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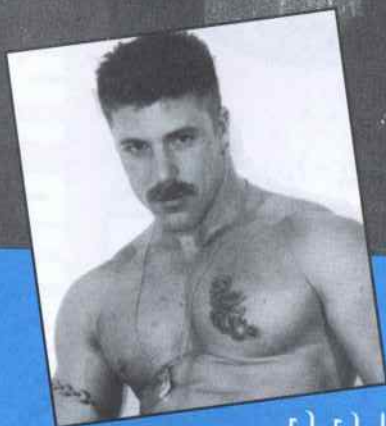

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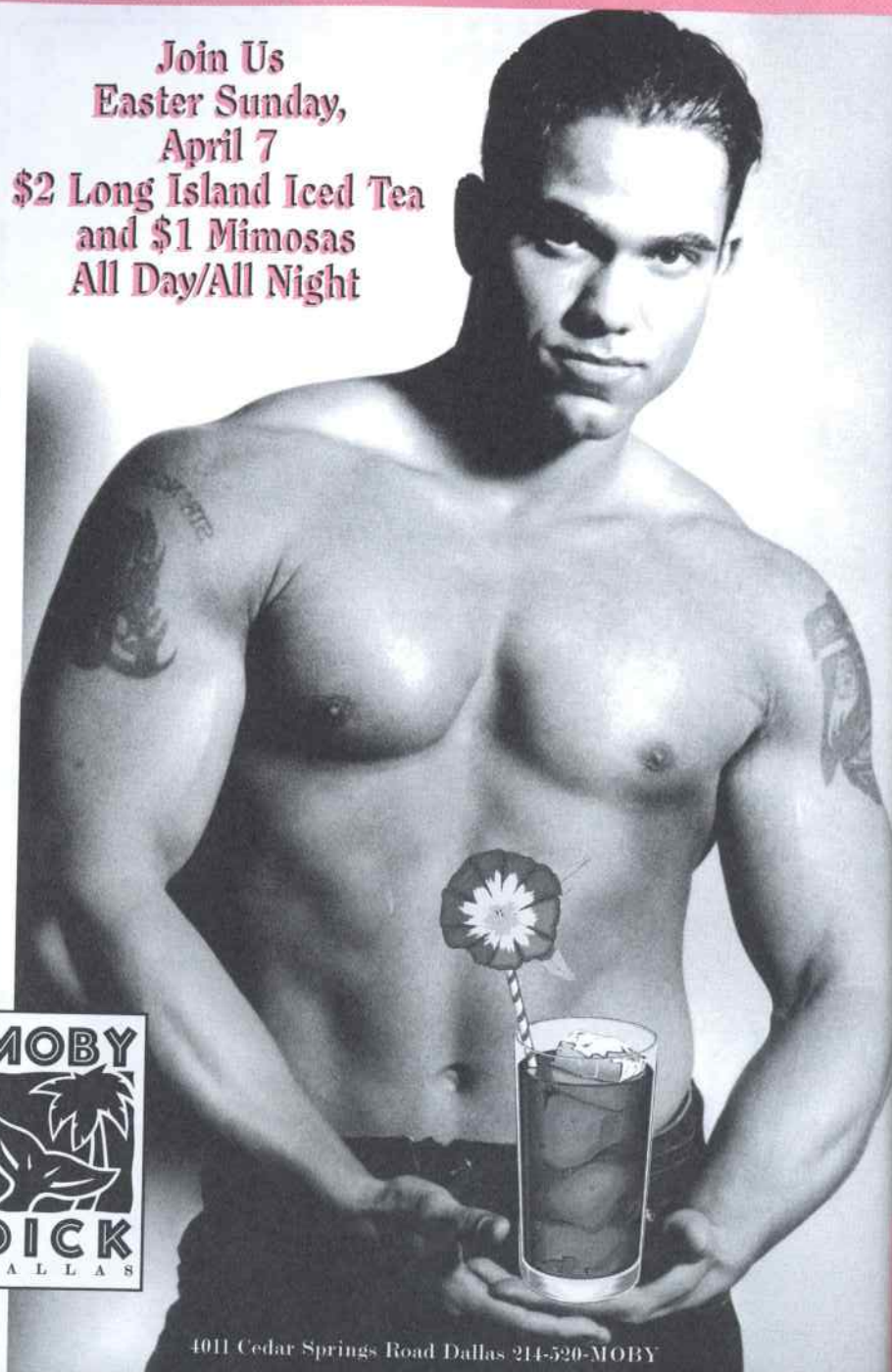
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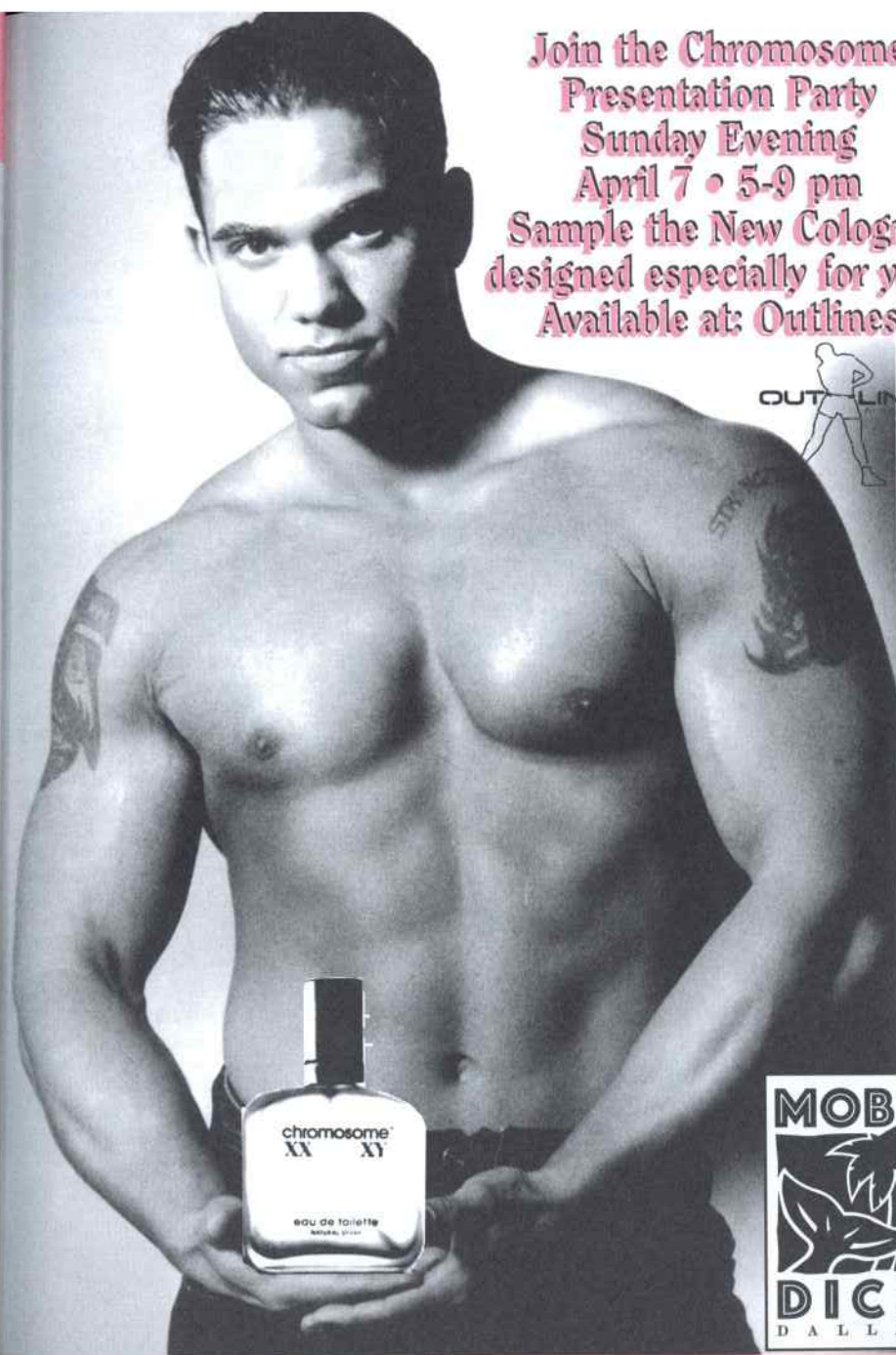

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# What's Out of Interest to Gays and Lesbians

Look for actor **Eric Roberts** in his latest role, as a gay man dying of AIDS, in the just-released feature film *It's My Party*. The cast includes a vast array of familiar Hollywood faces, from **Olivia Newton-John**, **Margaret Cho**, **George Segal**, **Marlee Matlin**, **Lee Grant** and **Bronson Pinchot**, among others. There's even a brief cameo appearance by the late Dallas entertainer **Rhapsody**. We'll see if this one meets with the same incredible commercial success as the smash comedy *The Bird Cage*, which was perched atop the



charts for four weeks and is still going strong. *Bird Cage*'s opening weekend out-grossed that of any other film so far this year; crowds flocked to the American remake of *La Cage aux Folles*, which has been helped by an over-the-top performance by **Nathan Lane**, who we hope will be included in next year's Oscar nominations. Industry insiders say *Bird Cage* has brought in over \$70 million and could easily top the \$100 million mark in just a few weeks, possibly making it one of the top-grossing features of the year....

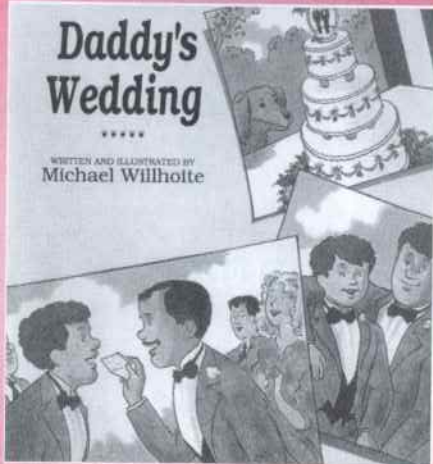

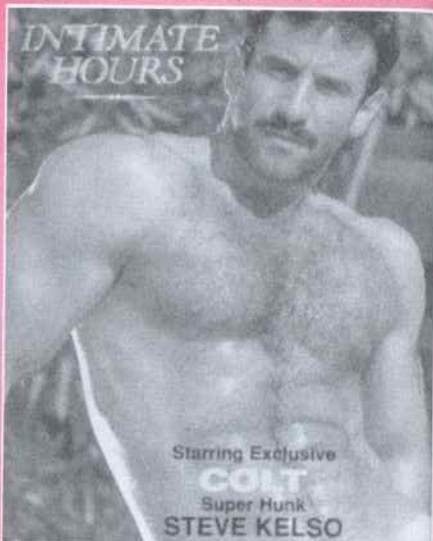

hunky porn star on his very own disc, *Intimate Hours* — but this one runs only on Windows software. These should be available at your local gay book and video store....

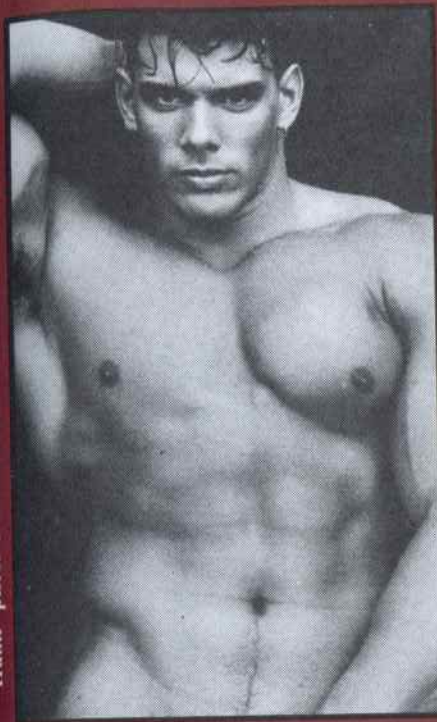

# the celluloid closet

**Takes An Entertaining,  
Insightful Tour of the History  
of Gay Screen Images**

**H**umans are social animals; we cling together in groups. And the smaller the group, the harder we cling. As members of a minority — gay people — we are instinctively attracted to others like ourselves, and are reassured by their presence. The gay community, especially since Stonewall, has identified itself and found its place in contemporary culture. For good or bad, we are no longer invisible. But it hasn't always been that way. For almost a hundred years we were all but nonexistent in a medium that defined American culture — the movies. Hollywood taught us how to act, how to look and who to be, and to the extent that gay men and lesbians were depicted at all, the images in question were, almost without exception, negative.

*The Celluloid Closet*, a documentary based on the late Vito Russo's book of the same title, chronicles the depiction of gay and lesbian characters in popular films. For producers/directors Rob Epstein and Jeffrey Friedman, this film was a labor of love that began in 1987, when the team first got together. Financing for any film is difficult, and raising money for a film about the Hollywood image of homosexuality was nearly impossible, but the team persevered, gaining the interest of influential producers and artists like Lily Tomlin. Tomlin, a friend of Russo, spearheaded a direct-mail fund-raising campaign and benefit. By 1994, half the budget had been raised, and through the efforts of Tomlin, HBO agreed to supply the remaining half. Production began immediately.

*The Celluloid Closet* is narrated by Tomlin, and features on-screen interviews of Armistead Maupin, Tony Curtis, Whoopi Goldberg, Harvey Fierstein, Shirley MacLaine, Tom Hanks and more than a dozen other actors, directors, producers and writers. Meticulously researched clips take us from the beginning of the motion picture industry — rare footage of an 1895 Edison experimental film shows two men dancing together while a third plays a violin — a piece of unintentional camp as the two dancers obviously try to figure out who will lead. As cinema progressed through the silent era, the image of the stock gay char-

acter emerged. Always played for laughs, the mincing, effeminate "sissy" was a sure-fire gag, one that would define what it meant to be gay to generations of American movie-goers.

After that, the overtly gay character disappears from the screen for more than 30 years. They were still there, but between the lines. Some of *The Celluloid Closet*'s most engaging moments occur in an interview with the writer Gore Vidal. As a screenwriter for the late-fifties blockbuster *Ben-Hur*, Vidal recalls how he and the director conspired to spice up the biblical epic by hinting rather strongly at a homosexual relationship between Ben-Hur (Charlton Heston) and Massala (Stephen Boyd). It was all done with longing homoerotic looks directed at Heston by Boyd, and when the clip is shown in the context of Vidal's comments, the intent is unmistakable. Playing Doris Day's "Secret Love" over the *Ben-Hur* scene is one of this film's moments of high comedy.

Gore Vidal recalls how he and the director conspired to spice up *Ben-Hur* by hinting rather strongly at a homosexual relationship between the title character and Massala.

It's this kind of "behind-the-scenes" presentation that will appeal to movie buffs and anyone over 30 who can remember seeing these movies and wondering whether he imagined it, or did Laurence Olivier really proposition a dishy Tony Curtis in *Spartacus*? (The answer is "yes.")

From "women in prison" flicks, in which tough-as-nails matrons have their way with pretty little pieces of fluff, to '50s musicals (Jane Russell in *Gentlemen Prefer Blondes* singing "Ain't There Anyone Here for Love?" to a gaggle of scantily-clad body-builders who don't even know she's alive), and with a lavish original score and top-notch production values, *The Celluloid Closet* never fails to inform and entertain.

*The Celluloid Closet* opens at Landmark theaters around the state in the next few weeks. For opening dates and times, consult local listings.

to discover that five Canadian actors have banded together in Toronto and made a very big name for themselves here in the States. So big, in fact, that on April 12 they make their film debut in *Kids in the Hall BRAIN CANDY*, a Paramount Pictures release directed by Kelly Makin.

The Kids — David Foley, Bruce McCulloch, Kevin McDonald, Mark McKinney and Scott Thompson — make their big leap to the big screen fresh on the heels of the overwhelming success of their now syndicated television series, *The Kids in the Hall*. To the delight of their cult-like following, the group re-assembled last summer in Toronto to film *BRAIN CANDY* (which was also produced by Michaels), a satirical story about a mythical mood-altering prescription drug craze

"I never actually auditioned," Scott admits. "In fact, I pretty much managed to force my way in from the beginning."

While attending a stage performance of the original four, Thompson in effect inserted himself into a sketch by throwing chocolate doughnuts from his seat in the audience, creating an impromptu situation that snowballed into regular appearances.

"They initially cast me in all the thankless female roles," says Thompson. "I loved it!"

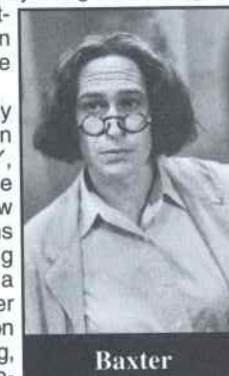
Later on he created scores of characters, but none so loved by gay viewers as Buddy Cole. "My best work, the work of which I am most proud, is Buddy." Through Cole, Thompson espoused his personal wisdom while planted firmly on a barstool, from which he delivered his often-quoted monologues on every imaginable subject, from sports and acting to the Queen Mother and race relations.

Although Buddy does not appear in *BRAIN CANDY*, Scott does manage to create some new characters for fans to enjoy, including Mrs. Hurdicure, a dating grandmother who's the first person to take the new drug, and Wally, a repressed gay dad who has just come out of the closet and who, according to Scott, appears naked in most of his scenes. Thompson also recreates his Queen of England character, a woman to whom he bears a striking resemblance.

Whoever Scott Thompson is or is playing, he is undeniably a force to be reckoned with in the entertainment field, diverse, creative and multitalented — a member of our "family" who's destined for great things.

**Dallas Theater Center Brings**  
**Part I of Tony Kushner's Epic**  
**To the Metroplex Through April 28**

The Dallas Theater Center concludes its 1995-96 season with the internationally acclaimed and award-winning *Angels in America, Part I: Millennium Approaches*. Tony Kushner's 3½-hour epic takes a sobering and humorous look at the political, sexual and spiritual landscape of contemporary America.

The celebrated play has garnered virtually every theatre award, including the Pulitzer Prize for Drama, the Tony Award, the New York Drama Critics' Circle Award and the London Evening Standard Award for Best New Play.

*Angels in America* is a major theatrical tour de force which had its world premiere in May 1991 and its Broadway premiere two years later. It provokes questions about our response to what this country is to be as we approach the year 2000.

The story takes place in New York City in the latter part of 1985. The stock market is booming and the AIDS toll is rising. The plot weaves together an array of characters, focusing on the lives of two couples. One pair consists of Prior Walter, a gay man who has just learned that he has AIDS, and his lover Louis Ironson, who eventually leaves him. The other couple are Joe Pitt, a Reaganite lawyer and straight-arrow Mormon who's struggling with his own sexual identity, and his wife Harper, who is reduced to a life of tranquilizers and depression brought on by her husband's secrets.

The Dallas production has been praised for the quality surrounding it, from the

direction of Dallas Theater Center Artistic Director Richard Hamburger to the high-caliber scenic designs of nationally-known Ming Cho Lee, who has won virtually accolade there is in his field, including the Tony Award, the Drama Desk Award, the Los Angeles Drama Critics Award and numerous others. Lee is currently Chairman of the Set Design program at the Yale School of Drama.

*Angels* is an unqualified success in Dallas. In just five days, it sold more than \$30,000 worth of individual tickets, which is usually the goal for an entire production at the Dallas Theater Center. The play has already been extended for two weeks and theatre officials are exploring the possibility of continuing the run even further because of the strong response.

ative reinterpretations of classic theatre pieces and for his dynamic productions of new works. ### TWT: Why did you want to bring *Angels in America* to Dallas?

Hamburger: It's such a beautiful play. I would have been remiss as an artistic director if I hadn't. It's a play for everyone, whether black or white or gay or straight. It's about responsibility, freedom, taking care of others, along with marriage, AIDS and other issues. It contains some very bracing thoughts, but tremendous amounts of humor throughout.

### You directed this play as well as produced it. Was that difficult?

Not at all. I felt privileged to direct and produce it. I was blessed with a marvelous group of collaborators. They're a superb group that were totally devoted to bringing Kushner's vision to the stage.

### Were you worried about the reaction from such a conservative city as Dallas, with the topics covered and the nudity and adult situations included in this work?

No, Dallas is a sophisticated city, and DTC plays to our most intelligent audience. There are many progressive, intelligent people in Dallas. This play has a terrific track record in every place it plays. We had every reason to believe it would do well and the community would respond well to the play. And it's a wonderful play for our community because it deals with a lot of issues in the American community, such as where are we heading into the next millennium. That's on people's minds a lot. Some people underestimate the intelligence of audiences, but when you do something wonderful like *Angels*, people come. I believe in audiences. At our opening night, we had the Mayor of Dallas, Ron Kirk, and we were all delighted. He supports the arts and is very visible doing that; taking the time to go see a play and watch artists working shows he's a responsive mayor.

### This play covers so many topics; is there one overriding message to it?

I'd call this a symphonic work, the canvas

is very large. Like all wonderful plays, it's not the one answer for people, but forces us to ask many, many questions about how we live our lives. You'll walk out more intensely alive than when you walked in. Hopefully you'll feel closer to those around you. Not the least of the many of its qualities, it helps us to be a little more tolerant of how other people live.

### Would you say *Angels* has a downbeat message because of some of the topics it deals with, or a positive one?

Oh, it's a very uplifting play, watching people cope with incredible difficulties with tremendous vitality and humor. Kushner has a very optimistic view of humanity.

### Everything about this production seems to be of the highest quality: the sets, the costumes, everything. How did you get so many quality people involved in it?

I asked them to join me in the journey and they all said "yes." I was really lucky to get such a great cast. The actors are the bravest ones, and this is a very brave cast. It doesn't matter what you put up there if the actors don't have life. They're doing noble work.

### Will you be bringing the second part of Kushner's play, *Perestroika*, to Dallas?

It's looking very good. There's a very strong possibility that we'll be doing it. The city will want to see it, and if the demand is there, we'd like to do it in early fall.

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**B**efore we get to the latest sprinkle of cute little go-go gems, I'd like to tell you about a few CDs I happened upon during my recent trip to Miami.

First off, check out Logic Records' latest **Barramundi** sampler, the third in a fab series, "The Spirit of Wandjina." This double CD sports 17 hypnotic, trippy, ambient tracks for that chillin' time that we all love so much. Various groups from the U.S., France, Australia, Belgium, Finland and the Netherlands give this collection an acute international flavor, and the selection of tracks is beyond compare. Gotta have this one! Also, check out Logic's web site at <http://www.logicrecords.com>.

Another double CD I've come across is *Dutch Dance Music 96*, an eclectic array of dance morsels of madness from the Netherlands. Although this one's a bit pricey (about \$36), it's definitely worth it. There are 31 tracks, varying in style from NRG, house, hi-house and progressive trance. Holland is really one of the happening places for dance music, and that country is moving into a new phase in 1996. On one hand, they're pushing the envelope of what is known as "dance music" by further exploring the electronic variety and its possibilities. On the other hand, the Dutch are nurturing and expanding dance's urban styles such as hip hop, R&B, jazz-cross-over and funk. The Netherlands is producing such a diversity of dance music that, from the underground to the mainstream, there's something for everyone. And it's all on *Dutch Dance Music 96*. Find it. Love it.

Everyone is already familiar with the "Stayin' Alive" cover by **N-Trance**, featuring rap by Ricardo Da Force. If Ricardo's voice sounds familiar, it should. He does the rap for Clubzone, and I'm sure you all remember KLF — one and the same. At any rate, this full-length CD, *Electronic Pleasure*, is the bomb. Twelve lovelies for your boogie pleasure comprise this one, found on Radical Records. Real McCoy, watch out! N-Trance is here to stay!

Okay, let's get to singles. Well, Miss Estefan is back and singing in English. Now, make no error, we loved her last two Latin/house singles, "Abriendo Puertos" and "Tres Deseos." But now we all can sing along to her new English single, "Reach." The lyrics are motivational and the energy level is definitely there, taking us back to the Miami Sound Machine days. Hey, and guess what? This tune is the official theme song for the 1996 Summer Olympics. As

you can imagine, Gloria and everyone at Epic is extremely excited about this project, which, by the way, is from her forthcoming album, *Destiny*. Get ready — it's hot!

Speaking of Epic, they've put out sort of a cute EP that you may want to get a hold of, "If You Love Dance," featuring songs by four artists, including Canada's #1 record of '95, "A Deeper Shade of Love," by **Camille**; Gloria's "Tres Deseos"; **Luther Vandross** "Power of Love (Love Power)"; and **Ottmar Liebert's** "Havana Club." It's worth springing the coins for the Ottmar alone. Liebert is a well-schooled musician, actually from a New Age/classical background. But the mix of "Havana Club" by Ralphie Rosario lends a new twist to Liebert's style of music, creating a copacetic environment for the dance floor. Pick it up. "Symphonic trance" — a new movement? "Children" by **Robert Miles** has got

to be one of the most incredible songs of the year. Although the record came out some time ago, interest stateside has recently skyrocketed. Miles is a pioneer in this particular style of trance, which has its origins in Italy and, in particular, the Venice region.

The history of symphonic trance — otherwise known as "dream" music — ironically has its roots in techno. Italy has for some time been the largest clubbing nation in the world; 4,000 locales exist and a total of four million clubbers frequent them every weekend, or one out of every three people of club-going age.

In 1991-92, the 20,000-strong "Mama Anti-Rock Movement" started up a protest against the number of club-related accidents on the road (like Mothers Against Drunk Drivers here). They demanded that clubs — particular those in Venice, renowned for playing the harder genres of music such as techno — start closing at the earlier time of 2 a.m.

Anyway, some of Venice's bigger-name deejays reacted to the "Mama Anti-Rock Movement" by slowing down the tempo and introducing slower progressive trance music and melodic dream music. Voilà! "Symphonic trance," pioneered by deejays such as Robert Miles, was born, eventually became the mainstay and is now taking the U.S. by storm.

Another Italian trance gem that I happened upon this week is **DJ Dado's** "X-Files"; yes, the *X-Files* theme. Gorgeous, soaring trance at its best. Yummie!

Faves of the week: **Lonnie Gordon's** comeback on Republic Records, "Dirty Love." Lovely hi-house romp, her best ever! And without a doubt the dance mixes of the **Smashing Pumpkins'** "1979" by Roli Mosimann and Moby are it, period, no questions, only answers. It's available on Virgin. And that's Dance Music **THIS WEEK IN TEXAS.**

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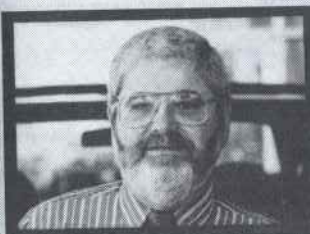


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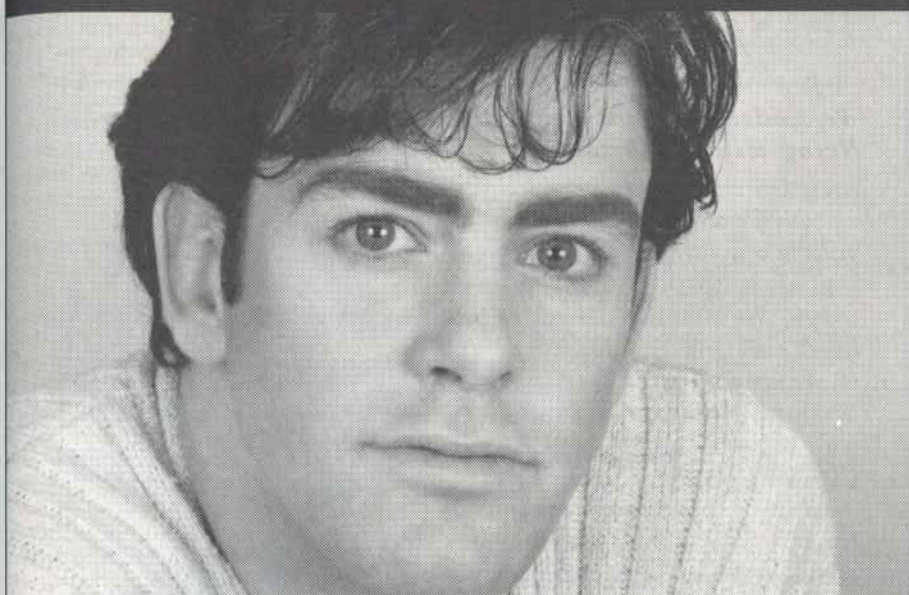


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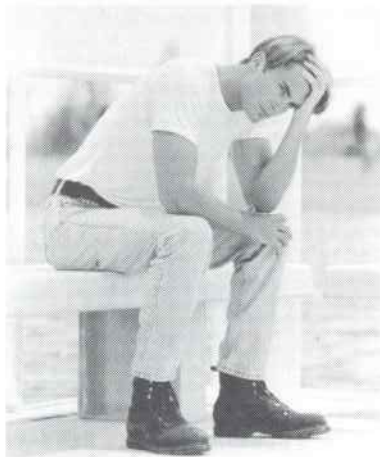

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## AWARDS BANQUET A BIG SUCCESS FOR BLACK GAY GROUP IN HOUSTON

*Larger Than Expected Crowd  
Celebrates AALGA's First Year.*

HOUSTON — The African-American Lesbian and Gay Alliance celebrated its first year of existence with a heavily attended banquet last Saturday that honored members and others for their outstanding contributions.

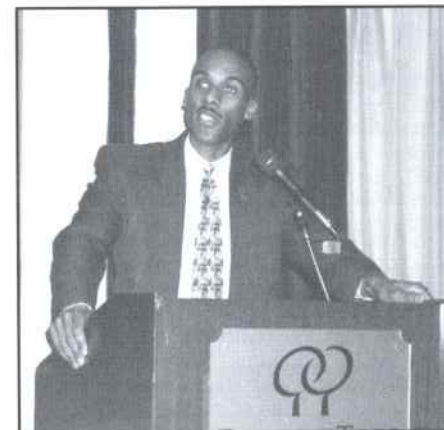
"We had 120 people present, more than even we expected," said Ken Harris, co-founder of AALGA and banquet chair. Attendees sat at tables named after prominent African-American gay, lesbian, bisexual or transgendered people, like the choreographer Alvin Ailey, the author Alice Walker and the drag entertainer RuPaul.

"Tonight we celebrate our first anniversary, and honor several community and AALGA members for a year of special deeds," Steve Walker, the group's chair, told the audience, "and it is great to see many of my old and new friends present today." Walker reminisced over how he and a small group of friends met to begin planning AALGA, in the face of warnings from others that such a group would never get off the ground.

Held at the DoubleTree Hotel in downtown Houston, the banquet drew numerous notable attendees, including state Rep. Garnet Coleman; Glenda Gardner of the City of Houston HIV Prevention Department; Bruce Marquis, a candidate for the Democratic nomination for Harris County Sheriff; Pat Gandy, president of the Houston Gay & Lesbian Political Caucus; Sarah DePalma, chair of It's Time, Texas!; Angela Larkin Byer, president of Sisters of Houston; and Barbara Winston, president of PFLAG-Houston.

"Thank you for this special tribute, and for taking it upon yourselves to create community," said Houston City Councilman Jew Don Boney, who won the Barbara Jordan Spirit Award. "AALGA is important to this city, to the black community and the gay and lesbian community because you speak from a unique perspective, and I am honored that you have chosen me to receive this award."

Also honored were Gerald Waddy, As-

sistant Director of the TSU HIV Prevention Center, who received the Essex Hemphill Award for his lifetime of activism and research on HIV and AIDS issues; Evelyn Whalen of the Ensemble Theater, winner of the James Baldwin Arts Award; Angela Larkin-Byer, winner of the Audre Lorde Award as outstanding AALGA female member; and Freddy Ivan Smith, who was honored with the Bayard Rustin Award as outstanding AALGA male member.

Keith Boykin, executive director of the National Black Gay and Lesbian Leadership Forum, gave a keynote address which several times brought his audience to its feet. "The image of black gay men and lesbians is invisible," Boykin said. "We must not allow Newt Gingrich, Eddie Murphy or even Louis Farrakhan to define who we are as black lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgendered people. If we let them define us, they will define us as they have: immoral, ungodly, inhuman or less worthy of respect and companionship."

The African-American Lesbian and Gay Alliance was formed a year ago in Feb-

ruary, and currently has over 200 members. The organization has set as its goals providing mentorship, skills building and leadership to gay men, lesbians, bisexuals and transgendered people of African descent; destroying negative myths about homosexuals; and building bridges with other black and gay/lesbian organizations.

Walker said AALGA would soon seek a change in its status that would allow it to begin endorsing political candidates.

## **AIDS AGENCIES IN DALLAS TO LOSE FEDERAL FUNDS**

*Decision Will Force  
Deep Cutbacks in Services.*

DALLAS — Local AIDS organizations are scrambling to deal with what they have been told will be a 31% cut in federal funds coming from the agency which disperses money from the Ryan White Comprehensive AIDS Resource Emergency Act of 1990 and supplies much-needed federal resources to those agencies.

In total dollars, Dallas groups will lose \$1.5 million countywide compared with last year's funding. The grant area will receive a total of \$3.3 million this year, to be distributed to numerous AIDS service groups.

At least 4,100 people were served by local AIDS agencies in the last half of 1995, according to a recent survey, and about 950 of those were first-time clients.

AIDS Services of Dallas, which provides housing for people living with the disease, stands to lose approximately \$55,000. The agency had been on the verge of doubling its capacity for providing living arrangements for PWAs, but is now reconsidering those plans in the wake of the loss of funds.

The AIDS Resource Center was also hard hit, with Karen Estes, the center's director of operations, saying the federal cuts would mean severe reductions in virtually every one of the center's programs.

While Dallas lost money, other cities gained, such as New York. Officials with the Dallas-area AIDS consortium in charge of distributing federal Ryan White money said they could find no reason for the loss of funds for the Metroplex. Steve Young, a spokesman for the Ryan White agency in Washington, was quoted in *The Dallas Morning News* as saying that "Dallas may

have good programs, but other cities might have had really good programs."

The loss of funds has not been caused by the political wrangling in Washington over federal budget cuts; Dallas was apparently a victim of the process through which money is distributed through Ryan White. The setback couldn't come at a worse time, as statistics show that safer sex is being practiced less and less and rates of HIV and AIDS are showing an upsurge among teens, minorities and in the gay population.

## **NUMEROUS CRUCIAL RACES MAKE APRIL 9 RUNOFF INTERESTING**

*City Council, School Board  
Elections in Austin, San Antonio,  
Drawing Gay Attention.*

TEXAS — The first round of excitement was March 12, when the Republican and Democratic primaries were held in Texas. The big excitement will be Nov. 5, when national and state elections for everything from county constable to president will be held.

In between, there are at least a couple more times when voters will be asked to go to the polls in Texas. Tuesday, April 9, is the runoff election in local and statewide races in which no candidate won outright last month. On May 4, elections will be held for seats on bodies like the Austin City Council and school boards in Austin and San Antonio, to name just a couple. All these elections will have strong bearing on what sort of political support or opposition gay men and lesbians will have to deal with in the closing years of this century.

The Austin Lesbian/Gay Political Caucus is endorsing two candidates April 9 in Democratic runoffs: Margo Frasier over Stacy Suits for Travis County Sheriff and Gary Taylor over Charles Holcomb for Court of Criminal Appeals Judge, Place 2. Frasier outpolled Suits 46%-20% the first time, while Taylor is looking to make up what was a 35%-30% gap. In addition, the ALGPC isn't endorsing, but is actively supporting, John Bryant (who returned the group's questionnaire too late to be considered) against Victor Morales to be the Democratic challenger to Republican Sen. Phil Gramm in November.

The ALGPC will follow the election with a candidate forum and endorsement meeting for Austin City Council and Austin Independent School District School Board members at 7 p.m. Wednesday, April 10 at Metropolitan Community Church of Austin, 425 Woodward St.

The Log Cabin Republicans of Austin have a strong interest in one of Tuesday's runoffs, Terry Keel vs. Kirk Ingels, to be the GOP candidate for state Representative from District 47. "We do not want Kirk Ingels to win," LCR-Austin President Steve Labinski said. "He's the president of the American Family Association here, and one of the biggest gay-baiters around. He was trounced (44%-24%) in the primary, which was great. We hope the people of the district aren't going to elect a bigot."

A state Representative race also holds big interest for the San Antonio Equal Rights Political Caucus: District 125, where Arthur "Art" Reyna and Ray Vale Jr. square off again after Reyna showed a slight 41%-40 edge in the first round for the Democratic nod. "We've sent out special mailings to all the people in the district," explained Bruce Jarstfer of SAERPC, "emphasizing the homophobic things that have come out of Vale's campaign. We've been getting a lot of feedback, good reception to our push to help Reyna." The SAERPC also is strongly endorsing Bryant.

In Houston, the Houston Gay & Lesbian Political Caucus has endorsed John Bryant in the Democratic race for U.S. Senate, after the group's first-round pick, John Odum, failed to make the runoff. In the race for Harris County Sheriff, the group retained its endorsement of Art Contreras in his run against Bruce Marquis, who had also sought HGLPC's support.

## **GAY BANDS HOLD SPRING CONFERENCE NEXT WEEKEND IN SAN ANTONIO**

*Two Free Public Concerts  
Set for April 13 in Alamo Plaza.*

TEXAS — The Houston Pride Band and Dallas' Oak Lawn Band will co-host the 1996 Spring Conference of the Lesbian and Gay Bands of America [LGBA], to be held next weekend, April 12-14, in San Antonio.

The conference is being held in San Antonio to encourage the appreciation of community band performances in that city. "At our most recent conference, in Indianapolis last fall, we [the Houston and Dallas bands] decided to host the next conference, Connie Moore, a longtime spokesperson for the Houston band, said. "LGBA conferences are usually held in cities that have gay and lesbian bands. In an effort to reach new musicians and promote and encourage the assembly of new bands, we felt that San Antonio would be a great place to achieve this goal."

"LGBA has twice visited Texas in years past," Moore added, "performing in Houston's Jones Hall in 1991 and meeting in Dallas in 1993 to prepare for a Gay Games performance. San Antonio offered LGBA musicians a refreshing change of venue. Everyone is enthusiastic about visiting historic sites in San Antonio and performing in front of the Alamo. It is our desire to stir up some interest in what we do, and hope that area musicians will respond by forming a gay and lesbian band under LGBA's aegis."

According to Russell Ben Williams, secretary of the Houston band and a coordinator of next weekend's conference, LGBA is an international organization of community bands from gay and lesbian communities around the U.S. and Canada. Two members from each of the organization's 19 affiliated bands serve as delegates to LGBA's semiannual conferences.

"Besides rehearsals and performances, this conference will feature brass and percussion clinics, committee meetings and a little sightseeing," Williams said. "We will also offer workshops on increasing membership within bands, producing concerts, fund-raising, sharing concert program ideas and increasing awareness of our existence to encourage the formation of new bands."

## GAYS, LESBIANS INCLUDED IN NEW SCHOOL POLICY IN DALLAS

### Anti-Harassment Rule Initially Left Out Sexual Orientation.

DALLAS — After initially not including sexual orientation in their proposed new anti-harassment policy, board members of the Dallas Independent School District have changed their minds and instructed the committee writing the policy to broaden the new rules to protect gays and lesbians.

The policy change came about after former Dallas school board member Dan Peavey was secretly recorded in telephone conversations using anti-gay, racist and anti-feminist language. That tape was later made public both at a Dallas School Board meeting and in the media. Peavey resigned from the board under pressure.

The school board is now addressing the issues brought up by that tape, and most observers expect members to approve the new procedures when a final vote is held sometime next week.

The new policy, which was unanimously approved by the Intercultural Relations Committee, which recommends policy to the board, sets out procedures for report-

ing and investigating harassment complaints involving students and employees. It prohibits "oral, written, psychological, physical and other demonstrative actions with regard to race, creed, ethnic origin, sexual orientation or religious preference that is harassing."

Board members who violate the policy could be censured by colleagues, and vendors and school volunteers could lose contracts or have to leave school grounds. Board members cannot be removed from office, however; committee members decided such actions should be left to the voters.

DISD's new regulations come on the heels of similar measures enacted by the City of Dallas late last year which protect gays and lesbians from employment discrimination based on sexual orientation.

Jim Thurman, the editor of *Positive Threads*, was grateful to the Esther's Follies folks and to special sponsors who purchased tickets so people with AIDS could attend the show. "We did good; we actually netted close to \$2,000, and this was our first benefit," Thurman stated.

"Actually, we were able to give away about 75 tickets to [people with HIV/AIDS]. Normally they can't afford tickets to something like this. That's what I wanted to do, to try to get as many as possible to enjoy a night out like this....We've got a lot of friends."

A near-capacity crowd of about 250 people paid \$15 or \$20 for tickets, and they more than got their money's worth as the Follies troupe was at its madcap best. The opening number poked fun at everyone in the news from Fidel Castro to Bob Dole, from Colin Powell to Michael Jackson, to the newly legitimized "Baptist Boogie" in Waco to Austin's infamous dive-bombing grackles.
