Danny Williams returns again this year as our Master of Ceremonies. After seeing how hard we work and the amount of money that we raise for local AIDS charities, he was quick to volunteer his services again. "I'm thrilled to return for a *third* year," he says, "although I was *awfully* busy as MC at Bear events throughout the United States."

Danny also just finished his 68th RSVP Cruise. He first became known as an entertainer when he released his hit record "Castro Boy," which was the gay version of "Valley Girl." He began performing as a stand-up comic at the legendary Valencian Rose. Since then, he's entertained audiences in over 25 states and Canada and is featured in the book, "A Funny Time to be Gay."

Danny has been honored with many awards including the Cable Car Award for Entertainer of the Year, Bay Area Gold Award, Outstanding Male Comic, for three years and the Gay Community Award, Male Entertainer of the Year, for six years. He has also been

recognized for his community work with the Harvey Milk Award, John L. Wasserman Award and was named by the Oakland Tribune as an unsung hero.

In addition to stand-up comedy, he is also one of the most sought-after performers in the community as an MC for such events as International Mr. Leather and Mr. Hotlanta. From 1989 thru 1996, he has been the host and MC for all RSVP Cruises and Land Programs where he has worked with such performers as Michael Feinstein, Harvey Fierstein, Dianne Schuur, Jimmy James, Nell Carter, Fem 2 Fem, Mary Wilson, Thelma Houston, Pudgy, Lainie Kazan, Jane Oliver, Betty Buckley, Jennifer Holliday, Helen Reddy, Sister Sledge and Viola Wills.

Danny's comedy is deeply personal, while at the same time it touches upon feelings that are common to all. He is particularly well-known for his ability to ad-lib and play with the audience, getting them involved in the fun.

THE MISS CAMP AMERICA® FOUNDATION, INC.

The Miss Camp America® Foundation, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) organization. Our mission is to perform charitable activities to provide relief to persons distressed with the Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS); to volunteer; and to financially support AIDS organizations which help the general public and health care organizations in their care of persons who have contracted the AIDS virus. The Foundation is proud of this commitment to the Houston community.

Investigative work and study pursued over several years led to the organization being chartered in June, 1992 as the MISS CAMP AMERICA® FOUNDATION, INC., a non-profit corporation. Working in this new direction has offered the Foundation an opportunity to do what they do best in a more financially advantageous position. Since the organization's non-profit charter took effect, MCAF has contributed \$209,500 to a variety of AIDS-related charities in Houston, Texas.

The Foundation, which consists of volunteers, sponsors several yearly fundraising events — including a new associate benefit, raffle, silent auction, and pageant program, — leading up to the major fund raiser, The Miss Camp America® Pageant. This event, which utilizes Houston publications, newspapers, and radio, has a mailing to over 4,500 and a yearly attendance of 1500 - 1800 people, depending on the available location.

Each year, members of the Foundation establish a "Designated Charity Selection Committee" to interview other 501(c)(3) AIDS related charities and to select the "designated charities" for the year. The Foundation presents these grants yearly at the annual production.

For almost 30 years, the members of MCAF have been entertaining Houston at social and fund raising events including a long list of charities, organizations, and individuals. In the past twelve years, the members of Miss Camp America® have made a concerted effort to become a positive force in Houston—dealing with all the joys and sorrows, good times and bad times that have affected our community.
