The OP in Houston will feature a special appearance by Claude Sacha as part of the OP Sunday Night Follies.

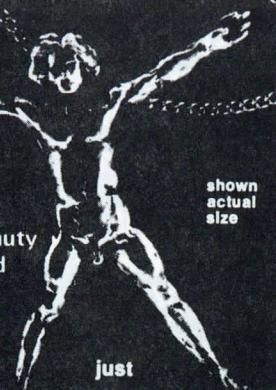
The Ventru-N will have a Taurus birthday celebration Sunday.
