The Miss Camp America® Pageant began in 1969 at an apartment in Houston, where 11 people gathered to watch the Miss America® Pageant. Ten of those attending took turns drawing one of the state names representing the top ten finalists in the pageant that year. Before the evening was over, one of them became "Miss Camp America®" by virtue of "her" state winning the title in Atlantic City, New Jersey.

That simple beginning on South Post Oak Road led to the extended guest list of 50 state representatives and more, to various bars and grills of the Montrose Arts District. During the early years, the annual pageant found winners at the corner of elegant Elgin and luscious Louisiana (now the French Quarter), the Glass Stein (now a tattoo parlor on Montrose), the Palm Center Auditorium (remodeled yet???), the defunct Texas State Hotel, and the drag bar of its day - the Hi-Kamp Club.

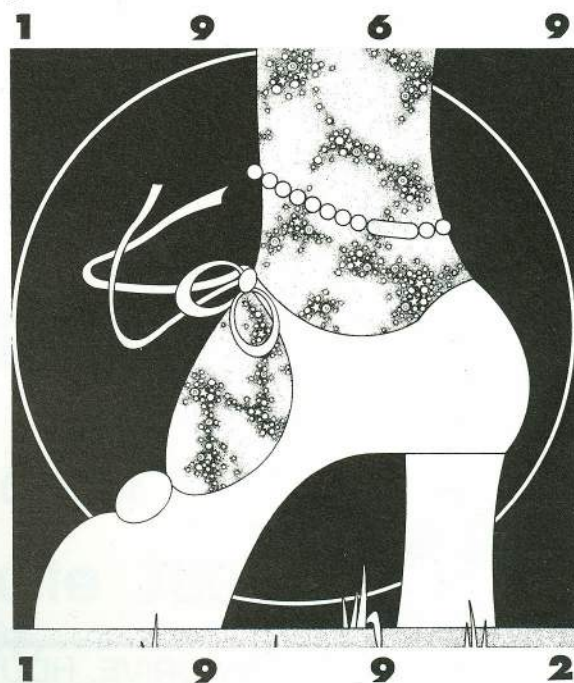
From 1976 through 1979, Miss Camp America® was crowned in the Grand Ballroom of the Sheraton Houston Hotel. From 1980 to 1987, Miss Camp America® received her crown at the Tower Theatre in the heart of Montrose. We celebrated our twentieth anniversary at the Alley Theatre and then we crowned the first Miss Camp America® of the Nineties in the Grand Ballroom of the Astro Village Hotel.

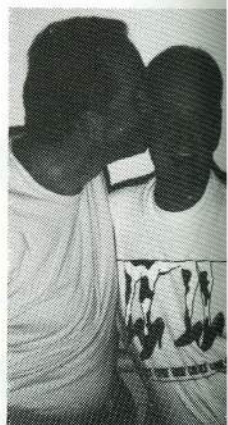
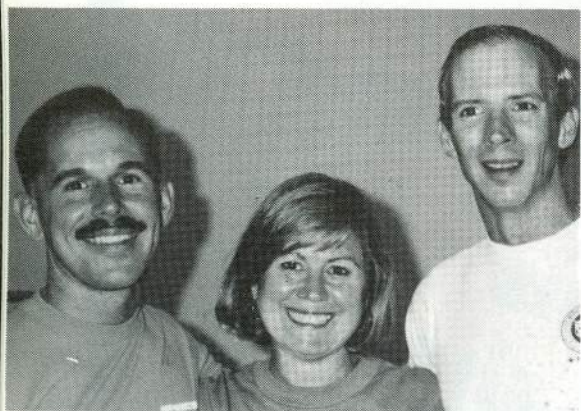
In 1990 we strutted our stuff back downtown to the Houston Civic Center and tonight another Miss Camp America® contestant will be crowned on the Music Hall stage. She'll join a group of past winners, crowned in bars, in ballrooms and on legitimate stages, who continue to help write the history of Miss Camp America®.

For the past 24 years the members of Miss Camp America® have been entertaining Houston at our own social and fundraising events as well as participating in countless events benefitting a long list of charities, organizations and individuals. In the past 10 years of Miss Camp America® we have made a concerted effort to become a positive force in Houston - dealing with all the joys and sorrows, good times and bad times that have affected our community.

Investigative work and study pursued over the past five years has finally come to fruition in 1992. We have finally been chartered as the MISS CAMP AMERICA® FOUNDATION and now a greater effort can be made to help meet all of the needs of our community. Endeavoring to become a non-profit foundation, applying for the 501(c)(3) tax exempt status under Texas statutory guidelines and working in this new direction will give us the opportunity to do what we do best in a more financially advantageous position.
