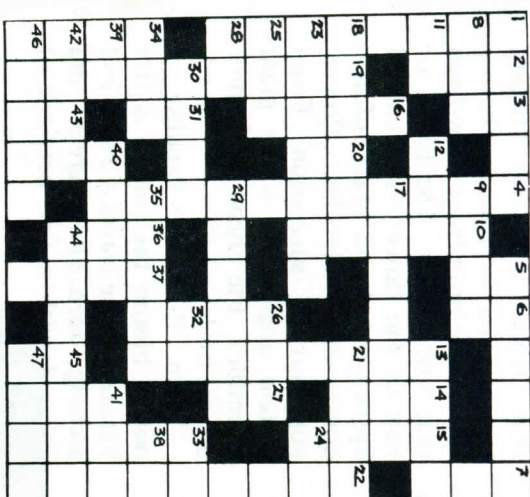

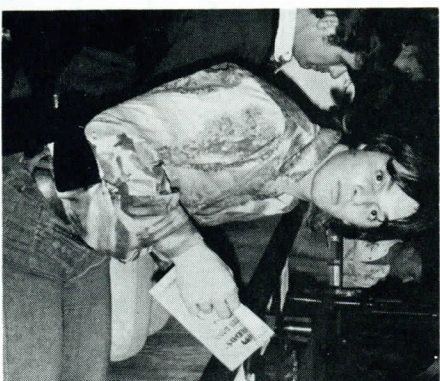
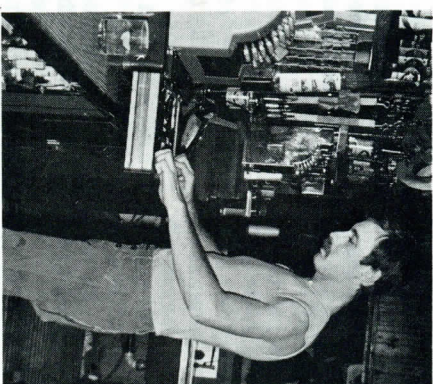
Bird of Paradise (*Strelitzia reginae*) is a member of the banana family; the resemblance is easy to see in the leaves. It is native to South Africa where there are several other species. Some of these are huge tree-like plants and others are smaller and grass-like. Bird of Paradise reaches about five feet in height. It is an exotic and interesting plant. The one I own was a gift from a friend and flowered the first year. Usually Bird of Paradise is stubborn about blooming. It generally takes ten or more slow growing leaves to make each flower. The nice thing about it is

that when a bloom finally appears, you can count on having almost two months of show from that one flower. The bract, or base of the flower, is green and lipstick red. As the bract unfolds, orange and violet blue flowers pop out in succession. From certain angles the whole plant resembles the head of some bizarre bird.

When Bird of Paradise is not in bloom the foliage is still beautiful. The leaves are stiff and arching, deep bluish green, and covered with a fine network of veins.

The only important need of the Bird of Paradise plant is sun. It needs a south facing window in the winter and is happy in a temperature range of 50-70 degrees. The thick leaves and fat roots store water and require a drink only when the soil is quite dry.

OCCULT



'Supernatural' is a convenient word for a huge area of human speculation about things believed to exist beyond the threshold of our ordinary day to day existence, our normal trudging journey from birth to death. John Wesley, the great preacher whose eloquence sent some of his hearers into ecstatic convulsions, believed that he showed his flock 'the demonstrative evidence of things unseen, the supernatural evidence of things invisible, not preceivable by the eyes of flesh nor by any of our natural senses or faculties.'

The supernatural includes cases in which the normal order of nature appears to have been momentarily upset; miracles, for example; or the appearance of an other worldy being in visible form; or levitation, the ability to rise from the ground and hover above it unsupported. Like the famous St. Joseph of Cupertino in the 17th century who was always shooting up into the air, much to the embarrassment of himself and his ecclesiastical superiors.

But the supernatural also includes the operation of forces which are perfectly natural but whose workings are not generally admitted or understood. When man long ago saw lightning, they thought it supernatural and ascribed it to the Gods. We know that they were wrong in thinking it non-natural but right in observing its existence.

Similarly, a hundred years ago, those who observed the existence of the strange powers of the human mind which we call extra-sensory perception or telepathy or clairvoyance, often thought they had discovered something supernatural. Science today shows us there is evidence to support the fact that these powers do exist and that they are natural and people in the past were wrong to think of them as anything else.

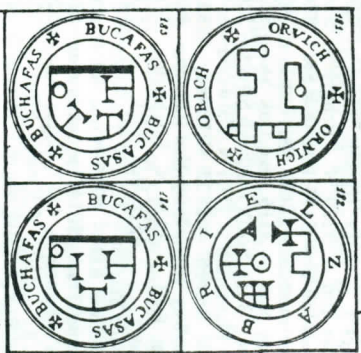

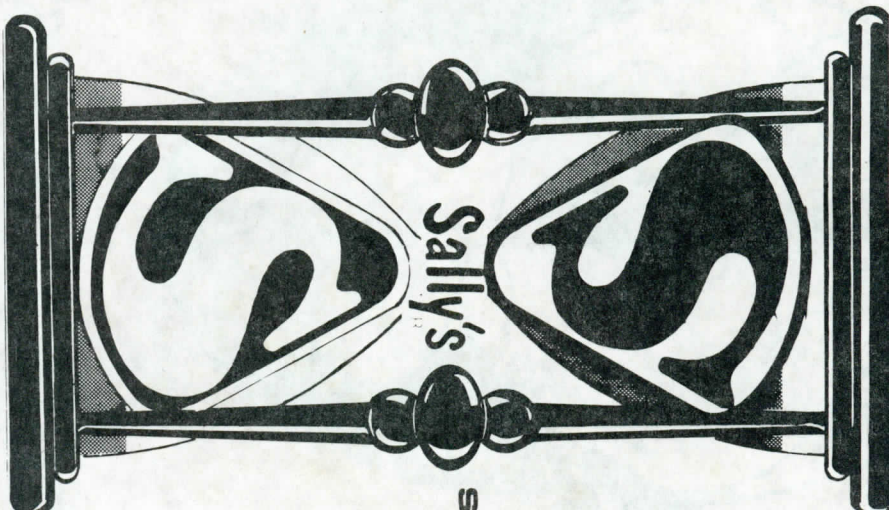
