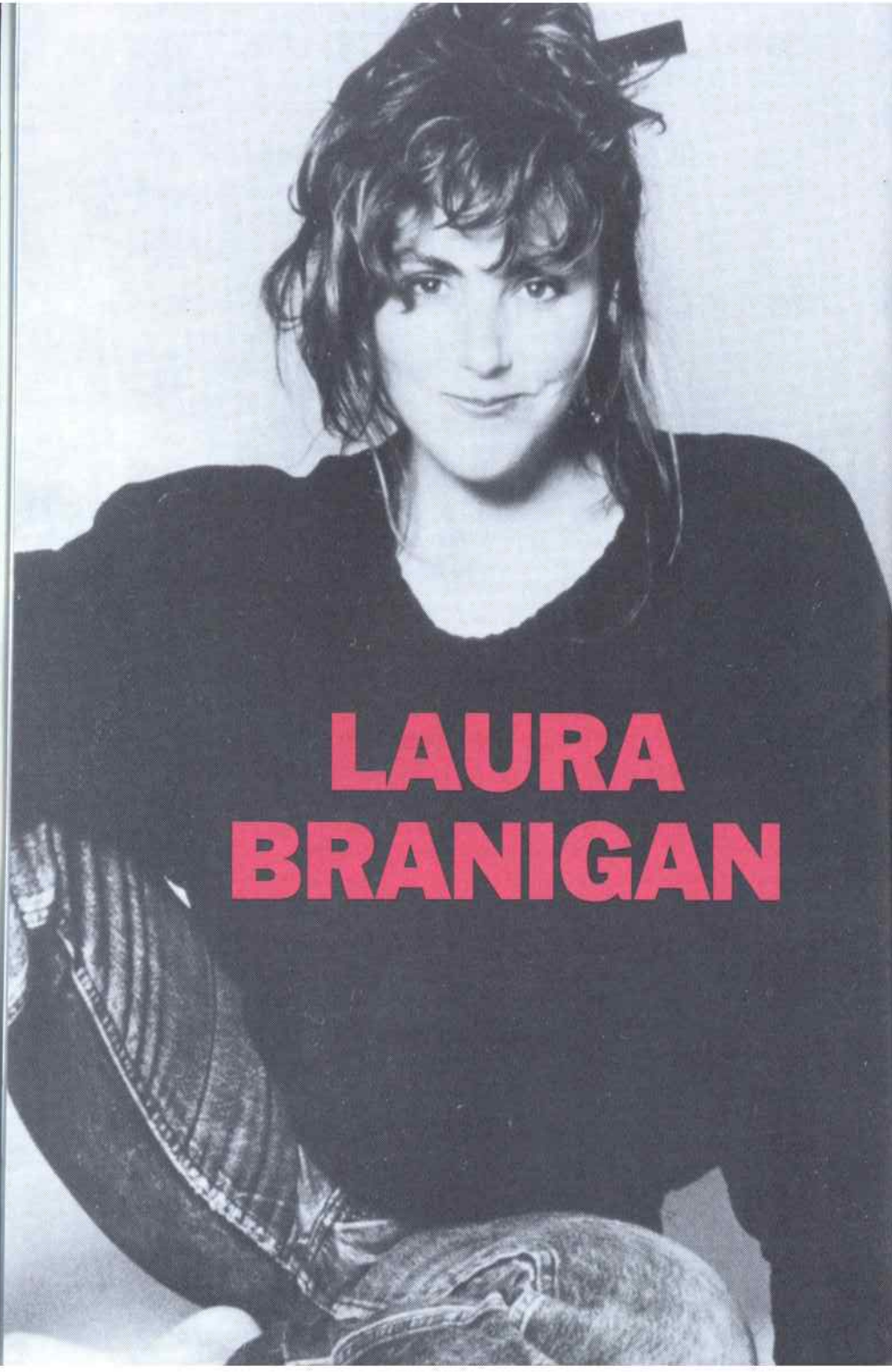

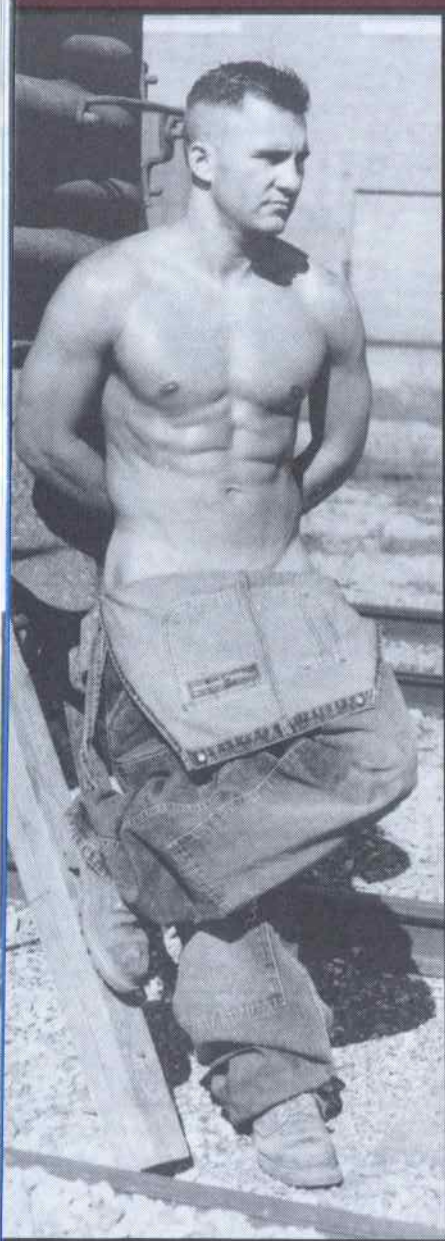

Offers Few
Answers
at Austin's
Hyde Park
Theatre**

Pity poor Tish. A fledgling in the world of exotic dancing, she finds the world that she's just getting adjusted to torn apart by the murder of her mentor and friend, Jean. So, in an effort to put some semblance of order in the seeming madness around her, Tish becomes obsessed with tracking down the killer of her friend. In trying to avoid one type of madness, the young woman becomes a victim herself of a deeper—and worse?—madness.

That's the focus of *Girl Gone*, Jacquelyn Reingold's one-act play being presented through May 13 at Frontera/Hyde Park Theatre, 511 W. 43rd St. in Austin. The story takes us on a dizzying journey into dark places, strip bars, jazz clubs and ourselves. It poses the seemingly no-win question of which is madder: blind acceptance, or an obsession with finding answers that just might not be there.

"One step and you're gone... you've got to watch your step," Tish tells herself and the audience again and again. But she doesn't follow her own good advice. The unreal twists and turns of reality, like the shards of glass that hang from the ceiling as part of the set, make a simple question such as "I like you; do you like me?" impossible to answer in a world where the fine line has been blurred for lies, hustle and survival.

Virginia Jenkins is beautiful in her role as Tish, the naive waif whose faith in the security of her new world is shattered by her friend Jean's (Patricia Wappner) unsolved murder. Jenkins brings a great amount of innocence and vulnerability to her performance; you wonder how she'd survive for five minutes out on the real streets. She also brings a tinge of madness to the role. Maybe that's how she's survive: she wouldn't, like so many other real-life victims of reality.

Wappner as Jean is strong in her mentor's role, a person who knows all the tricks

(figuratively speaking) and can handle anything...she believes. Despite her worldly knowledge, Jean is just another insecure human being looking for love, and not certain if she can find it in new boyfriend Bobby or ex-lover Sammy or even in Tish. Wappner gives a strong portrayal in flashbacks, but she's seldom on stage long enough to discover where her real heart begins and all the illusions and self-delusions end.

Maggie Bridges, Amy Lee Pearsall and Aimee McCormick are the other three dancers at the exotic club. Each turns in a solid performance, dealing with life only as she wants to see it.

The strongest performance is by Chamberlee Ferguson, who appears under special arrangement through the courtesy of Actor's Equity Association. As Bobby, the jazz musician who first bedazzles Jean and later Tish, he seems to lie at the heart of the mystery of whether or not things are what they seem. Ferguson projects too strong in the small theatre sometimes when he rages and yells, which can be unsettling, since the audience is so close in the small theatre-in-the-round setting. But it fits well with the mood of uneasiness Reingold seeks to evoke.

Michael David as male prostitute Sam does a solid job; he's such a good hustler that you believe he knows all the answers, though he won't give anything away. Ron Reeder is Danny, Tish's stiff boyfriend who seemingly has no personality or beliefs of his own; he definitely doesn't fit into the world she's made for herself.

Director Vicky Boone does a fine job of capturing the dark side of Reingold's frustrating, depressing tale. A problem is that flickering lights or half-second blackouts are usually used to signal flashbacks or changes in scene; that's often not enough time for the audience to make the adjustment, or to accept the changing points of view. In something as deep and pondering as *Girl Gone*, you just want to holler "time out!" and ask for a breather to catch up. But there are no breathers. There is no catching up.

Only acceptance. Or madness.

Girl Gone is being presented at 8 p.m. Wednesday-Saturday through May 13 at Frontera/Hyde Park Theatre, 511 W. 43rd St. in Austin. Tickets are \$10, \$6 for seniors, students and ACOT members; Wednesday is pay-what-you-wish. For tickets, call (512) 499-TIXS.

ANGELS IN AMERICA PART 2

PERESTROIKA

Second Part of
Tony Kushner's Stage
Epic Effortlessly Blends
Dramatic, Comedic
Elements In Production
at Houston's Alley

Asking in the success of *Angels in America Part 1: Millennium Approaches*, Houston's Alley Theatre opened the second play of Tony Kushner's Tony Award-winning epic on April 19. Theatre patrons will have additional opportunities to experience the critically acclaimed box office smash with the Alley's jubilant announcement of a four-week extension of the run through July 9.

Performed in repertory with Part 1, *Pereestroika* further develops the cross-section of characters introduced in the first play and brings their lives to resolution. It be-

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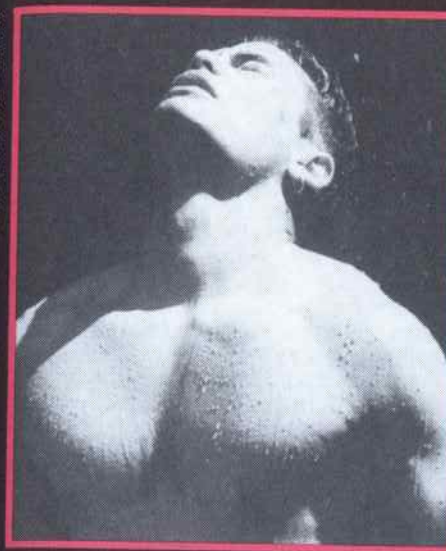


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gins where *Millennium* left off, with the appearance of an angel at the sick bed of Prior Walter, who is suffering from severe complications associated with AIDS. Abandoned by his lover, Louis Ironson, in the first part, Prior must face the onslaught of the disease and the appearance of the angel all alone.

Much to the surprise of Prior and the audience, the angel is angry, aggressive and bitchy, having faced abandonment by God in heaven. She paints a bleak picture of the state of the universe to a shocked Prior.

Alley Company member John Feltch is charming as Prior Walter, lovable and huggable as he accepts the onslaught of the disease and copes with the failure of his relationship. The alien chemistry between the mortal Feltch and the enraged angel (played by Shelley Williams), is both comical and unusually erotic. The wrestling match between Feltch and Williams is, to say the least, the most unexpected event

in the play and provides the best action in the show.

Much to the delight of the audience, the character of Belize, the black ex-drag

queen-turned-nurse who is also a former companion of Prior, is the central focus of the second act. Underutilized in *Millennium*, actor Michael McElroy creates in Belize a compassionate creature who is simultaneously sassy, insightful and funny. The nurse's entire belief system and values are challenged as right-wing, closeted homosexual Roy Cohn lands in his hospital ward, still in complete denial of his HIV infection.

Houston actor James Black's superb dramatic personification of Cohn is raging and ice cold. Black embraces Kushner's profoundly scripted stab at right-wing extremists and pushes it to the outer limits. The confrontations between Cohn and Belize, though disturbing for the racial slurs they contain, are hysterical as well as thought-provoking.

Bettye Fitzpatrick works overtime in *Perestroika*, playing four different characters. Her delivery of the pivotal role of Hannah Pitt, the spunky Mormon mother who has moved to New York from Salt Lake City to save her son from homosexuality, is appropriately feisty. While working at the visitors center run by the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, she comes in chance contact with the sinful world of homosexuality when Prior wanders in to try and understand his lover's attraction to her Mormon son. When Prior collapses in the lobby of the center, Hannah rushes him to the hospital, becoming an unlikely nursemaid for the AIDS patient. The angel appears and battles the pair.

Fitzpatrick also accomplishes an outstanding portrayal of Ethel Rosenberg, who serves as Roy Cohn's death angel—a fitting choice for the task, since Cohn had prosecuted Rosenberg and subsequently sentenced her to death in the courtroom.

The relationship between the politically liberal Louis Ironson (Joseph Haj) and the Mormon Joseph Pitt (David Whalen) collapses when Louis discovers that Joseph is Cohn's assistant. Joseph also realizes that Louis has taken up with him on the rebound from Prior, and is not really in love with him. Heartbroken, with his life in a shambles, he crawls back to his wife, Harper, and makes an attempt at reconciliation. It is, however, too late, as Harper has been reborn in the face of adversity and has moved on with her life.

Annalee Jefferies is simply adorable as Harper Pitt. In *Perestroika* she emerges from childlike helplessness to self-dis-

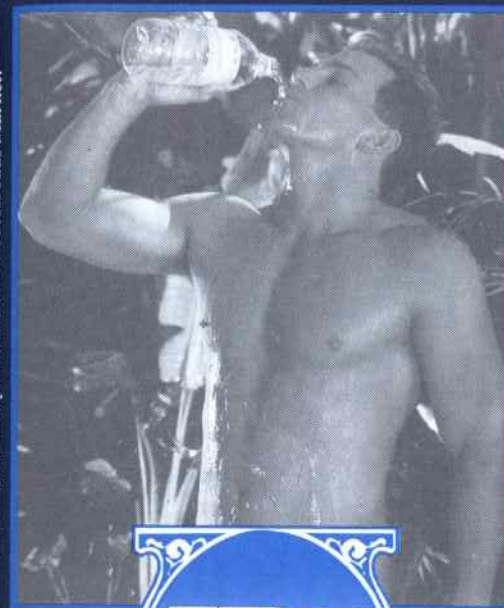

covery. Her understated, deadpan delivery of comedic lines provides almost as much laughter as McElroy's portrayal of Belize.

The brilliance of this piece resides in its seemingly effortless blending of dramatic and comedic elements, due in part to Kushner's innovative script. The laughter, however, does not come from the text, but rather from the outstanding performances of the entire cast under the exceptional direction of Michael Wilson. One goes to the show expecting another depressing AIDS drama and instead leaves with a warmed heart, laughter-produced endorphins and an enlightened spirit.

Angels in America Part 2: Perestroika is being presented by Houston's Alley Theatre, 615 Texas Ave., through July 9. *Perestroika* runs in repertory with *Part I: Millennium Approaches*. There are several "marathon" performances scheduled, at which Parts I and II are performed as matinee and evening fare. For tickets and information, call (713) 228-8421. The Alley encourages standby tickets on day of performance, and reports that all standbys have been accommodated to date. [The Alley also announced that the company will go on hiatus for two weeks this month to perform the show at the Venice Biennale arts festival in Italy.]

THE COLLECTION

From the Memories of Yesteryear Part 2 of A Trilogy

OUR HISTORY MUST BE PRESERVED

Randy died in 1972. In his last years he complained that he had outlived his time. His was a time when life was less hurried. But it was also a time when heartland audiences were shocked to see male ballet dancers in white tights. A time when Clark Gable titillated audiences by taking off his shirt in *It Happened One Night* to reveal a manly chest unencumbered by clothing. Honestly! (In department stores, under-shirt sales immediately fell, but tickets to the movie sold briskly.) A time when Gable uttered, "Frankly, my dear, I don't give a damn!" and audiences tee-hee-heed in their seats. MGM had had to fight hard to keep that line in *Gone With the Wind*, and bluenose censors of the day predicted that because of Hollywood and the Ballet Russe de Monte Carlo, the world was going to the hot place in a handbasket. Had they seen "the collection," they would have ruined their underpants!

Thirty years later, the always-tipsy operator stopped her elevator between floors of the YMCA, turned to the men packed inside and said, "Hoo-whee! Someone smells like a country whore who just came to town!" Everyone laughed except the very properly dressed old man standing in the far corner. He, instead, straightened his already straight back, stared straight

ahead and pretended not to have heard the earthy comment.

Randy was an old-timer at the Dallas Y, having lived there since the day it opened in 1934. He was known among staff and fellow residents for his out-of-the-way consideration for others and for his encyclopedic knowledge of music and art. The wealthy scion of a noble family in Mississippi, he could easily have chosen to live in more expensive quarters. But life in the residential halls of the Y could not be duplicated elsewhere for any amount of money, hoo-whee!

The halls were sandwiched between the 5th and 13th floors and were the heart and soul of the Y. While not elegant, each room was nicely furnished. A maid cleaned the rooms daily and left fresh towels; a janitor cleaned the halls and the community bathrooms.

Because the Y was built before air-conditioning and because women were not allowed above the lobby, windows and doors were left wide open during the summer. To further ward off the heat, nudity was common and comfortable. When going for a shower, a man merely threw a towel over his shoulder and proceeded down the hall with everything swinging. Needless to say, the shower rooms were popular gathering places.

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At night and on weekends, the residential halls were crowded with friendly visitors. There was always an impromptu party going on in someone's room, and strangers were made to feel like guests. Guests made themselves at home, sitting wherever they could while everyone camped and dished the dirt. This easy, drop-in-anytime informality made the camaraderie all the more dear.

Decades before AIDS, sex with the perfect stranger... well, that's another story.

In sharp contrast to the others, Randy's room was a restful retreat from all the parties and sexual adventures. It was a miniature palace with an impressive Persian rug, artsy throw pillows and custom-designed drapery. An entire wall was lined with books. But Randy was no uppity snob. If someone was interested in listening to opera, he was happy to entertain. His vast record collection was strictly Victor Red Seal! Of course, cooking was disallowed in rooms, but Randy had smuggled in a hot plate and, being an excellent cook, he was always able to offer a little something with wine and candlelight.

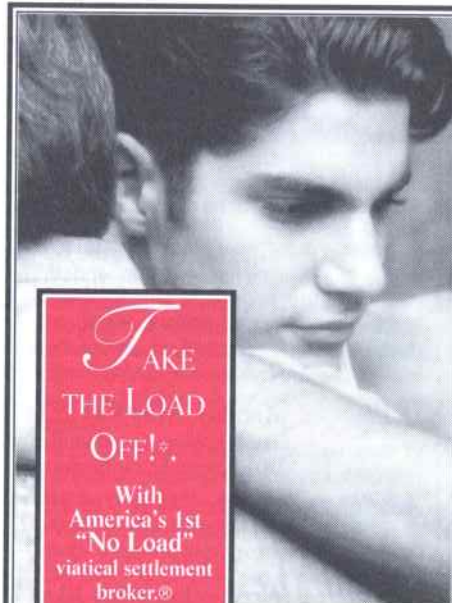
But only friends were allowed to see "the collection"—nude photos of muscle-men, of movie stars and of ballet dancers.

Texas is fortunate in having three gay and lesbian library/archives, in Dallas, in Houston and in San Antonio.

There were water colors, pastels, pen and pencils and oils, all dedicated to masculine beauty. Some were faithful reproductions of masterpieces, but most were originals commissioned by Randy. The art was all the more erotic because it suggested rather than displayed. There were few frontal nudes and no erections or penetrations. A dedicated lifetime and a small fortune had been spent for it.

But time waits for no one, and even an elegant queen grows old. Randy's eyesight began to fail and his steps to falter. Fearing he had little time left, he returned to his small hometown and the family estate that was his by inheritance. His alcoholic sister and her husband moved in to take care of the frail man. Strangely, the unlikely trio got along well.

But in this Old South community people

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began to whisper, "Have you heard about the collection?" Like those flocking to a Clark Gable movie, the small-town gossips were eager to be shocked. On some occasions, when asked, Randy would display a few items. No one complained to the old man, but if someone questioned the propriety of the subject matter to his sister, she would bristle, "Well, that's my brother. Take him as he is or don't come back."

So it seems strange that when Randy had been dead only a few days, the husband discovered his wife in the back yard burning the collection. "What are you doing? Are you crazy?" He tried to save what was left. "If you don't want this, we can sell it. It must be worth thousands of dollars!"

"We don't need money from filth," the sister piously proclaimed as she continued to feed beautiful art to the flames. The books and records were also discarded.

Texas is fortunate in having three gay and lesbian library/archives. In Houston, there is the collection housed in the Metropolitan Community Church of the Resurrection. In San Antonio, there is Gene Elder's Happy Foundation Archives. And in Dallas, there is the Historic Archives and Research Library (now in the process of being housed in the Dallas Gay and Lesbian Alliance's Community Center), a collection which this writer started in 1947 and which includes items dating back to the 1920s.

All three collections would be happy to receive art, books, magazines, newspaper clippings, photos, records—memorabilia or anything of beauty having to do with gay and lesbian history.

Unlike Randy, we must not die and leave our treasures to homophobic relatives. Our heritage must be properly housed and catalogued so that it will live and be loved forever.

Two Women-Owned Businesses In Houston Recognized As Among 50 Fastest-Growing Gay Firms in Country

OUT IN FRONT

Owners of a Houston-area travel agency and real estate company have combined hard work and dedication to their businesses with involvement in the community to achieve a level of success recently recognized by a national gay and lesbian business publication. Travel agent Sandra Wilkins and real estate broker Suzanne Anderson were honored earlier this year by *Victory* magazine as among the 50 fastest-growing gay/lesbian-owned enterprises in the U.S.

The "Victory! 50" awards were designed to "acknowledge the success of gay and lesbian entrepreneurs as a means to motivate and inspire tomorrow's business leaders." The magazine honored the 50 fastest-growing gay and lesbian business owners who "demonstrated courage, initiative, innovation and wisdom."

Wilkins, who along with Pat Brown owns Brown-Wilkins and Associates Travel agency, has been in the business for the last 17 years. She's worked for airlines and managed large travel agencies, and knew she was lesbian the whole time, but has been out only for the past six years.

"My business," Wilkins says, "sort of veered off and took its own course on its own volition. In the first three years of owning my own company during the late '80s and early '90s, I worked primarily with many AIDS-related New York organizations. Through them, I worked with clients in Los Angeles and San Francisco."

Through old friend and former sweetheart Dan Baker (now the editor and publisher of *Quotient Research*, a newsletter covering the gay and lesbian marketing business), Wilkins was put in contact with many clients going to international AIDS conferences. Baker, who had contacts in New York City, was treasurer of ACT UP New York at the time.

"I felt great about getting this award,"

Wilkins observes. "It's a tremendous honor anytime to be recognized for anything, but to have been included in the *Victory* award is really nice."

Wilkins explains that her clientele ranges from "mainstream" travelers to those looking for a specifically gay vacation. Most gay men and lesbians travel to gay "meccas" like Palm Springs, Provincetown, San Francisco and Key West. Arizona, she adds, is also a pretty hot destination for gay travelers at the moment.

"The explosion of very specific gay and lesbian tour operators has been the most exciting thing that's happened in my whole 17 years of travel," she says.

There is now a national organization gay and lesbian travel professionals can belong to, the International Gay Travel Association [IGTA]. Wilkins became a charter member five years ago when the membership totaled 32; there are now over 700 members.

"Gay people have good sense," says Wilkins, "and we have a lot of disposable

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income, and it's been my experience that gay people are discriminating about their destinations. Whether someone wants a budget trip, or a super-deluxe trip, there's now something available for everyone."

Internationally, she says, Spain is a hot destination for gay men and lesbians, as is Greece. Those countries welcome gays and don't discriminate. The most difficult countries in Europe to travel in and really be out, according to Wilkins, are Italy and Germany.

"In France," she says, "they don't care who sleeps with anybody. The whole cultures of England and France lend themselves more to what we want over here, which is like, 'Don't worry about who we're sleeping with.'"

"The importance of being selected for the Victory award," says Wilkins, "is that it's brought us good recognition, both locally and nationally, and it's just nice to be recognized at being good at what you do."

"It was nice to be recognized," agrees Anderson, the real estate broker, "for something that I'd spent so much of my personal feelings and time and energy towards. It feels very good to get the national recognition."

"Selling real estate is just one dimension of who I am," she notes. "I really have a lot of community interest, and I wanted a place that I could do my real estate, but at the same time, I could tie it all in together."

Anderson is a former president of Lesbians in Business, which she helped found,

and serves as a co-host of the KPFT radio show *Lesbian and Gay Voices*. She was recently chosen female Grand Marshal for Houston Gay/Lesbian Pride celebrations in June.

She attributes her climb to success to her degree in applied music, which she found so limiting that she became a stockbroker. In 1977, she became interested in real estate when her then lover answered an ad saying applicants could make \$2,000 a week selling undeveloped five-acre tracts of land.

"Nobody makes \$2,000 a week," she remembers saying at the time. Anderson told her lover to check it out, and soon joined her. She quit her job in August and by November, she and her spouse were driving a brand new car.

Anderson and her partner leased a four-wheel-drive vehicle. "It was bizarre, after being a stockbroker and wearing heels and a dress, and going downtown," she says. "Suddenly I was in a four-wheel-drive with a pair of jeans, my first pair of boots, and going out and selling people five-acre tracts!"

She was able to sell land to some of her stockbroker clients, and become very successful. Soon, she began selling commercial properties, but didn't like her clientele. "I got tired of hearing all these men telling about how they made their fortunes, and I really didn't give a damn!"

From there, she and her partner worked with time share properties, then began selling resort properties. In 1984, she tried her hand at selling homes in addition to land tracts. In her first month of closings, she closed \$750,000 in houses. That was the beginning of her residential sales.

Anderson says she was ultimately fired for getting into an argument with a builder whose mistress wanted her job. So she opened her own company.

"I was ready to quit the real estate business when I came to Houston in 1986 because I was so bored with it," she says. "After I started directing my business to the gay and lesbian community, I started talking to people that I truly liked and enjoyed, and many have become personal friends."

She maintains a casual office, and her realtors wear shorts to the office in the summer. "That's part of why I wanted my own company. The business became interesting and fun and I really enjoy what I do now. I enjoy being out and watching people's reactions."

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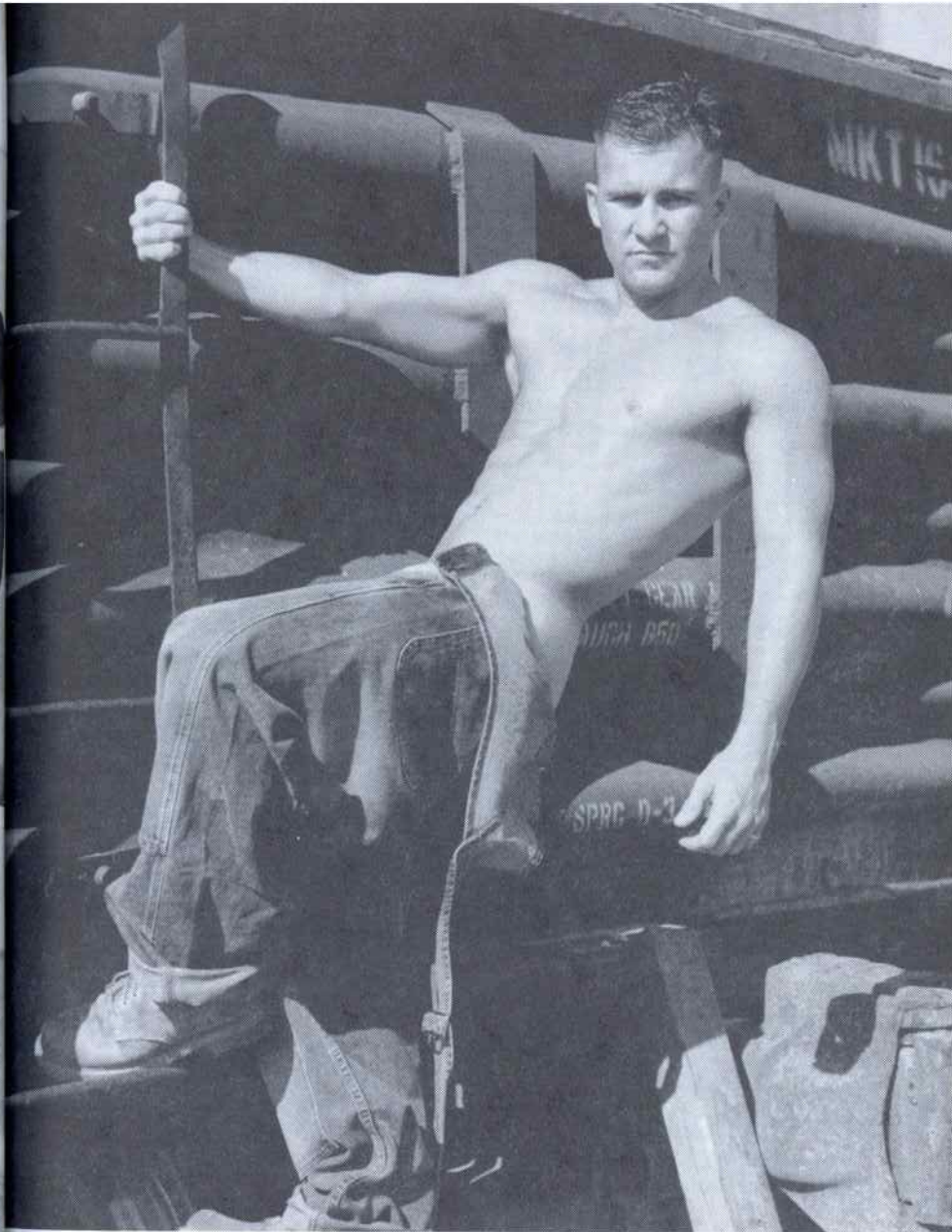
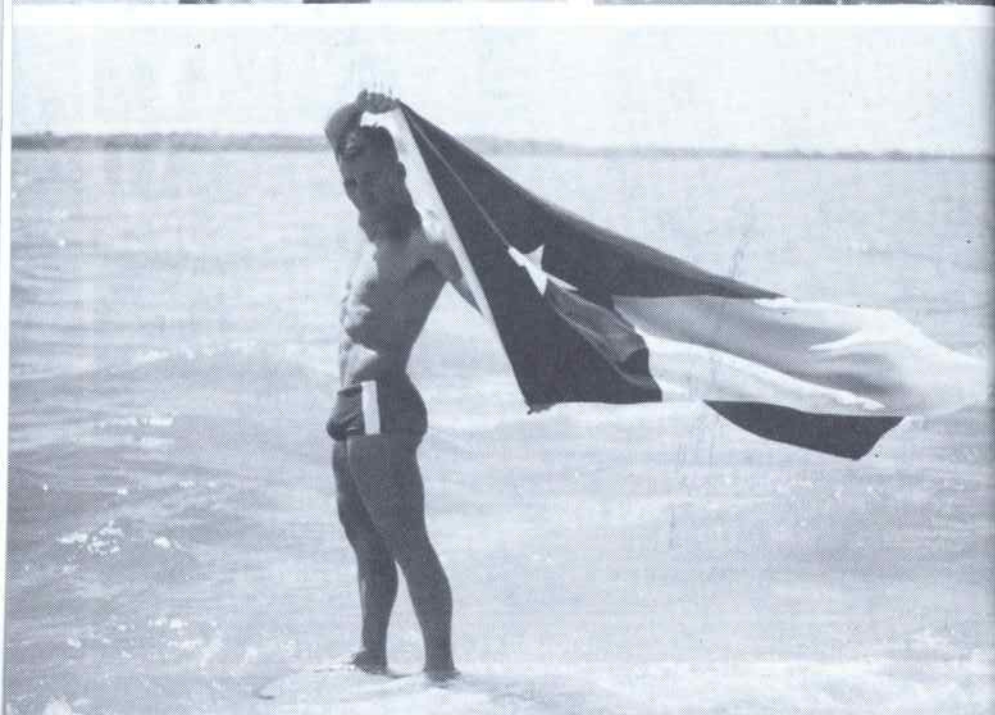
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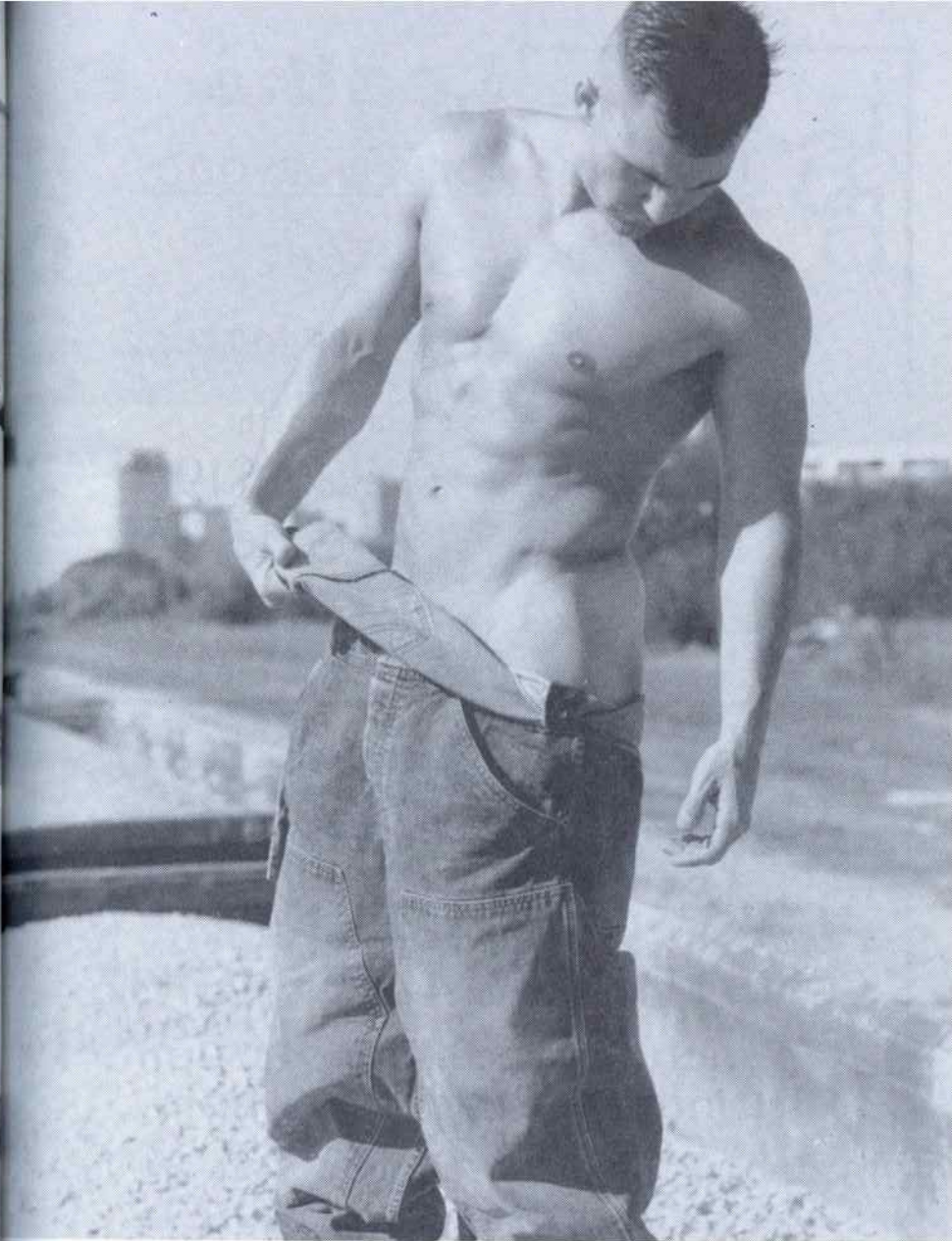
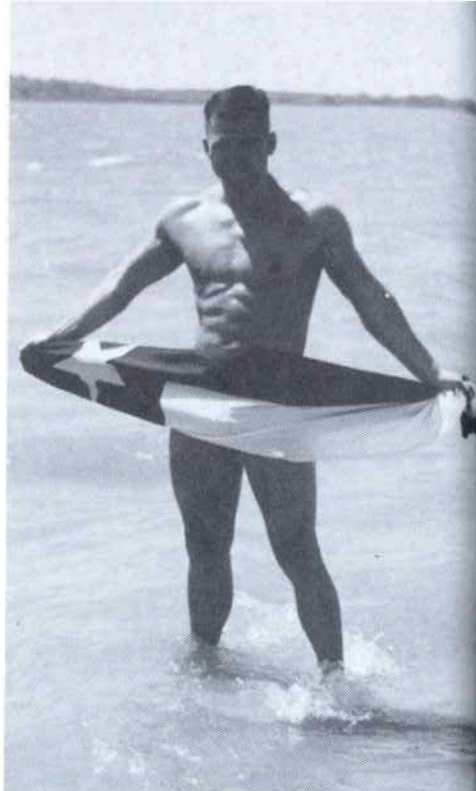
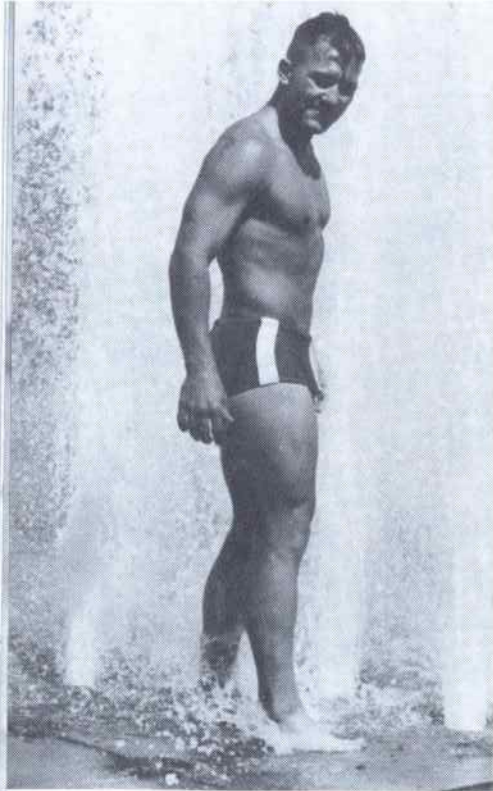

This track is rapidly climbing the charts in England, so look for equal success domestically.

One of the dance community's best-kept secrets, **Eve Gallagher**, is back on the scene with "You Can Have It All," available as an import on the Cleveland City label and soon to be available domestically from **Radikal**. It's heart-pumping, chart-stopping Hi-NRG/House at its best. I've been known recently to put on the record and dart down to the dance floor for a few minutes of dancing pleasure myself. Eve has been around awhile, having been discovered a few years ago by **Boy George**. If you ever get a chance to see her live, don't pass it up—the woman can sing like nobody's business. Also, don't forget to check out Eve's '95 version of "Love Come Down" with remixes by **Evolution**, **Bruce Forest** and the always flawless **David Morales**.

New York's **Logic Records** continues their winning streak with the **Blunt Funkers'** "God's an Astronaut." This track is a pseudo-alternative House piece with driving bassline and hypnotic vocals. Great for any after-hours crowd.

Since last November, I've received several wonderful pieces on **Vestry Records** out of New York. The latest, "The Morning After" by **3rd Chapter**, is clear evidence that **Vestry** is here to stay and growing by leaps and bounds. If you're a fan of true underground House music, look for the **Vestry** label at your favorite music store. You won't be disappointed.

If you became addicted to **Staxx** last summer, don't pass up their latest, "You." It's one of those gorgeous House/NRG hybrids that have been floating around lately and is simply brilliant. Expect to see some of those wig-wearing boys performing this one before too long. (Hint, Hint, Hint)

For those of you who're techno-heads, check out "Candy" by **Angel Corpus Christi**. It's actually a nice compromise between House and Techno and should be charting shortly. Word has it that "Candy" is stirring up the dance floors on the West Coast. The track is available promotionally only, but should be ready for commercial release in just a few weeks.

If you're into **Deep Forest**—which, if you have any sense, you probably are—give a listen to **Epic's** release of their latest single, "Marta's Song." Really good stuff. I don't know who "Marta" is, but who cares when it comes to **Deep Forest**? The pack is loaded with fierce mixes by **Armand van Helden**, **Pete Arden**, **Greg Padula** and **DJ Casanova**. Among all that, I'm sure you'll

AUSTIN READY FOR SPLASH FESTIVITIES

*Thousands Expected for Annual Fun
At McGregor/Hippie Hollow Park.*

AUSTIN — Everyone's ready; it's all up to the weather now on just how successful the annual First Splash Day will be this Sunday, May 7 at McGregor/Hippie Hollow Park on Lake Travis north of Austin. If it's a sunny day like last Saturday, as many as 20,000-30,000 mostly gay and lesbian revelers will descend upon the park.

One thing Splash Day participants will find different this year is a limitation to the area they can legally party in. Private property owners south of the world-famous Hippie Hollow complained about trespassers in years past—and not just on First Splash Day—so new 15-foot-high chainlink fencing was erected to mark the end of the parkland. To make it easier for boaters participating in the festivities, the easternmost cove is a "no-wake zone" (no going any faster than would cause a wake) that is boat-accessible to shore. The rest of Hippie Hollow's swimming shoreline is protected from dangerous boaters by a cordon of buoys.

"This has been going on for years, and pretty much worked out; we're just defining things more clearly this year," explained Jim Corrigan, one of the park rangers at Hippie Hollow. "We haven't had any major complaints in the last several years. We'll have plenty of people out here making sure everybody has a good time."

Parking is very limited at Hippie Hollow; gates open at 9 a.m., and Corrigan expects the lot to be closed by 10. Parking is also available at Bob Wenz State Park, west of McGregor/Hippie Hollow and across from the Oasis Restaurant about a mile to the east. No parking is allowed on Comanche Trail, which leads to Hippie Hollow, and that will be strictly enforced. Entrance to Hippie Hollow is \$5 per vehicle, \$2 per pedestrian; people who park at Bob Wenz will be stamped so they don't have to pay the pedestrian charge.

"You can't bring glass containers or pets; no ground fires are allowed. Just about everything else goes," Corrigan said about Hippie Hollow, one of the nation's few remaining clothing-optional beaches. "A lot of people do come by boat from Mansfield Dam and other parts of the lake. Everyone's welcome; we want everyone to

to have fun and be safe—and to be considerate of others. First-aid units will be on hand if they're needed; we hope they won't."

The yearly Splash Days at the start and end of summer are sponsored by the Austin Tavern Guild. Armbands to get free beer from the guild's party boats at the lake will be available Saturday night, May 6, at host bars in Austin, which include Auntie Mame's, 'Bout Time, Chain Drive, Charlie's of Austin, Club 404, Cowboys, D.J.'s, Fifth Street, Hollywood, Nexus, Oilcan Harry's, Proteus and others. The day at the lake is the highlight of the week-end of parties and celebrations; Hippie Hollow stays open until 9 p.m.

GAY SON OF MARINE COLONEL TO SPEAK IN TEXAS

*Scott Peck Will Appear in Austin,
Dallas and Houston on Tour for
Release of 'All-American Boy.'*

TEXAS — Two years after the debate over gays in the military made the front pages, a young man whose sexuality was thrust into the limelight during the controversy has written a memoir about that experience and about his life. Scott Peck, whose Marine Colonel father revealed his son's homosexuality while urging Congress to retain the Pentagon's anti-gay policy, makes stops in Austin, Dallas and Houston this month. His appearances (courtesy of Oaklawn Marketing, Inc. and Charles Scribner's Sons) are part of a nationwide tour coinciding with the release of *All-American Boy: A Memoir*.

Peck, 25, first came to the nation's attention during Congressional hearings on the Pentagon's anti-gay policy in 1993. He had learned that his father, Fred Peck, planned to testify before Congress against efforts to loosen or eliminate prohibitions against homosexuals in the armed forces. Scott Peck decided it was time to tell his father that he was gay.

Far from changing his plans, the elder Peck decided that his son's revelation would strengthen his case for retaining the military's anti-gay rules. In his remarks to a Senate committee, he said he loved and respected his son, but would fear for his safety if he joined up. "There is no place in the military for him. Because my son

Scott is a homosexual."

The title of Scott Peck's memoir is tinged with irony since, as he tells it, his story is hardly that of an all-American boy. When he was one year old, he and his mother were abandoned by Scott's biological father. The younger Peck was severely abused by his alcoholic stepfather, and his mother died of cancer when he was 15. The fundamentalist religious environment in which he was raised made his growing attraction toward men that much more difficult to accept, and he admits to having been very homophobic toward gay people when he was younger.

Of his relationship with his father in the last two years, Peck has said, "I finally figured out that he doesn't want a perfect son—he wants *his* son. And I don't want a perfect father."

Peck will appear at the Gay and Lesbian Community Center, 2701 Reagan St. in Dallas, at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, May 8. On May 9, he will speak at Metropolitan Community Church of Austin, 425 Woodward, at 7:30 p.m. On May 10, he will appear at Bering Memorial United Methodist Church, 1440 Harold St. in Houston, at 7:30 p.m. A reception and book-signing will follow each event at the above locations.

DALLAS VOTERS GO TO POLLS SATURDAY

*Candidates with LG-PAC Support
Running in Mayoral, Council Races.*

DALLAS — With current Mayor Steve Bartlett opting not to run for a second term, Ron Kirk, Domingo Garcia and Darrell Jordan have emerged as the front-runners in the race, which will be decided at the polls tomorrow, May 6. The 14 City Council seats are also on the ballot, as is a \$178 million bond package of capital improvements for the city.

Both Kirk, an attorney, and Garcia, current Mayor Pro Tem, have gone on record as supporting the city's new personnel policy that prohibits discrimination based on sexual orientation.

Recent financial reports indicate that Kirk has an almost two-to-one lead over Garcia and Jordan in fund-raising, with a little over \$600,000 compared to roughly \$300,000 for each of the other two. The latest poll, conducted by *The Dallas Morning News*, showed Kirk in front, garnering the support of 30 percent of those sur-



veyed compared to 23 and 20 percent for Garcia and Jordan, respectively. Almost one-quarter of the respondents were undecided, however, and many political observers expect that the mayoral race will have to be decided in a runoff.

In addition to Kirk, the Dallas LG-PAC recently endorsed the following candidates for City Council: Steve Salazar for Place 1, Chris Luna (who serves part of the heavily gay Oak Lawn area) for Place 2, Bob Stimson for Place 3, Taylor Brannon for Place 6, Kenneth Green for Place 7, Sandra Crenshaw for Place 8 and Craig McDaniel (whose district also takes in part of Oak Lawn) for Place 9. Several City Council incumbents were not opposed for reelection.

In Dallas Independent School Board races, candidates endorsed were Yvonne Ewell for Place 3, Jose Plata for Place 7 and Katherine Leos for Place 8.

All eight propositions for the capital improvement bond program were endorsed.

BENEFITS GIVE BOOST TO AUSTIN AGENCIES

'Viva Las Vegas!,' Carnival at Amy's Ice Cream Raise Funds for ASA and Christopher House.

AUSTIN — "People don't mind giving to a good cause," smiled Don Massa, developmental director of Christopher House. He was all smiles—though with a slight case of the sniffles—after a weekend in which Austin and the surrounding area showed its support for those battling AIDS with two hugely successful fund-raisers.

On Saturday, the second "Viva Las Vegas!" casino night raised at least \$55,000 for AIDS Services of Austin [ASA] and its legal program, the Capital Area AIDS Legal Project [CAALP]. An estimated 1,100–1,200 people turned out during the evening at the Austin Music Hall to gamble their money away to benefit people with HIV and AIDS in the ten-county Central Texas area.

On Sunday, Amy's Ice Cream Inc. celebrated its grand opening at its new 3400 Guadalupe location with a carnival benefit for Christopher House, an intermediate treatment facility that provides hospital-level care in a homelike setting for people with AIDS regardless of their financial status. The carnival raised over \$650 in donations for Christopher House's clients.

Massa developed his sniffles as a celebrity victim at the dunking booth, one of the most popular events at the Amy's soiree. "I never knew there were so many people who hated me...when my turn came, I think I spent just one second on the platform, and the rest of the time in the water," Massa chuckled. "I had a ball!"

Amy's and neighbor Mangia Chicago-Style Pizza both collected for Christopher House during the afternoon. Owner Amy

Miller's company helps Christopher House once again this Sunday, May 7, with Amy's Fun Run Cattle Drive at Austin High, featuring a 10K run and a two-mile fun walk. Registration starts at 7 a.m. and the race at 8, and over 500 runners are expected.

"She's a godsend!" Massa said of Miller. "She also works with AIDS Services, and generally provides across-the-board support. And she's real, real low-key about it. It's the beautiful people like Amy that I just can't say enough about."

There were plenty of beautiful people at "Viva Las Vegas!" Some took advantage of the "Love Me Tender" Wedding Chapel to exchange (nonbinding) vows, especially when Elvis himself showed up to perform the ceremonies. Others devoted their energies to games of chance like craps, blackjack and roulette. Still others participated in the auctions of donated prizes, both live and silent. One of the most touching and little-ballyhooed events of the evening took place when attorney Jim Rodman, co-chairman of the legal advisory board of ASA/CAALP, and wife Susan bought one of the two greyhounds up for auction and then gave it to an unidentified female bidder, who desperately wanted one of the animals but couldn't bid high enough to win one.

"It was just a huge, huge success; the energy was just incredible in the building," said a smiling Kirk Rice, CAALP's director of legal development. "We're hoping that the final count of the money raised goes to \$57,000. There was a wide array of people who participated...it was just great!"

HOUSTON GROUP RELEASES RESULTS OF SURVEY ON LESBIAN HEALTH NEEDS

Study Shows Need to Clarify Meaning of Safer Sex for Women.

HOUSTON — Last year the Lesbian Health Initiative conducted a survey among Houston-area women to determine the health needs of lesbians. The project, which was carried out with the assistance of the Montrose Counseling Center, drew responses from 612 lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender women. Results were reported at a press conference held April 24.

In the area of physical health, according

to Barbara L. Becker of the Counseling Center, more education is needed concerning skin and breast cancer. Skin cancer was the form most frequently reported among respondents; 25 percent reported having had cancer, with half of those reporting skin cancer and 20 percent citing breast cancer. Over 90 percent reported they know how to perform breast exams, but only a third do it on a regular basis, and nearly 20 percent never do.

Concerning safer sex, the study showed that there is no clear idea of what safer sex is for women who have sex with other women. "The term 'safer sex' is most often linked to HIV disease, and the Centers for Disease Control don't even list woman-to-woman sex as a risk factor," said Becker. "It's hard to get a group of women to think along those lines, but because there are other types of STDs that are transmitted and do show up, you have to think along those lines." She said more research is needed in the area.

Stress was a major factor in most of the respondents' lives, with over one-third reporting higher than average levels.

Concerning incidents of sexual assault or domestic violence experienced in the preceding 12 months, 70 percent of respondents reported either not being in a battering situation or not having a partner. Of the 30 percent who did report such events, over half cited verbal abuse, 17 percent were slapped or hit, 14 percent had partners who withheld sex as punishment and 11 percent were thrown out of the house.

Forty-two percent of respondents reported being forced to have sex at some time in their lives. About one-third reported having forced sex as adults; another third reported being forced as children; and a third experienced forced sex at both times. These numbers are higher than national averages for sexual assaults, but are consistent with other similar studies.

"What we've found in this survey as far as barriers to many kinds of health care services for lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender women," Becker observed, "[is] that there are layers of problems. There is one layer that has to do with being female and the status of women in our society. Another layer has to do with being gay, and those multiple layers and the homophobia involved is a very definite risk factor for accessing health care services in this country."
