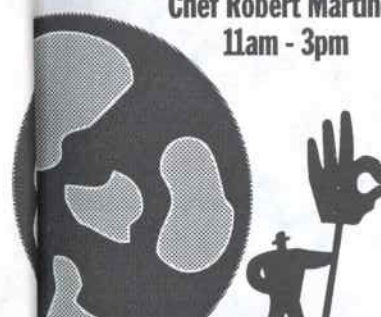

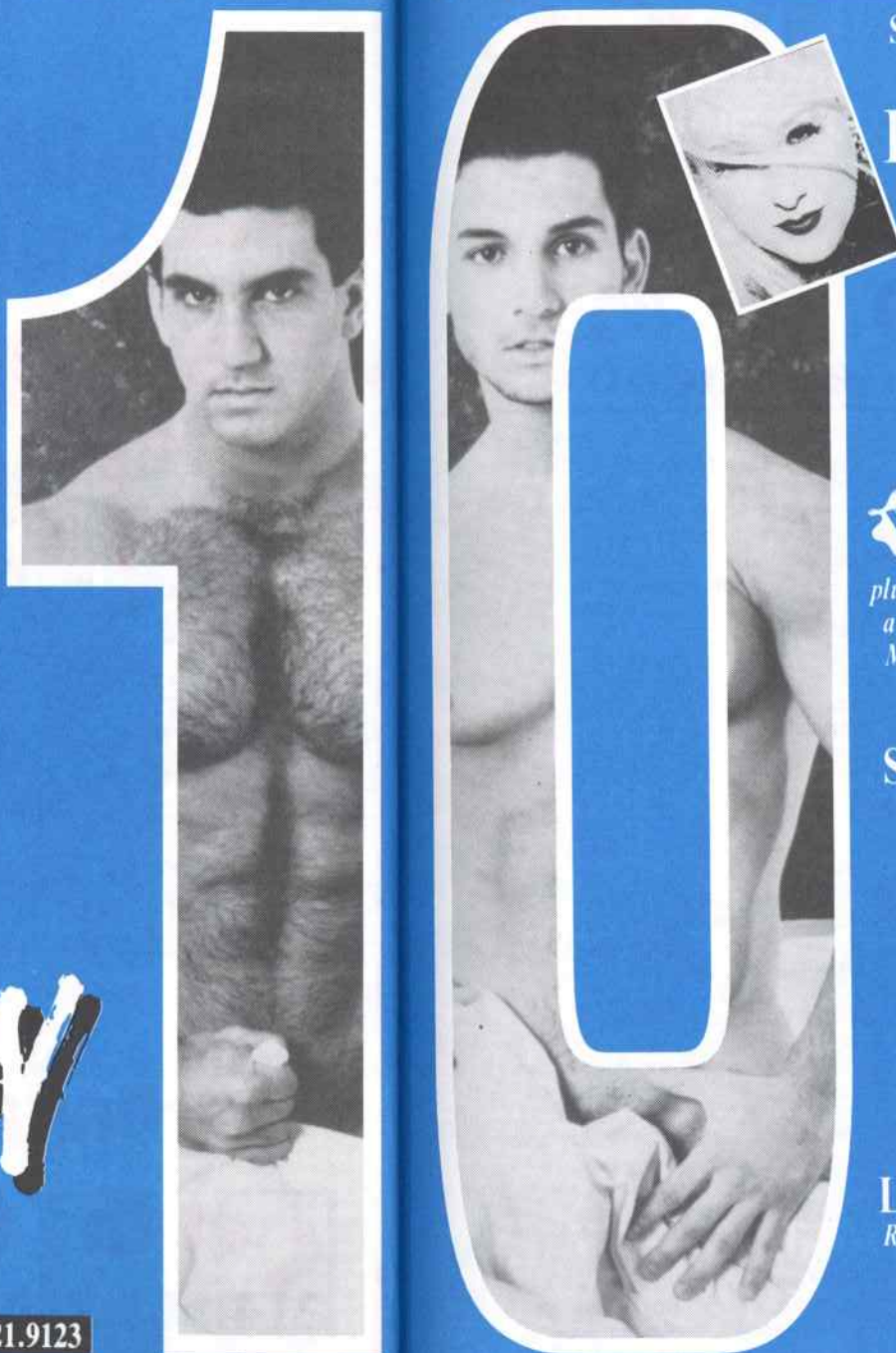

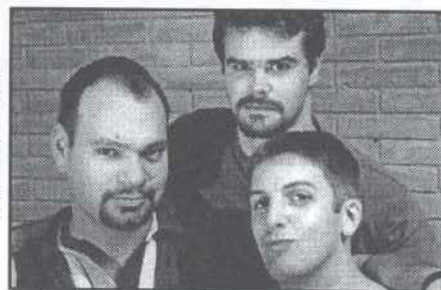

Surprising Twists and Turns Spark The M.O. of M.I. at Austin's Planet Theatre

Wow! Playwright Aaron Brown insists he has the firm conviction that gay characters should be real and not just "those funny, gay neighbors." So he has endowed the characters of his new play *The M.O. of M.I. (The Modus Operandi of Male Intimacy)* with enough twists and turns and double-somersaults-without-a-

net that all you can do is sit back and savor and wonder what might spring up next.

Middle-aged Michael (Laith M. Radif) and ten-years-younger Thomas (Lane Pianta) are celebrating the eight-month anniversary of their relationship. Performance artist Jonathon (Matthew Patterson), who's closer to Thom's age but flirting shamelessly with Michael, is a newcomer to town with nowhere to stay. Jonathon's flirtatious friendliness and carefree style threaten to tear apart Michael and Thom's ever-more-shaky domestic comfortableness.

Yet just when you think you know what's coming, that you've heard it all before,

known someone just like that, even lived it yourself, author Brown gives the plot some new spins. And new problems and possibilities are thrust into the mix. Act I ends with a jaw-dropping change of directions that had the audience abuzz, and the second act rollercoasters the three men's lives toward other unexpected, dangerous destinations.

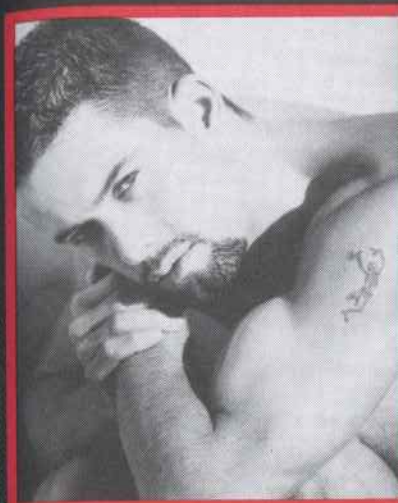
Brown has been creating theatre for 15 years, but while he's appeared in numerous plays, most of his writing has been in musicals. Yet he smoothly captures the everyday normalcy of his three characters, pumps in enough of fate's tragicomedy and winds up with a captivating tale of three guys who might be living next door to you, or in the place across the street. Michael, Thom and Jonathon are so everyday (at least in the first act) that you're sure to know someone like them. Just hope your acquaintances don't wind up the way Brown's protagonists evolve.

The delightful production is aided by superb work from cast and crew alike. Director Bonnie Cullum, known for dark works like *Faustus* and *Beirut*, does just as well with the comedy and normal life that make up the start of *The M.O. of M.I.*...and then smoothly directs the flow onto unexpected and dangerous paths.

This is just one of those shows where everyone deserves to take a giant bow: For a world premiere, everything was about as close to perfect as you can get. The teamwork of Brown on sound, Radif on scene design, Brad Butler on lighting, T'Cie Mancuso on costumes and Cullum

on props, plus Che Lopez, Dory Parisi, Kevin Lee and the actors, made for an enjoyable evening that was so much more than anticipated. Excellence, from top to bottom.

Radif's Michael is a well-to-do 30-something who's pretty happy with what he's got, though still a little curious and wistful about what he might possibly be missing. He's not afraid to pull rank on Thom, insisting, "It's my house, so I say he can use the guest room." On the other hand, Michael is willing to bend over backwards when he can to let Thom have his way and protect their threatened relationship; he really loves his younger half.

Pianta's Thom, on the other hand, is mercurial and unpredictable — one moment sweet and loving and contrite, the next jealous and catty and demanding. Sometimes it seems as if Pianta makes Thom's mood swings too rapid and unexplainable, but as things develop it turns out there may actually be method here, no matter the degree of madness.

Patterson's Jonathon is the carefree spirit, unentangled like the two roommates. He can come and go as he pleases, deal joints and other drugs and not worry about answering to anyone other than himself. And yet, is he really happier than the roommates, or are there some deep secrets and fears that even he hides?

"Religion is a string of ambiguities," Michael tells Thom in defending a performance art piece by Jonathon. Michael could just as easily have substituted "life" for "religion"; the twists and turns that enmesh the three gay men prove a bit frightening, but even more fascinating; they make willing voyeurs and accomplices of us all, as the trio work to unravel their destinies in life.

Good theatre gathers the audience up in the telling and transports them along, willing, no matter where the ride may go. *The M.O. of M.I.* is excellent theatre, because it deals with reality while at the same time rarely allowing it to get boring.

Double wow!

The M.O. of M.I. is playing at 11 p.m. Fridays and Saturdays though Sept. 9 at Planet Theatre, 2307 Manor Rd. in Austin. The VORTEX Repertory Company production also has 9 p.m. shows Sept. 3 and 10. Tickets are \$11 (\$7 discount); call (512)499-TIXS for reservations.

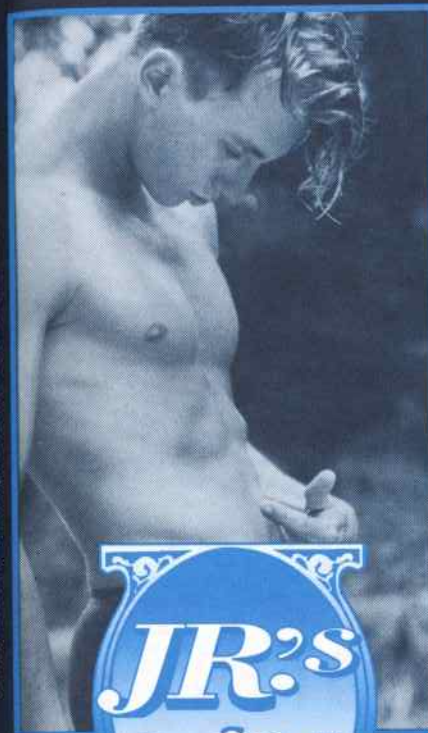

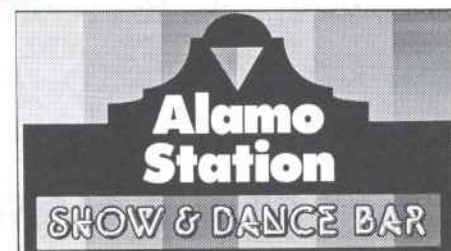

**Republican and Democratic
Supporters of Gay Rights
Must Join Together to Fight
The Extremist Onslaught**

The infamous 1992 Republican Convention in Houston bore an eerie comparison to the 1960 Republican Convention in Chicago. Judging from the scorched-earth political style and new-found arrogance of Republicans since their '94 election sweep, it is likely that the 1996 Convention will continue the trend. In 1960, the moderate mainstream of the GOP was under attack from the extreme right of that time — the John Birch Society. In 1992, the nation heard the battle cry by the extreme right once again from its spokesman, Pat Buchanan, declaring a "cultural and religious war" for America.

In 1996, the dwindling band of Republican moderates will face a new onslaught by an ever stronger, more sophisticated and consequently more dangerous extreme right — the Christian Coalition, led by Pat Robertson, his handmaiden Ralph Reed and a host of other well-financed and influential "family" clones: from the Rev. Donald Wildmon's American Family Association and Gary Bauer's Family Research Council to James Dobson's Focus on the Family and Paul Cameron's Family Research Institute, etc., etc., ad nauseam.

These anti-gay and anti-democratic groups will be aided and abetted in their efforts to take over the Republican Party by the arrogance of the GOP majority class of 1994, who took their mandate as an excuse for a "conservative" revolution which, as it continues its frontal attack on hard-won past legislative achievements, begins to lose touch with the very people they are paid to represent. Their contempt for any moderation will be their undoing.

Today, as fundamentalists on the right attempt to dictate the moral compass of the nation, their stance on issues has taken on a religious/moral/Christian bent while they are using political power and the weapons



of government to achieve ends that their prayers have not achieved. They seek to replace democracy with theocracy and impose their own version of the Kingdom of God on America through the Republican Party.

In spite of his sanctimonious smile and sophisticated rhetoric, Pat Robertson is an ultra-extremist. A couple of years ago, he wrote some words that have already become part of American political folklore. According to Robertson, the passage of an Iowa Equal Rights Amendment would advance "...a feminist agenda...that would encourage women to leave their husbands, kill their children, practice witchcraft, destroy capitalism and become lesbians." Robertson's rhetoric continued from the podium at the 1992 GOP convention in Houston, when he said that unless America returns to "...her Christian roots...she will continue to legalize sodomy, slaughter innocent babies, destroy the minds of her children, squander her resources and sink into oblivion."

In true revolutionary spirit, the Republicans are calling for the abolishment of many programs that will essentially finish off a host of environmental, safety, health and civil rights programs that were fought for and achieved by both Democrat and Republican legislators in the past. Unfortunately, the Republican revolution bears more resemblance to the National Socialist takeover of the Weimar Republic [in Germany] in 1933 than to the American Revolution of 1776. It is the constant talk of "Christian" and "traditional" values that is becoming so ominous and worrisome to so many Americans. Can the "conservative" new Republicans not see that there are non-Christians in the United States — Jews, Buddhists, Muslims, Taoists, agnostics, atheists? Are the only family values Christian? What about Jewish, African-American, gay and lesbian family values? When the Christian Coalition takes over the Party, who will be in? Who will be out?

And who will decide?

The *déjà vu* is now complete. 1960. 1992. 1996. The new extremists are beginning to take over the Republican Party with seemingly acquiescent approval of the desperate-to-please GOP presidential hopefuls — Bob Dole, Phil Gramm and Pete Wilson. Pat Robertson has said, "We want...as soon as possible to see a working majority of the Republican Party in the hands of pro-family Christians by 1996." He will succeed unless radical steps are taken by those Republicans who still hold fast to the philosophical heritage of Abraham Lincoln, Theodore Roosevelt and Barry Goldwater.

Today, with the end of the Soviet empire, and the upsurge of the radical "Christian" right desperate to find another enemy, true conservatives have found a closer tie with moderate Republicans and Democrats than with those on the far right and their fundamentalist allies. Together, a new political alliance must be forged to create a powerful new voice in American politics, a party committed to individual rights, free enterprise and a renewed com-

mitment to embracing the rich diversity of American life.

At this crucial and dangerous time for our community, we believe it is incumbent upon lesbian and gay Americans to support *only* those politicians who support us, whether they be Republican or Democrat. We should pose the question to *all* candidates for public office — from the local school boards to the city councils to the state legislatures to the Congress and to the Presidency. We must be vocal against those who vacillate or don't take our demand for equal rights seriously. There are enough politicians who support our fight, and believe in the Bill of Rights and the principles of tolerance with which our country was founded, to volunteer for, contribute to and vote for. We must fight hard against the others.

Albert Camus wrote that revolution kills both men and principles. Log Cabin Republicans and Democrat lesbian and gay groups must rebel against the onslaught on our civil rights. If not, then we will be left drowning in the wake of the new extremism.

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"Jimmy, Jimmy, how come you never talk about Techno music in your column?!" Okay, well, it's like this. Techno music, for the most part, was a short-lived phase of mindless music that somehow filtered into gay tabernacles about three years ago. Most of us, however, got over it pretty quickly as there were no real guts to it. All of it began to sound alike — rampant thrashings of "sound" running together in an endless array of messiness. Now one might say, "But, dude, it's great music to trip out to." I rest my case: you need drugs to really get into it; hmm. Anyway, with our goal of satisfying all of our readers, here we go.

Attention, Technoheads! Check out **Rafy DJ Melendez's** latest EP, *Todo Puerto Rico*. It's as mindless and rampant as any



Techno music I've ever had the "pleasure" of hearing, complete with four tracks for your tripping-out pleasure, dude. Satisfied? Me too.

As summer begins to wind down and the pace of new releases does as well, expect to see some of your deejays wearing new clothes, since we'll now be able to afford some. I had to really dig this time to come up with some dance trinkets to tell you about, so here we go....

After her huge "Loving Arms" hit this year, everyone knows who **Billie Ray Martin** is for sure. Check out Radikal's release of "Sky-high" by Individual (not a cover), with vocals by Billie Ray. Smooth, straight-ahead House with an NRG undertone — really sweet! See if you can get ahold of the double pack that's floating around. But really, now — how can you go wrong with Ms. Martin?

One piece that's been out awhile (and sure to go all the way to #1), that for whatever reason I haven't told you about, is "Everybody Be Somebody" by **Ruffneck** featuring "Yavahn." Everyone is going nuts over this one! Hard-hitting House to work you, with or without "vitamins." Very edge-ish, almost alternative-sounding at points. The track combines a hard, infectious bass-line with fabulous synth work to captivate you for its

entire nine-minute, 13-second run.

Another cutesy House track that everyone needs is "Eeny Meeny (Sweet Temptation)" by **Ruffnexx Sound System** (not to be confused with the above. Remixes by Teri Bristol and Mark Picciotti set this one up to be a smacker on the charts.

House-heads, beware...Here's one for you. Strictly Rhythm's release of **Mone's** "We Can Make It" (also available on A&M/Import) is probably one of the hottest things to come out on that label all year. I'll tell you this much — Joe T. Vanelli has kicked ass again! It's out on a double pack with a smart selection of eight mixes to choose from, all of them slamin'.

I've never really been a great fan of **Incognito**, but their latest, "Everyday," has kind of gotten my attention. It's one of those smooth Housers that you listen to five or six times and it doesn't quite move you, and then



all of a sudden, on that lucky seventh time (a few Miller Lites later), it hits you — "Hey, I think I might like this after all!" After all, the mixes are by Masters at Work and Roger Sanchez!

Italy's Groove Groove Melody label has tinkled with **Libra's** "Closer to Me" — beautiful purist's soaring Hi-NRG, with diva-driven vocals featuring a gorgeous Hi-House flip. Definitely worth owning.

Several covers have come our way this week, some good and some *really* good. The first is a collectible piece for the nostalgic at heart. **Knew Romeo's** cover of Cher's "Save Up All Your Tears" and **Andy Kim's** "Rock Me Gently" are more or less pretty cheesy, but cute for a happy hour crowd or early on at a Sunday T-dance. **Legion 7** has done justice to Sting's classic "Every Breath You Take" on Back Stage Records; the track almost has a dark undertone. *Organizers Hope to Attract
6,000 Participants, Raise Over
\$300,000 at Oct 22 Event.*

AUSTIN — AIDS Services of Austin [ASA] has scheduled its eighth annual From All Walks of Life 5K fund-raiser for Sunday, Oct. 22. The event, the largest single-day AIDS awareness and fund-raising benefit of its kind in Central Texas, is expected to attract approximately 6,000 people and bring in more than \$300,000 in pledges to support ASA and 18 other area AIDS service providers. Program; CEACO; Christopher House; Community Action, Inc.; the HIV Wellness Center; Hospice of Austin; InterAct; Out Youth Austin; the People's Community Clinic; Planned Parenthood of Austin; Project Threads; Project Transitions; the University YWCA; and Waterloo Counseling Center.

For the third year, Miller Lite/Centex Beverage, Inc. has signed on as an Olympic sponsor of the Walk, contributing \$10,000. Other major sponsors include 107.1 KGSR, *Austin American-Statesman*, Pharmaco-LSR, Lotus Development Corp., Coors of Austin, Liberty National Bank, St. David's Health Care Systems, Tramex Travel and EDS.

The organization is seeking to raise \$700,000 as quickly as possible toward the purchase of property on which a community center and related offices can be established.

Life Partners, a Waco viatical firm, was the exclusive corporate sponsor for the July 30 gala and underwrote Louganis' fee. The participation of more sponsors will be one of the chief considerations in planning for the next fund-raiser.

*Concert, Display of Art Will
Highlight First Annual Event.*

HOUSTON — October is shaping up to be a great month for Texans who enjoy

Producers of the Houston Women's Festival are Planet Earth Productions, which since 1990 has presented local shows by Monica Grant, Deidre McCalla, Girls in the Nose and Jamie Anderson; Fern TV, which has produced programs shown on the Houston cable access channel dealing with women's issues and interests, and which Chambliss indicated may include coverage of the Festival in a future program; and Active Imaginations, a business new to the Houston area that specializes in the design and distribution of environmental consciousness-raising T-shirts. Active Imaginations is designing a one-of-a-kind festival T-shirt which will be available at locations around Montrose.

Chambliss said tickets for the Houston Women's Festival would go on sale around the first of October.
