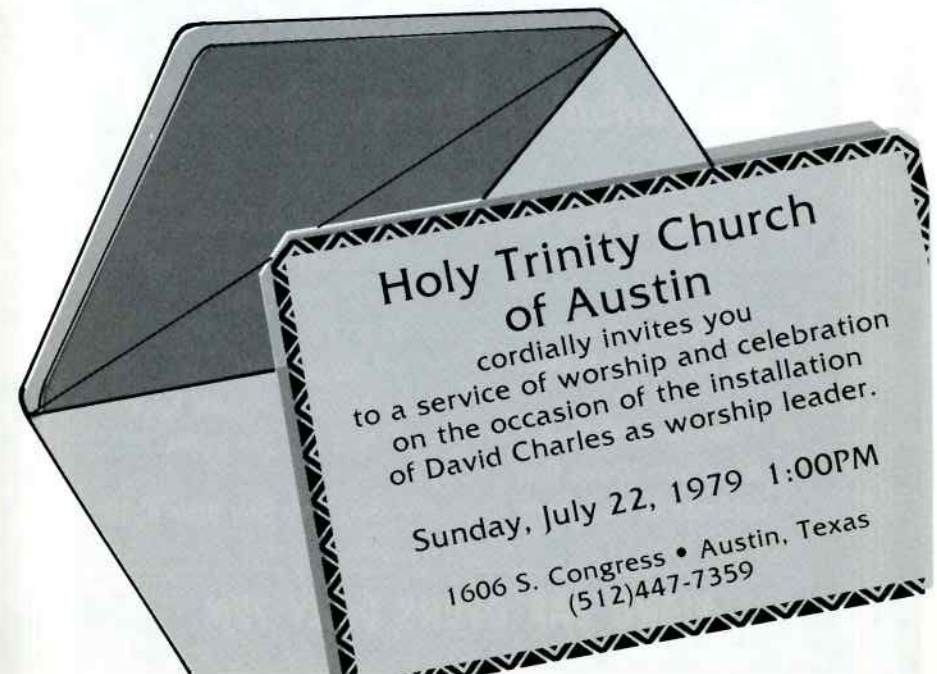
AUSTIN HOTEL FOUND GUILTY

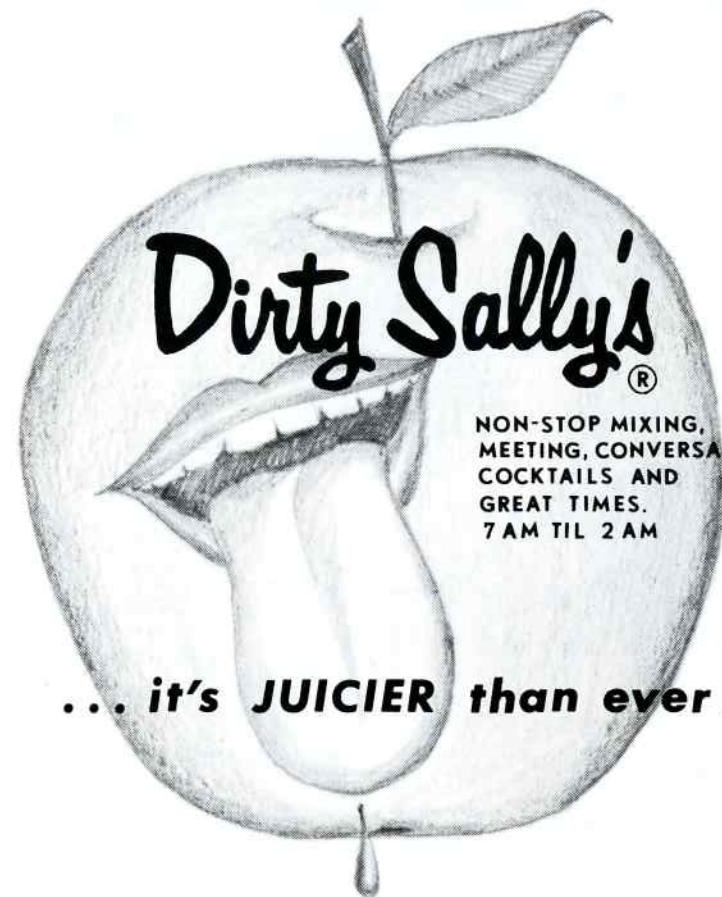

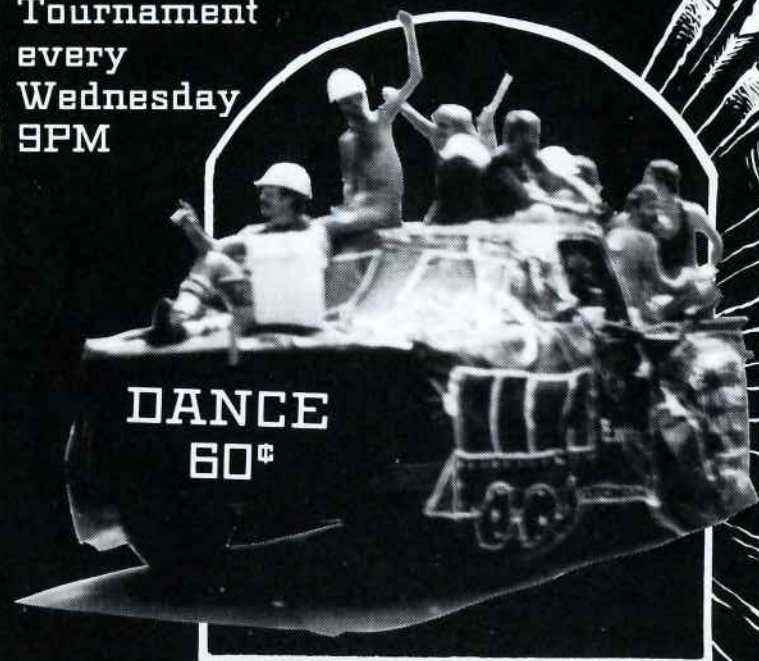

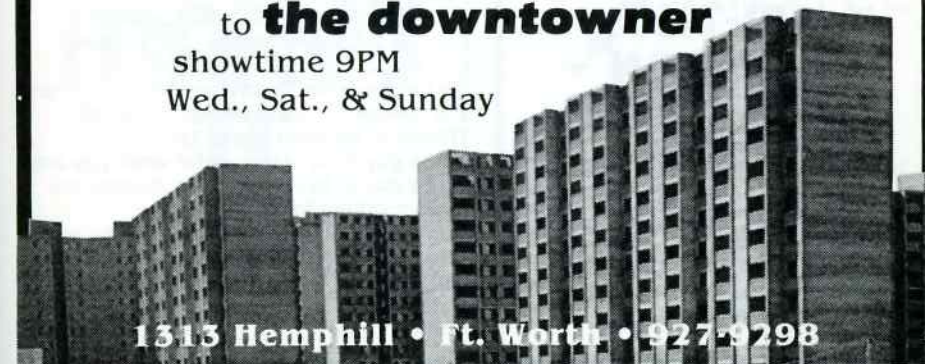

I'm not talking about a lover necessarily, but just people I can go visit occasionally, go out and dance, take rides, anything, ya know? Well, last night I had my last trick. I'm so damn tired of this "God, you're beautiful," or "I like blondes" or all those lines they give. I don't want one night stands, but

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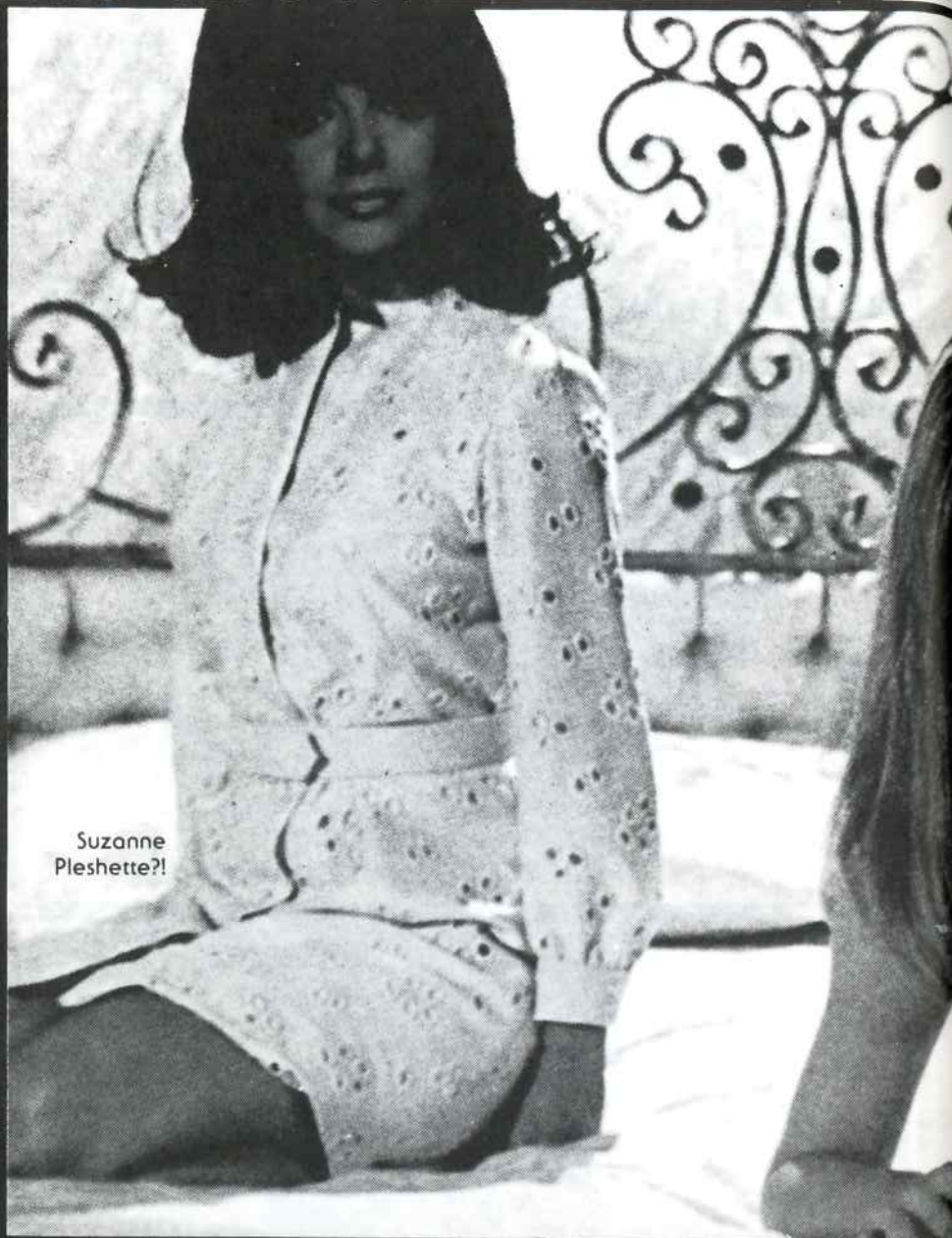

REAL DOWN IN THE VALLEY OF THE DOLLS

Perhaps taking a clue from Donna Summer, our friends at the offices of CBS Project Development recently went out in search of a little "hot

stuff." To snatch up some hot new property for the upcoming TV season. And what did they come up with? One of the hottest "snatches" of all time. I'm, of

course, talking about the trashy embrace between CBS and Twentieth Century Fox to bring "Valley of the Dolls" to the tube as a series. ➤

Everybody loves to make predictions concerning the new TV season and everybody knows how risky are those predictions. The show you thought was a sure-fire hit died on the vine, while the show you considered unfit for human consumption went on to become Number One. All against a background of broadcast lunacy unparalleled in demonstrating to one and all that nobody knows what the hell is going on.

However, when CBS issued the press release concerning "Valley of the Dolls" to the Hollywood press corp, often-burned prognosticators went out on a limb once again. It's the safest limb offered in a long time. The show has not been cast, not one foot of film has been shot, and the script probably contains the same amount of polish as a two-dollar car wash. The production company radiates an optimistic smugness often erupting into giddy laughter around the water cooler. And rightfully so.

No project in recent memory seems so destined for boffo ratings. "Valley of the Dolls" is absolutely awallow in that precious commodity so many segments of the public hold so dear — trash! You serve up a heapin' helpin' of gossip, backstabbing, bitch-fighting, show business dirt and costumes of questionable taste—whip all that up and, believe me, you WILL attract a crowd.

So strong is the show's recognized potential that ABC and NBC may pay it the ultimate compliment and not attempt to counter-program the show. In other words, the two competing networks, rather than trying to fight "Valley of the Dolls" in the rating game, may simply accept defeat and program its weak line-up links against it. Sacrifice a lamb rather than risk a big marble.

The precise form "Valley of the Dolls" will take is somewhat uncertain. Originally, it was planned to develop the project into a mini-series, totalling six hours of broadcast time, broken down into three installments of varying lengths. Then there was talk of breaking down the six hours into six one-hour episodes. Now there's talk of augmenting the series into a nine-hour package. I'll keep you posted.

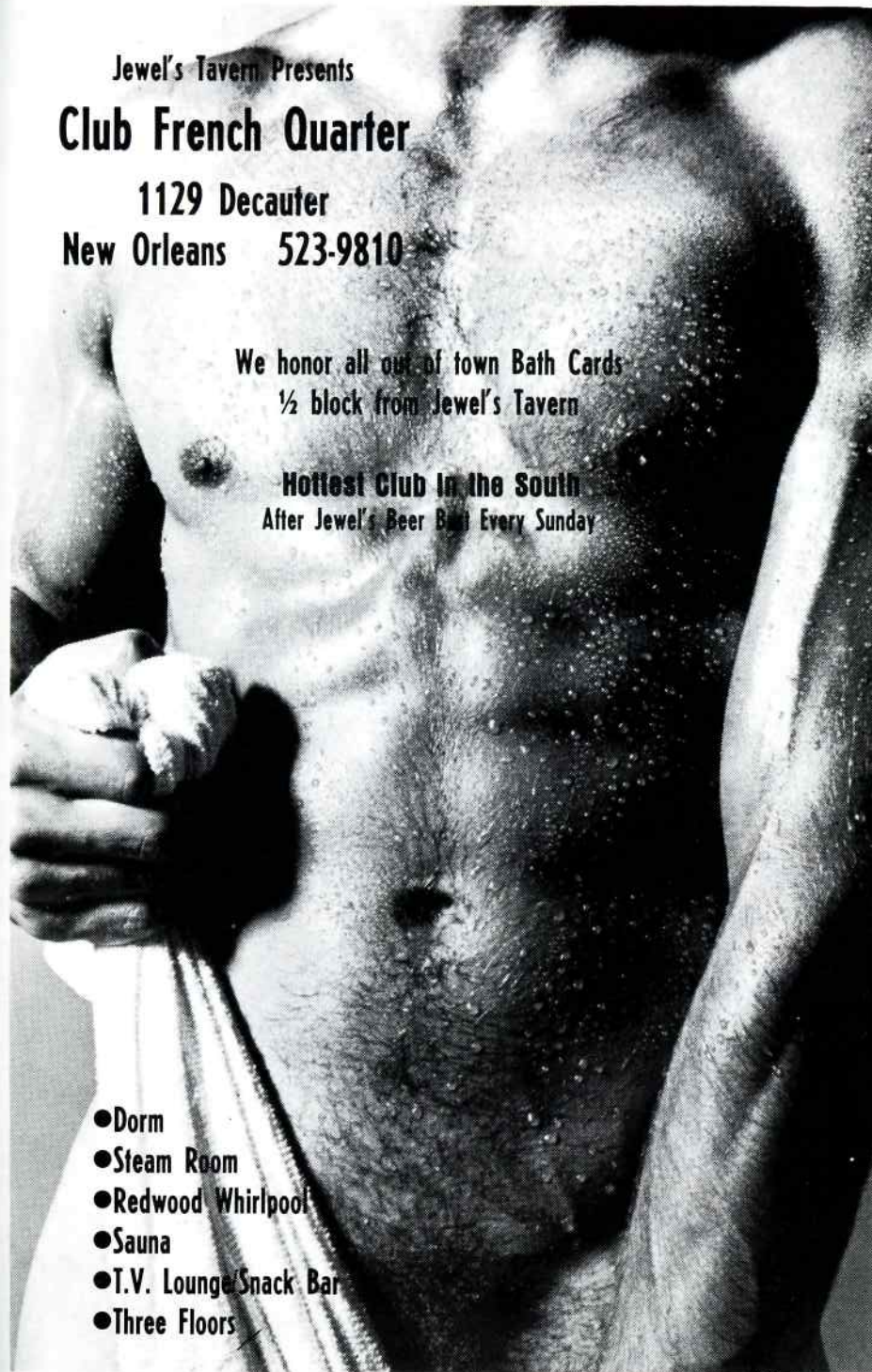

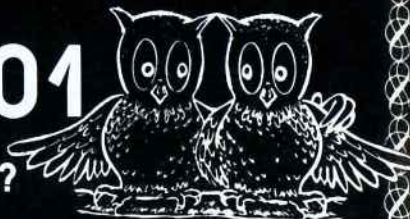

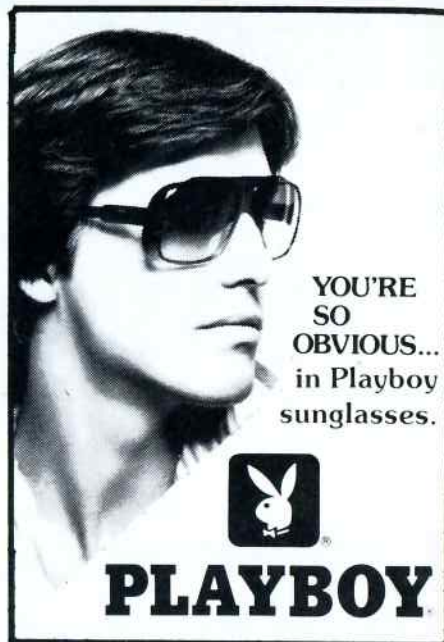


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LIFE WITH VERA by John Gardner

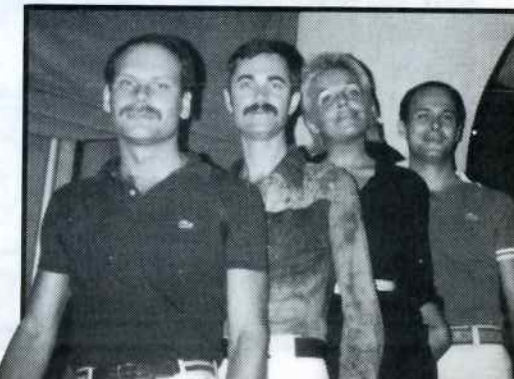
