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THE DIVERSITY OF OUR HUMOR

Out, Loud, & Laughing: A Collection of Gay & Lesbian Humor, edited by Charles Flowers; softcover; non-fiction anthology; 224 pp.; Anchor Books, Doubleday, New York, NY; \$12.95.

Growing Up Gay: From Left Out to Coming Out, by Funny Gay Males (Jaffe Cohen, Danny McWilliams and Bob Smith); softcover; nonfiction; 242 pp.; Hyperion, New York, NY; \$9.95.

There is much to be said about the healing power of laughter.

Comedians and humorists may be the true diplomats and physicians in the world today. There's nothing that can ease pain like a shared chuckle over someone else's similar but exaggerated experience. Nothing can bond strangers like the familiarity of common anxieties. People make jokes about what they fear, to deal with it and overcome it.

"What remains after the laughter is the sense of pleasure, of identification rather than difference, which lets us remember our common bond," explains Charles Flowers in the humor anthology he has edited, *Out, Loud, & Laughing*. "If the comedian is gay or black or feminist, that identification just might create cultural change by connecting us with a person we might otherwise consider alien or threatening."

Gay and lesbian humor is currently very popular, the "in" thing on TV specials and in comedy clubs. The print media has joined the rush to make such material available to readers; two recent works are Flowers' anthology, which is subtitled "A Collection of Gay & Lesbian Humor," and *Growing Up Gay: From Left Out to Coming Out*, by the three-man comedy team of Jaffe Cohen, Danny McWilliams and Bob Smith.

TWO NEW VOLUMES SHOW

Sure, some of the material is repetitive, touching on the same old subjects, and some of the comedy arrows miss their marks. But not at all too long ago, these kinds of books would have been considered *non grata* in the literary marketplace; now they're out there, being allowed to stand on their own merits. There's a lot of extremely funny material in both of these works, and they're well worth the price and capable of eliciting a chuckle during anyone's hard day.

If Jesse Helms or Pat Robertson took the time to read these books and appreciate their humanity, their common-man (and -woman) quality, maybe they wouldn't be such grumpy curmudgeons all the time.

Bob Smith had a hand in both books. The New York-based comedian is a co-author of *Growing Up Gay*, which is written in the first person plural; he also was one of the 15 contributors to *Out, Loud, & Laughing*. By coincidence, both works had just made it onto bookstore shelves when Smith visited Texas in June doing his one-man shows.

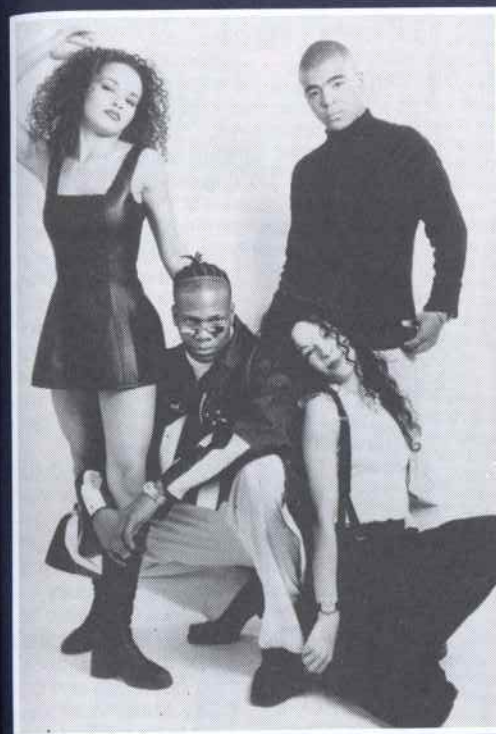
"It's kind of funny having two things out at the same time," he said before a show at Laff Stop in Austin. "It's different being in print from being onstage, because there's not the improv and the immediacy of a live audience. But it all works together for your career. It's like everything in life: You're always auditioning."

"I prefer the stage, but I like being in a medium that people can take with them and turn to again and again. As long as I keep making a living! Actually, I am going to do my own book soon with Bantam Books. Gay comedy is the hot thing right now; it's accepted, so we need to make the most of our chance while we can...It's our chance to show gay life is just the same as everyday life: sometimes

happy, sometimes sad, sometimes frustrating, sometimes revelational. And always human."

In *Out, Loud, & Laughing*, Smith relates how he came out to his family: "I made my carefully worded announcement at Thanksgiving...I said, 'Mom, would you please pass the gravy to a homosexual?'" And he tries to set the record straight for the narrow-minded: "In South Carolina a state representative wants to outlaw gay men and lesbians from adopting children because he believes gay households are 'breeding grounds for future homosexuals.' I'm only going to explain this once: *Heterosexuals* are the breeding grounds for future homosexuals. I know it's hard to believe."

Family, love, TV shows, accessorizing and all the other little things are common themes in both these books, which talk about dealing with life from a humorous viewpoint. In *Out, Loud, & Laughing*, Frank Maya recalls high school gym class and how he learned "gay men cannot catch balls. I mean, once in a while you'll find a guy who can, but in general we can't catch balls. I'm sure that what they're doing in the military now that they can't ask — you walk in the door, they throw a ball at you and if you drop it they yell 'Fag!' and tell you to get out."

Comic Sara Cytron and her collaborating chief writer Harriet Malinowitz note in *Out...*, "As a comic, I travel around a lot and I see a lot of road signs. And very often I see a sign that says ADOPT A HIGHWAY. When I see this sign, I always wonder, 'What if you're a lesbian? Is it legal to adopt a highway? Isn't there a danger that somehow you'd influence the highway and it would become a lesbian highway?'"

Out, Loud, & Laughing is packed with one-liners and vignettes that will bring chuckles and knowing nods. It's like going to a comedy club to see routines without leaving your home. You can enjoy a snack or instead stuff yourself on the humor, depending on how hungry you are. Steve Moore, who centers his act on being the only openly AIDS-positive comedian, points out, "I figure you have to have a sense of humor about everything. That's how I deal with my situation. In my group therapy there's a woman with breast cancer who just had a mastectomy. Everyone in the group goes for that victim thing: 'Are you OK? Can I get you anything?' I'm like: 'Hey, Nancy...Nice tit!' She laughed. My T-cells went up. It was a lovely afternoon."

Some of the humor may seem rough or hard, but it's mostly about laughing together, and

at our own humanness. Like Don Rickles, Bill Cosby or Phyllis Diller, it's not about meanness; it's about oneness. And *Out, Loud, & Laughing* provides a bonus benefit besides giving its reader a chuckle: the publisher, Anchor Books, is donating all net royalties from sales of the book to Broadway Cares/Equity Fights AIDS, a group formed in 1987 that has raised and distributed millions of dollars in the fight against the disease.

If *Out, Loud, & Laughing* is a delicious snack, then *Growing Up Gay* is a feast divided into four courses. Funny Gay Males Cohen, McWilliams and Smith remember what it was like growing up unique and trying to find a way out — of the closet. "This book is not just for homosexuals. You don't have to be gay in order to be queer," the authors note. "Gay kids are not the only children growing up feeling like they'll have to make the best of a world that wasn't intended for them....This book, then, is being written for anyone who's genuinely excited about the advances we're making in identifying who we are — gay and straight — and how we can most ideally relate to one another."

Growing Up Gay looks at gays and dolls ("As misfits we often identified with other victims of oppression. Pretending to be an Indian had several other advantages: We got to dress up like Pocahontas, and we also got to choreograph delightful little rain dances — often to the score of *Annie Get Your Gun*"); comic books ("The Incredible Hulk was the Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hunk of the comic-book world."); queer TV vs. non-queer TV, and on to high school days ("Gay Math" question No. 6: "Margaret came out to her parents as a lesbian in 1978. Her parents made her see a psychiatrist for forty weeks at sixty-five dollars a visit. How many Melissa Etheridge albums might Margaret have bought with the money they could have saved?")

Some of this book may "flame" a bit too much, but most of it is just hot. And *Growing Up Gay* benefits from the bonus of sensational illustrations by Michiko Stehrenberger. The authors also leave their readers with the warning that a sequel, *Grown-Up Gay*, may be just down the road.

Hopefully the current explosion of gay literature, especially gay humor, is a trend that will never be reversed. Today's books are noted and praised for being hilarious and social-minded. When they're more common, and are praised on merit — and these two books earn high praise — then we've taken some good steps in the proper direction.

Whatever You Do, Don't See *Braveheart*

Why decry bigotry, why wring your hands over gay and lesbian bashing and then support it with your money? To see Mel Gibson's latest film is like sending a contribution to Jerry Falwell. Both are men of wealth and power who've found they can make big bucks by bravely attacking gays. You and I, by contrast, have only one defense. We can save our money. A handful of pickets in front of the theater will do nothing but insure long lines of homo-haters at the box office.

Right off, let me admit that I've not seen this much-hyped, multimillion-dollar spectacular. Nor will I. Not ever. So perhaps I've no valid right to critique it. But I've read enough reviews and listened to enough comments to know that, once again, Gibson has gone out of his way to slam gays — all the while pretending innocence. "I don't see how it could be interpreted that way (i.e., anti-gay), actually...I don't foresee any problem."

Any problem? *Braveheart* is ostensibly a "fact-based" epic. Yet it pits the stereotypical gay/nellie King Edward II of England against the equally stereotypical straight/heroic Sir William Wallace of Scotland, as portrayed by the super-macho hunk Mel Gibson.

By playing to stereotypes, by painfully distorting history, Gibson is able to whip up anti-gay sentiment. Audiences, as if on cue, howl with laughter every time Edward II, in nellie makeup and dandy dress, appears. They wildly cheer when Edward's father knocks him down and kicks him. They applaud when the father tosses Edward's lover, Philip (a totally fictional character), out a castle window to his death. The star and director says of his sure-to-make-millions *Braveheart*, "It's the kind of film I always wanted to see when I was growing up." Yes, I'm sure it is.

But Is It Really Gay Bashing? Consider the Facts

Wouldn't it be nice if films could be entertaining and at the same time educational? Wouldn't it be beneficial to our country if its

citizens were informed rather than deliberately misinformed? Well, why not? It's been said that truth is stranger than fiction. It's been proven that historical accuracy can be just as entertaining. Yet, for as long as films have been made, Hollywood has dedicated itself to distortions and downright damn lies. Consider how Hollywood has portrayed blacks. And Indians. And gay men and women. In the pursuit of millions, not even the Bible has been safe.

While it's no longer socially acceptable to attack minorities, gay men and women are still fair game. So leave it to the bravehearted Gibson to resort to lies to justify homophobia. Why do Gibson, his researchers and writers go out of their way to make Edward II the villain? Edward was 13 at the time of the 1297 rebellion. It was not the son, but his father, the very formidable Edward I ("The Hammer of the Scots") that Sir William Wallace faced. Edward II didn't come to the throne until 1307, two years after Wallace's death.

Why the snide remarks to the effect that Edward II was unable to father an heir? In fact, he did — Edward III.

Why does Gibson find it necessary for Wallace to impregnate Edward's wife, Isabelle — the ultimate insult! In fact, the two never met. Wallace had been dead for three years when Princess Isabelle of France arrived in England for the purpose of marrying Edward II.

Yes, King Edward II was gay. So what? There have been many English and Scottish kings throughout history who were gay. King Richard the Lion-Hearted (he of the third Holy Crusades) and King James I (he of the King James Bible), to mention just two. Like their heterosexual counterparts, some were great kings, others were not.

The Gay and Lesbian Alliance Against Defamation [GLAAD] of Los Angeles is to be praised for passing out flyers of protest. The flyers read, in part, "In *Braveheart*, Mel Gibson has gone out of his way to use his powers as director and star to ridicule gays.

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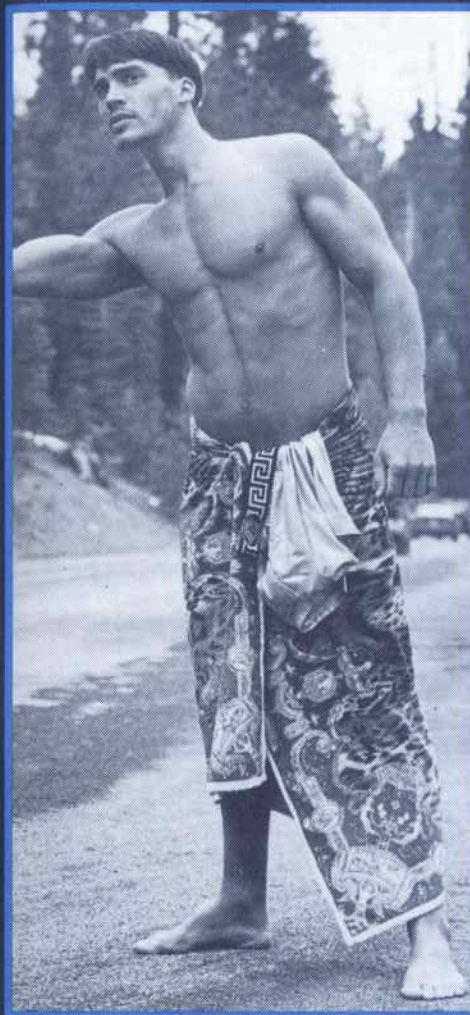
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This is not the first time. How brave is his gay bashing — and how funny is it — when we are beaten up on the streets of America because of who we are and whom we love?" (Beaten up? We are *murdered* for who we are and whom we love!)

Therefore, please don't be unconscious where prejudice is concerned. *You* may be the next victim of gay bashing. Please don't support this movie! If you wish to do even more, you may write to Mel Gibson at Ikon Productions; Paramount; 5555 Melrose; Hollywood, CA 90038.

Gibson has stated, "I became an actor despite that (the fear of being perceived as gay). But with this look, who's going to think I'm gay? It would be hard to take me for someone like *that*."

Hmm, I wonder. Shakespeare's comment "The lady doth protest too much, methinks" comes to mind. Why is Gibson so insecure in his own masculinity that he feels the need to attack gays, time and again?

I'm very certain Mr. Gibson will *never* miss my patronage. But you know what? I'm damn certain I'll miss his films even less.

A Final Note You May Not Want to Read

For the record: Both King Edward II and Sir William Wallace suffered extremely painful and grisly deaths. To make sure that his body remain unmarked, "The King's trousers were removed, and he was placed on his back on a table, his legs pinned to his chest by several strong men. The hollowed-out horn of an animal was then inserted into his anus, and a red-hot poker rammed through the horn. The King died after a few moments of indescribable agony and screaming.

"It was announced that the King had died of natural causes. But the villagers and those in the castle had heard the shrieks of the tortured King."

As for Sir William Wallace, after his capture he was brought to London where he was tried and found guilty of treason. Instead of an instant, merciful death, he was drawn (disemboweled). LOUGANIS WOWS LARGE TURNOUT AT CORNERSTONE GALA

*Benefit for Planned
Austin Gay Community Center
Proves A Huge Success.*

AUSTIN — The presence of Olympic gold medalist and AIDS sufferer/activist Greg Louganis helped make the evening wildly successful at the gala benefit for the Cornerstone, a group which is committed to establishing a community center for Austin's gay and lesbian community.

Louganis, who came out publicly as gay at the 1994 Gay Games in New York and then revealed earlier this year that he has been HIV-positive since 1988, came out strongly at the July 30 gala in support of the Cornerstone plans. Wearing a white long-sleeved shirt, gold- and multicolored vest, and gray slacks, an earring dangling from his left ear, the double gold medalist in diving at both the 1984 and '88 Summer Olympics explained to the crowd how important community and support can be.

"I didn't get a lot of that; I was afraid to be known for what I was, who I really was," Louganis explained. "During my diving career, I did experience some homophobia. When I knew that there were people in my corner, who would support me no matter what, that gave me the will to go out and keep fighting. That's the kind of support people will be able to find at a community center like the one you're planning, and why the Cornerstone is so important."

Over 400 tickets were presold for the evening, and there also was a large walkup turnout. A spokesperson for the Cornerstone said tabulations on how much was raised would be complete in about ten days, but the event was a giant positive step in the organization's drive to raise \$200,000 in cash and \$500,000 in secured funds for purchase of property where the Cornerstone facility will be built.

Tickets for the evening ranged from \$30 to \$1,000 (for "gold-medalist couples"). Louganis' 50-minute address kicked off festivities which also included an exquisite dinner, a fajita buffet, dancing, the silent auction of over two dozen items and a dessert reception with the Olympic champion in the Presidential Suite for gold- and silver-medalist ticketholders. The gala was

held at the Four Seasons Hotel, with Life Partners, Inc., as sponsors.

Larger than life, yet open, friendly and almost humble with everyone who chatted with him or sought his autograph, Louganis was the focus and the star of the evening. He talked about his best-selling book *Breaking the Surface*, which came out earlier this year, and expanded upon the triumphs and tragedies of his life: diving, being abused, testing positive for HIV, and many other adventures and feelings. He was welcomed with a minute-long standing ovation before he had even said his first words, and the enraptured audience interrupted his speech time and again with more applause.

"It's amazing how powerful secrets are, because they really imprison you," Louganis noted. "The first person you have to come out to, to be honest with, is yourself. When I came out publicly at the Gay Games in New York last year, it was a safe environment, and I had a blast...a lot of fun, and I got a lot of support while I was there."

"When I do my book signings, I've been meeting some incredible people; it makes you realize that everyone has their own story. I wanted to be here, to be healthy, to talk about and say you're able to live a good quality of life as long as you're able to take care of yourself. And the support of community is very important for a person's wellness."

Entertainment for the evening was provided by Cafe Manhattan (Sterling Price-McKinny and Karen Kuykendall, with Price-McKinney doing a tremendous turn as emcee before Louganis' speech). TURTLE CREEK CHORALE'S EUROPEAN TOUR A TRIUMPH

*Group Contributes to Local Gay,
HIV Organizations in Three Cities.*

DALLAS — When the Turtle Creek Chorale's Tim Seelig presented an \$11,000 check to a representative from SOHO, an AIDS organization in Prague, "The man," as Seelig, Artistic Director of the Chorale and its driving force since 1987, recalls, "broke down and began weeping on my

shoulder. It's something I'll never forget." That was just one of the memorable highlights of the Chorale's recently-completed three-city European tour.

The 150 members of the choral group who made the trek served as ambassadors not only for the city of Dallas, but for gay men and lesbians as well, helping to open the eyes of many and giving hope to others, especially in the Czech Republic, where the group's concert was the largest gay event in that newly free country.

Their first concert took place at the prestigious Santos Creus Music Festival in Barcelona, Spain at a monastery where monks have sung vespers (evening prayers) every night for over 700 years.

Next on the singing group's itinerary was



Berlin, the heart of gay life in Europe for decades. Seelig said the Chorale had no idea what to expect, since Berlin is widely considered "the gayest city in the world next to Amsterdam." "There are hundreds of gay bars, and so much competition. But from the first song, the audience wouldn't stop applauding. They clapped and clapped for us, pushing our concert longer than it should have lasted."

Then came Prague (Czech Republic) at the Rudolfinum, which houses the Czech Philharmonic. It was at that concert that the Chorale donated the \$11,000 to SOHO, a gay and lesbian AIDS organization that is government-sponsored. That money — an enormous sum in a relatively poor country where \$2,000 is equivalent to a year's salary — will go towards the hiring of an AIDS caregiver and a full-time worker for AIDS education, the printing of literature



and the purchase of medical equipment.

"So for a year," Seelig remarked, "we changed the course of the Czech Republic, of AIDS care and gay and lesbian rights. At least for a year, they'll have money to do what they can do with it."

The donation in Prague was similar to contributions the Chorale made during their other two stops. At each of their concerts, the group raised money for local AIDS agencies, with 100% of total proceeds going towards the services. The renowned singing group not only paid their way across the Atlantic, but also paid for meals, lodging and all expenses associated with their concerts, including the rental of performance halls, so that they could give as much as possible to gay organizations in Europe.

Seelig said Chorale members encountered the same question over and over again while on tour: "Why would you spend this kind of money and time, bring close to 200 people over here and give away all the proceeds?" As he explained, "We do this all the time at home in Dallas, Austin, Fort Worth and other places. We don't charge anyone to sing. The mission statement of the Chorale has changed from the beginning, from just bringing beautiful male choral music to Dallas, then to Texas, then to the country and now to the world. Each of the members had their own reasons for going, but for the organization, it was really wonderful to take our sounds not only out of Texas, but all the way to Europe....We did such remarkable things for the self esteem of gays over there. I don't think they or us will ever be the same."

Season tickets for the Chorale's 16th season go on sale Aug. 15. Highlights of the new season include appearances by Harvey Fierstein, Michael Feinstein and Metropolitan Opera star Gary Lakes. For more information, call (214)526-3214.

CANDACE GINGRICH BRINGS COMING-OUT MESSAGE TO HOUSTON

*Half-Sister of GOP House Speaker
Urges Greater Involvement.*

HOUSTON — Candace Gingrich brought her message of coming out and getting involved to Houston last Tuesday evening, but her relationship with her famous half-brother and what he thinks of her drew nearly as much attention.

The "Town Hall" meeting (and one in San Antonio on Thursday), at the Metropolitan Multi-Service Center on West Gray, was one of dozens of stops that Gingrich, sister of House Speaker Newt Gingrich, is making on a nationwide tour this summer promoting the Human Rights Campaign Fund's National Coming Out Project. That program urges gay and lesbian people to be open and honest about themselves and to become involved in educating elected officials and other Americans on gay issues.

"Coming-out stories remind us of what we all have in common," she observed, saying she thought of herself as having come out three times in her life. In college, she joined the women's rugby team, and became comfortable with acknowledging she was a lesbian when she discovered a few of the other players were gay. A short while later, her mother found a lesbian newsletter while cleaning her room, an incident which led Gingrich to come out to her family.

Her third coming-out experience took place, of course, in the wake of last November's elections, which saw the Republican Party take control of Congress. Her brother Newt became Speaker of the House of Representatives, and Candace Gingrich soon found herself in the spotlight. She drew chuckles Tuesday evening when, in response to a question from the audience, she noted that Newt had declared himself "pleased as punch" when informed of her decision to work with HRCF.

"I can't change what I haven't done...Now I have the opportunity and the chance to make a difference," Candace Gingrich said in explaining why she hadn't become publicly involved in gay and lesbian issues earlier. She again drew laughter when she noted, "I'm glad you didn't

wait until your brother became Speaker to get involved."

Gingrich urged her audience to make legislators aware of their concerns and pointed to the work the Human Rights Campaign Fund is doing.

During a question-and-answer session following Gingrich's address, transgender activist Sara De Palma heatedly insisted that the Employment Non-Discrimination Act, an HRCF-supported bill to prohibit job discrimination based on sexual orientation, would not protect transgender people.

In addition to National Coming Out Day, HRCF lobbies legislators on issues of importance to gay, lesbian and HIV-positive people; works to educate the public; and through its political action committee makes financial and in-kind contributions to supportive political candidates for Congress. National Coming Out Day is on Wednesday, Oct. 11 this year. HRCF can be reached by calling 1-800-572-HRCF.

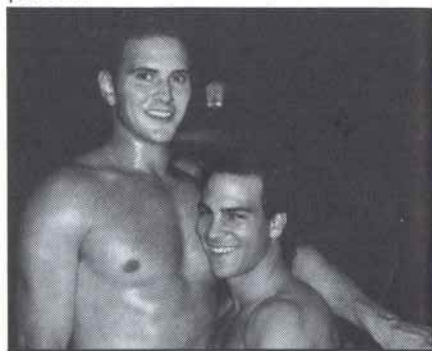

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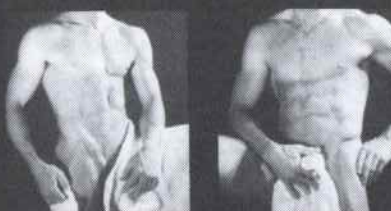
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Tom R. Reveley

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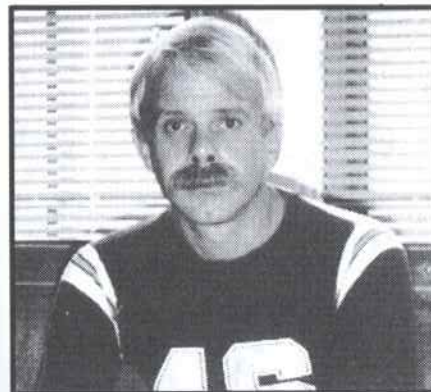
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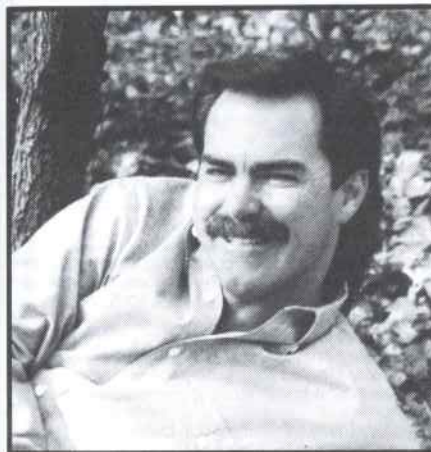

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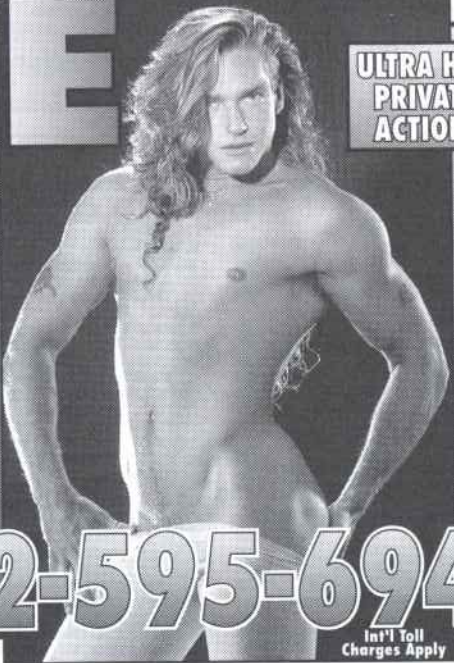
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
